GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Expedition ships dock at Puerto Bories (~5 km); large ships tender to the Puerto Natales Marine Terminal

Best For: Torres del Paine day trips, glacier cruises, Patagonian cuisine

Walk to Centre: 10–15 min flat walk from tender pier to Plaza de Armas

Don't Miss: Milodon Cave and a Calafate Sour at the Plaza

Getting around: **Taxi** CLP 1,000–2,000 (~USD 1–2) in-town · **Rideshare** Uber

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Torres del Paine National Park** — One of the world's great natural wonders: turquoise lakes, condors overhead, and the iconic granite towers rising...
 - Balmaceda & Serrano Glaciers Boat Tour** — Cruise the Última Esperanza Fjord past cormorant colonies and sea lions to two dramatic hanging glaciers.
- Cueva del Milodón Natural Monument** — A massive cave where remains of a prehistoric giant ground sloth were found in 1895.
 - Estancia Experience & Traditional Asado** — Visit a working Patagonian sheep ranch by boat.
 - Kayaking the Fjords** — Paddle the calm channels of the Última Esperanza Sound with a guide, passing steep cliffs and watching for black-necked...

BEST WALKS

- Waterfront Costanera Stroll** 1.5 km · 20 min · Easy · Free — Follow the Costanera promenade from the Marine Terminal past the old wooden Muelle Histórico (a photographer's dream), the Monumento...
- Plaza de Armas & Artisan Market** 0.5 km · 15 min browsing · Easy · Free — Wander the leafy plaza with its church and municipal building, then duck into the Pueblo Artesanal for hand-knit Patagonian wool...

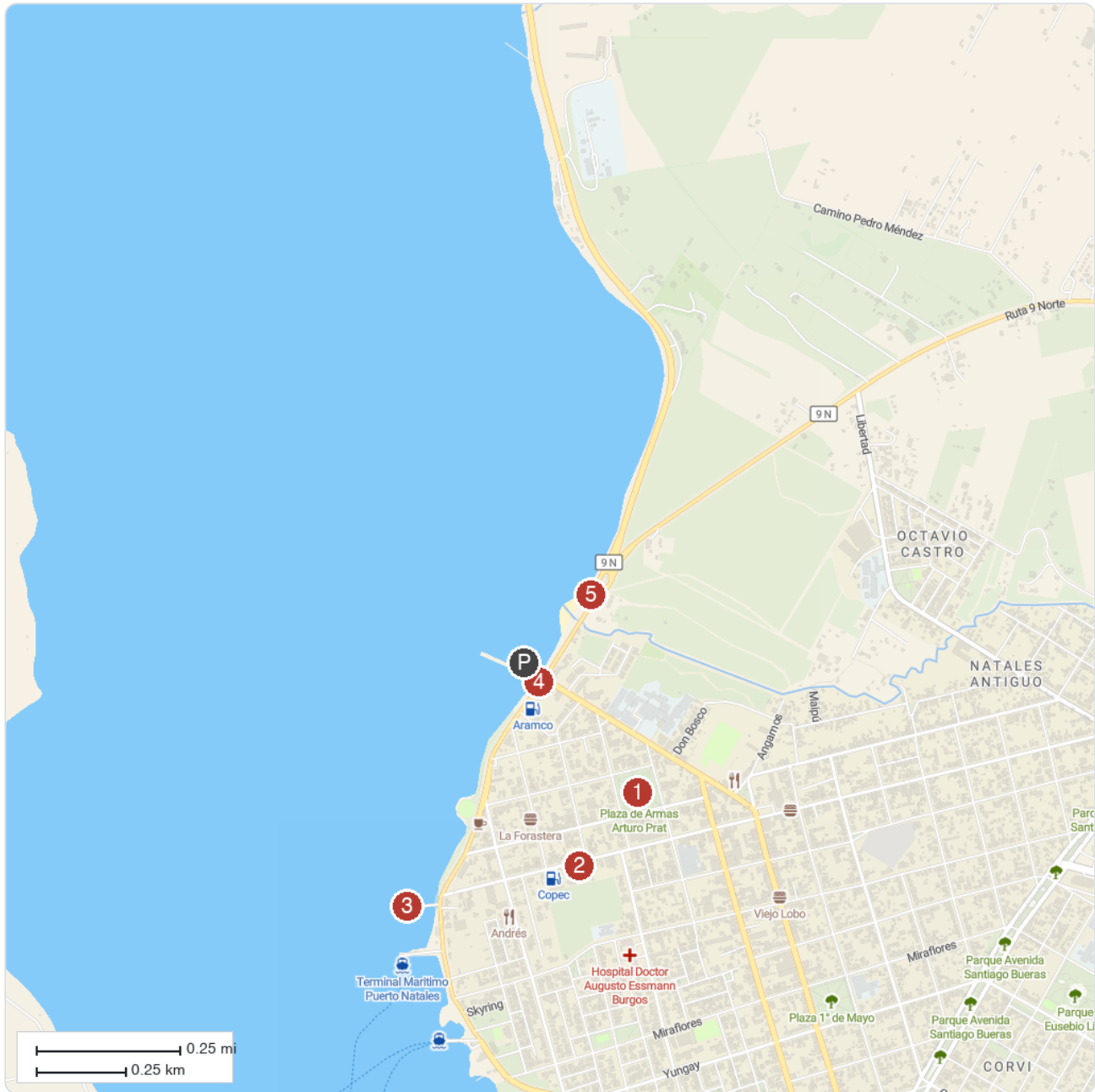
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
