GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier (docked) — either the Muelle de Cruceros in Puntarenas town or Puerto Caldera (~20 km/12 mi away); no tendering either way

Best For: Wildlife lovers, rainforest excursions, families, foodies

Walk to center: ~10 min walk to the Paseo de los Turistas if docked at the town pier; from Puerto Caldera you'll need a shuttle, taxi, or tour

Don't Miss: A Churchill (shaved ice dessert) from a kiosk on the Paseo de los Turistas

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Tarcoles River Crocodile Safari** — Boat down the Tarcoles River to see enormous American crocodiles (some over 15 ft) basking on the banks, plus scarlet...
 - **Carara National Park** — A rare transition zone between dry and humid rainforest — one of the best places in Costa Rica to spot wild scarlet...
 - **Isla Tortuga Catamaran Day** — Sail 45-60 minutes to a stunning uninhabited island with white-sand beaches and
- turquoise water — the best beach day...

 - **Rainforest Canopy & Zipline** — Fly through the rainforest canopy on ziplines or cross hanging bridges for a bird's-eye view of the jungle.
 - **Parque Marino del Pacífico** — A small marine rescue center just 5 minutes' walk from the pier — sea turtles, crocodiles, seahorses, and tropical fish.

BEST WALKS

- **Paseo de los Turistas Stroll** 1.5 km | Flat | 20-30 min each way — Walk the full length of the tourist promenade from the pier terminal east along the oceanfront.
- **Pier to El Faro (Lighthouse)** 0.8 km | Flat | 10-15 min — Short walk from the cruise terminal to the lighthouse at the tip of the peninsula — great photo spot with views across the gulf.

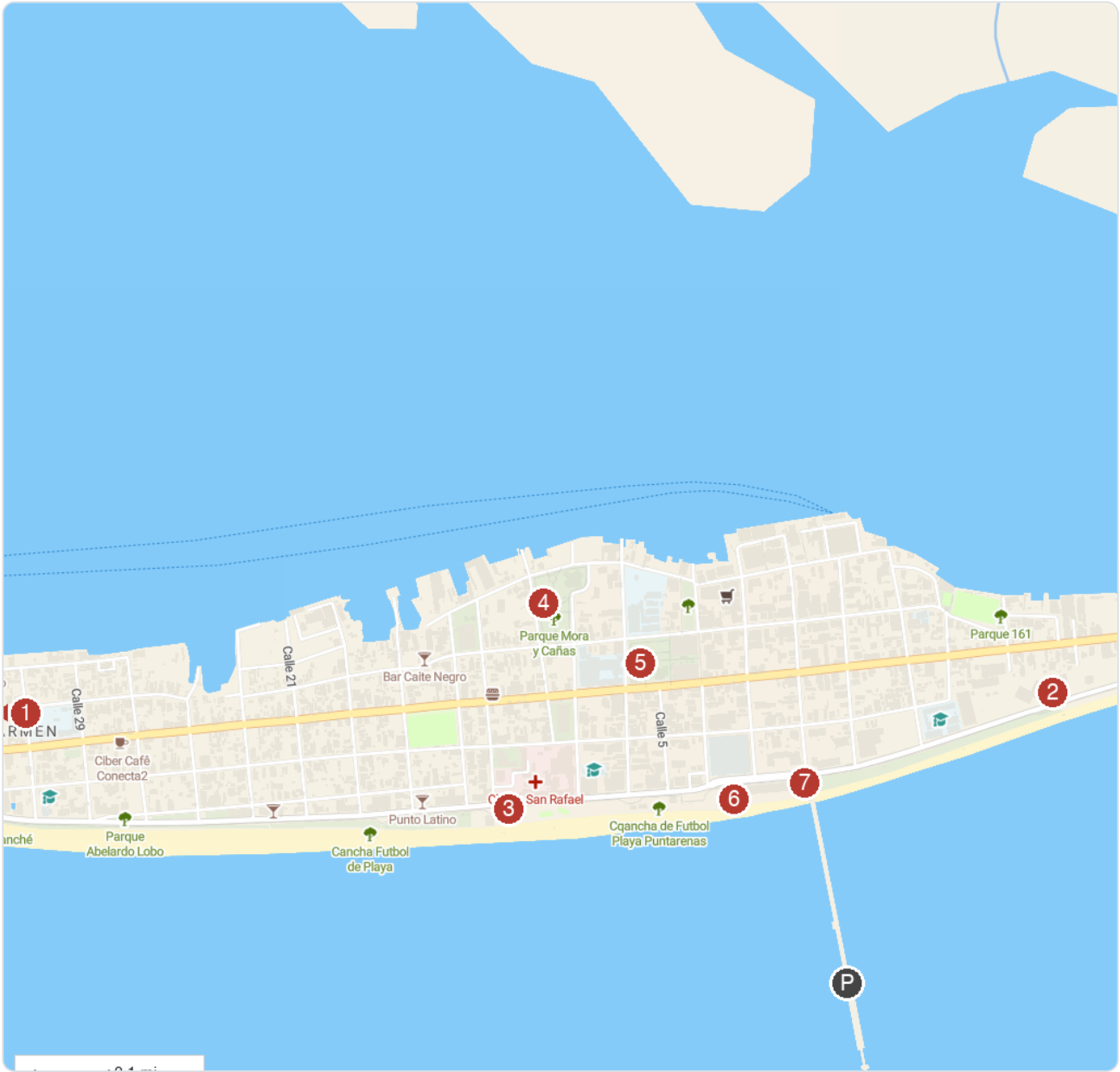
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
