TOP THINGS TO DO

- Benefit Street — Mile of History** — The highest concentration of restored Colonial, Federal, and Victorian homes in the US.
 - RISD Museum** — The Rhode Island School of Design's world-class museum holds over 100,000 works — from ancient Egyptian artifacts to...
- Federal Hill — Little Italy** — Walk Atwells Avenue for Rhode Island's legendary Italian-American food scene.
 - Rhode Island State House** — The fourth-largest self-supporting marble dome in the world.
 - Gondola Ride on the Providence Rivers** — La Gondola operates authentic Venetian gondola rides along the downtown canals — singing gondoliers included.

BEST WALKS

- India Point to Waterplace Park Riverwalk** 2.5 km · ~30 min · Flat · Free — Follow the paved Providence River path from India Point Park northwest to Waterplace Park at the heart of downtown.
- Benefit Street Historic Walk** 1.5 km · ~45 min · Hilly · Free — From Brown University, stroll south along Benefit Street past the Providence Athenaeum, John Brown House, and dozens of preserved...

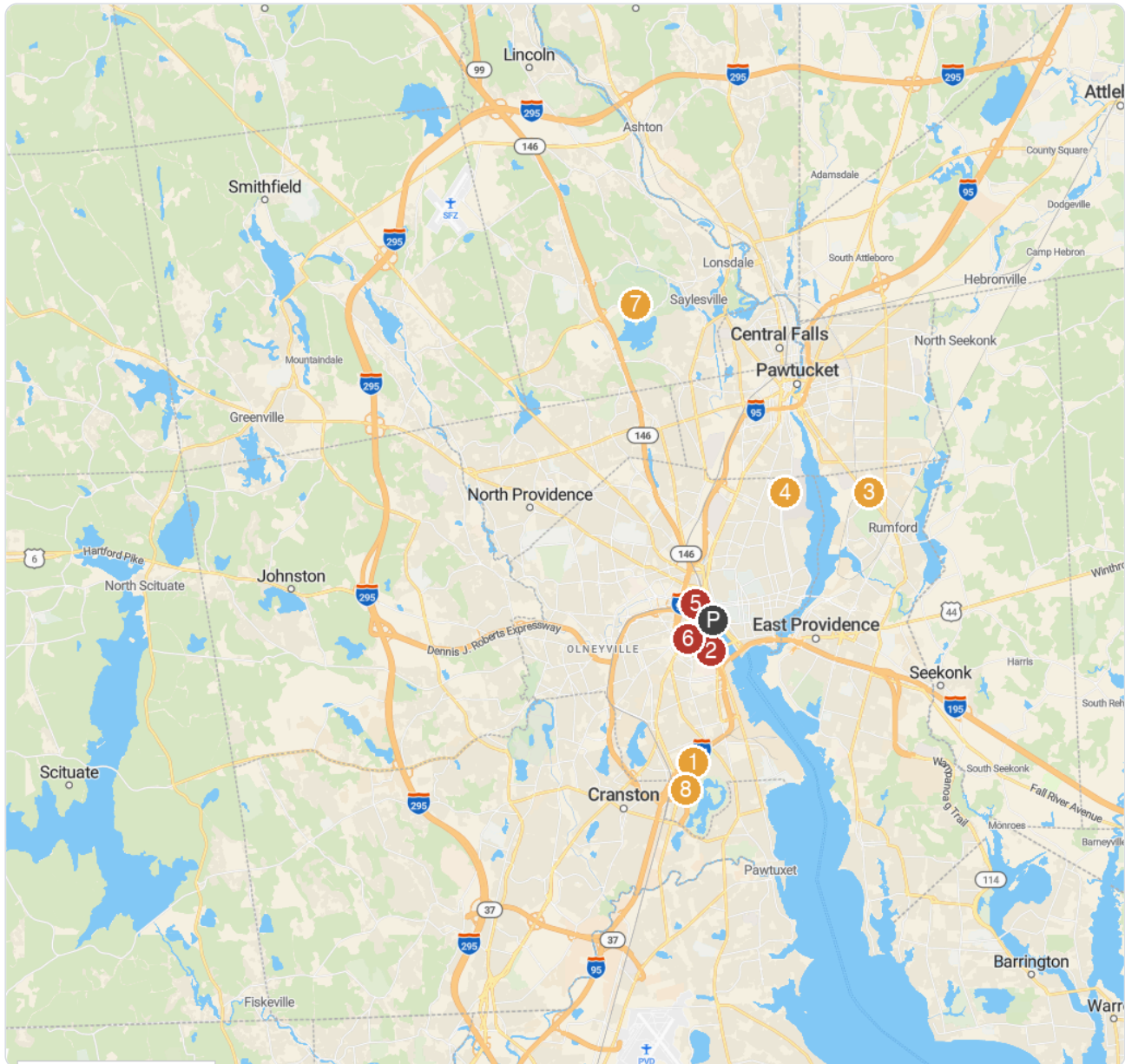
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
