

Puerto Banús–Marbella, Andalusia, Spain

Spain's answer to Saint-Tropez: a glittering yacht marina backed by a whitewashed Moorish Old Town, designer boutiques, and ten Salvador Dalí sculptures on the way to the beach. Small luxury ships tender directly in; guests from larger vessels make the 45-minute drive from Málaga.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Small luxury ships tender into Puerto Banús marina; mega-ships dock at Málaga (~45 min away)

Best For: Upscale people-watching, luxury shopping, Andalusian Old Town, beaches

Walk to center: 0–5 min from tender pier to marina; 10–15 min walk to Marbella Old Town from its marina

Don't Miss: Plaza de los Naranjos, Dalí sculptures on Avenida del Mar, espeto de sardinas on the beach

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Marbella Old Town & Orange Square** — Wander the Casco Antiguo's cobbled lanes to Plaza de los Naranjos — the 1485 Orange Square flanked by a Renaissance...
- **Puerto Banús Marina & Luxury Shopping** — Stroll Calle Ribera along the front-line marina to gawk at mega-yachts and supercars, then browse 40+ designer...
- **Costa del Sol Beach Day** — Playa de Levante (east of marina, calm water, family-friendly) and Playa del Duque (west, upscale beach clubs like...)
- **Roman Villa of Río Verde** — Roughly halfway between Puerto Banús and Marbella, these late-1st/2nd-century AD ruins are best known for...
- **Dolphin Watching & Boat Charter** — Dolphins are common in the Alborán Sea off the Costa del Sol; short catamaran or private boat charters depart from...

BEST WALKS

- **Paseo Marítimo — Marina to Old Town** 6.5 km one-way | ~1.5 hrs | Flat — Walk the full beachfront boardwalk from Puerto Banús marina east to Marbella's Old Town.
- **Marbella Old Town Loop** 1.5 km | ~45 min | Easy — From Marbella marina, walk up to Plaza de los Naranjos, thread through the narrow lanes of the Casco Antiguo past the Iglesia de la...

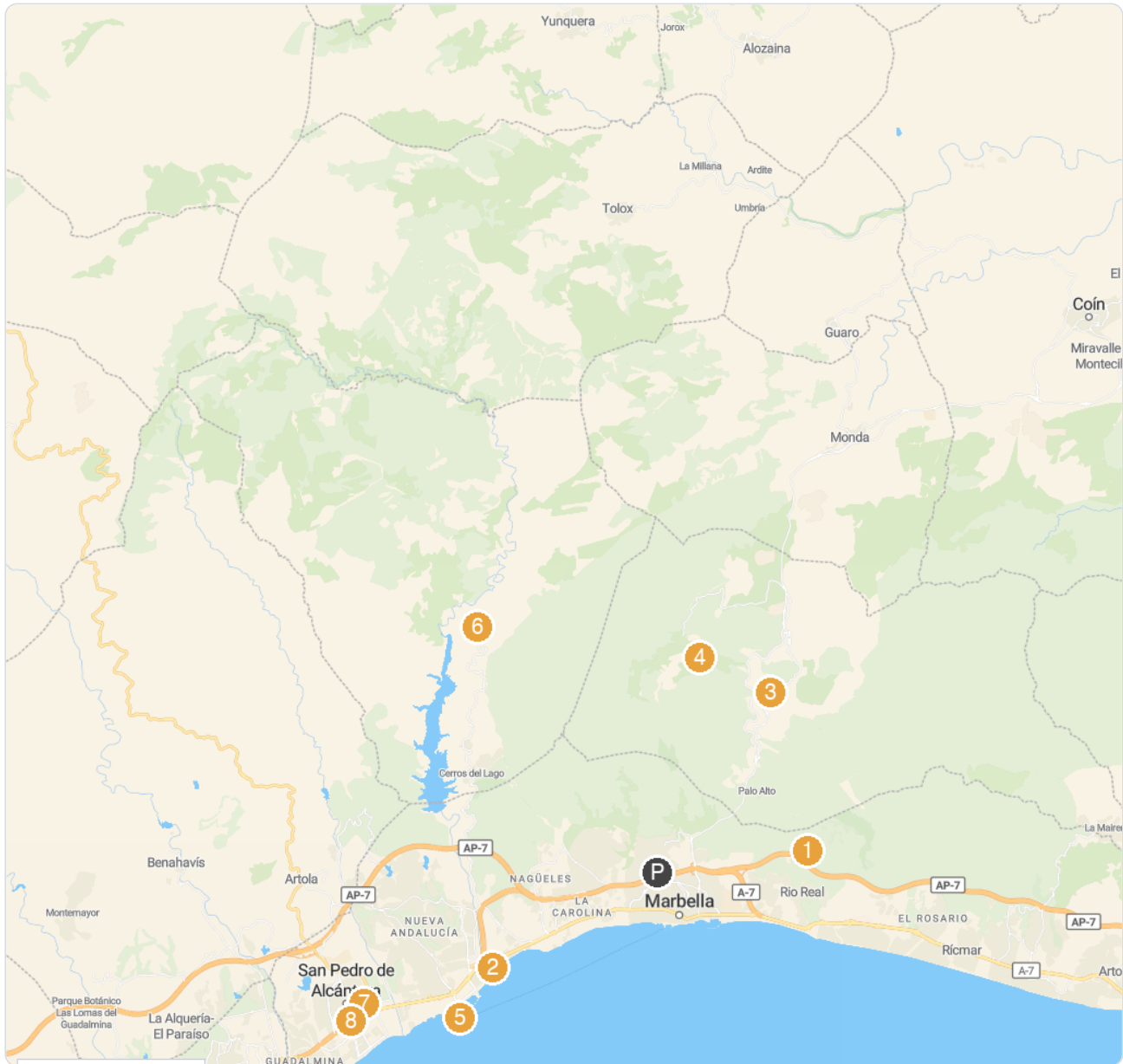
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
