- TSS Earnslaw Lake Cruise** — Step aboard the iconic 1912 coal-fired steamship for a scenic cruise across Lake Wakatipu to Walter Peak High Country...
- Shotover Jet & Canyon** — Hold on tight as a jet boat screams through the narrow Shotover River canyon at 85 km/h, spinning 360° within inches of...
- Bungy Jumping — Kawarau Bridge** — Leap from the world's first commercial bungy site — the historic Kawarau Gorge Suspension Bridge, 43 m above the river.
- Gibbston Valley Wine Tour** — The 'Valley of the Vines' just 25 minutes from Queenstown is New Zealand's highest-altitude wine region, famous for...

BEST WALKS

- Queenstown Waterfront & Gardens Loop** 3 km · 45 min · Easy · Flat — Start at Steamer Wharf and walk the pebbly shoreline of Queenstown Bay past street performers and the town beach, then cut into the...
- Queenstown Hill Time Walk** 4 km return · 2.5 hrs · Moderate · Some steep sections — A rewarding climb through fragrant pine forest from the edge of town to the 'Basket of Dreams' iron sculpture at the summit.
