GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River dock at Rainier Marina / Riverfront Park — no tender

Best For: Columbia River scenery, small-town Pacific NW charm, Mount St. Helens day trip

Walk to town: Under 2 min — ship ties up next to Riverfront Park; A Street is 1 block

Don't Miss: Lewis and Clark Bridge views from the park; watching cargo ships pass close-up

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Mount St. Helens National Volcanic Monument** — The standout excursion from Rainier.
- **Lewis and Clark Bridge & Longview, WA** — Cross the towering 1930 bridge to Longview, Washington for a visit to Lake Sacajawea Park — often called one of the...
- **Dibblee Beach River Walk** — A long sandy Columbia River beach about a mile west of the dock.
- **Historic A Street Stroll** — A Street's brick storefronts date to Rainier's logging heyday.

BEST WALKS

- **Riverfront Park to A Street Loop** 0.5 mi · 15–20 min · Flat — From the pier, explore Riverfront Park's riverside path and historical markers, then cut one block inland to A Street for the historic...
- **Dibblee Beach Walk** ~1 mi one-way · 20–25 min walk or 5 min taxi · Flat — Head west along the riverbank from the park to Dibblee Beach.

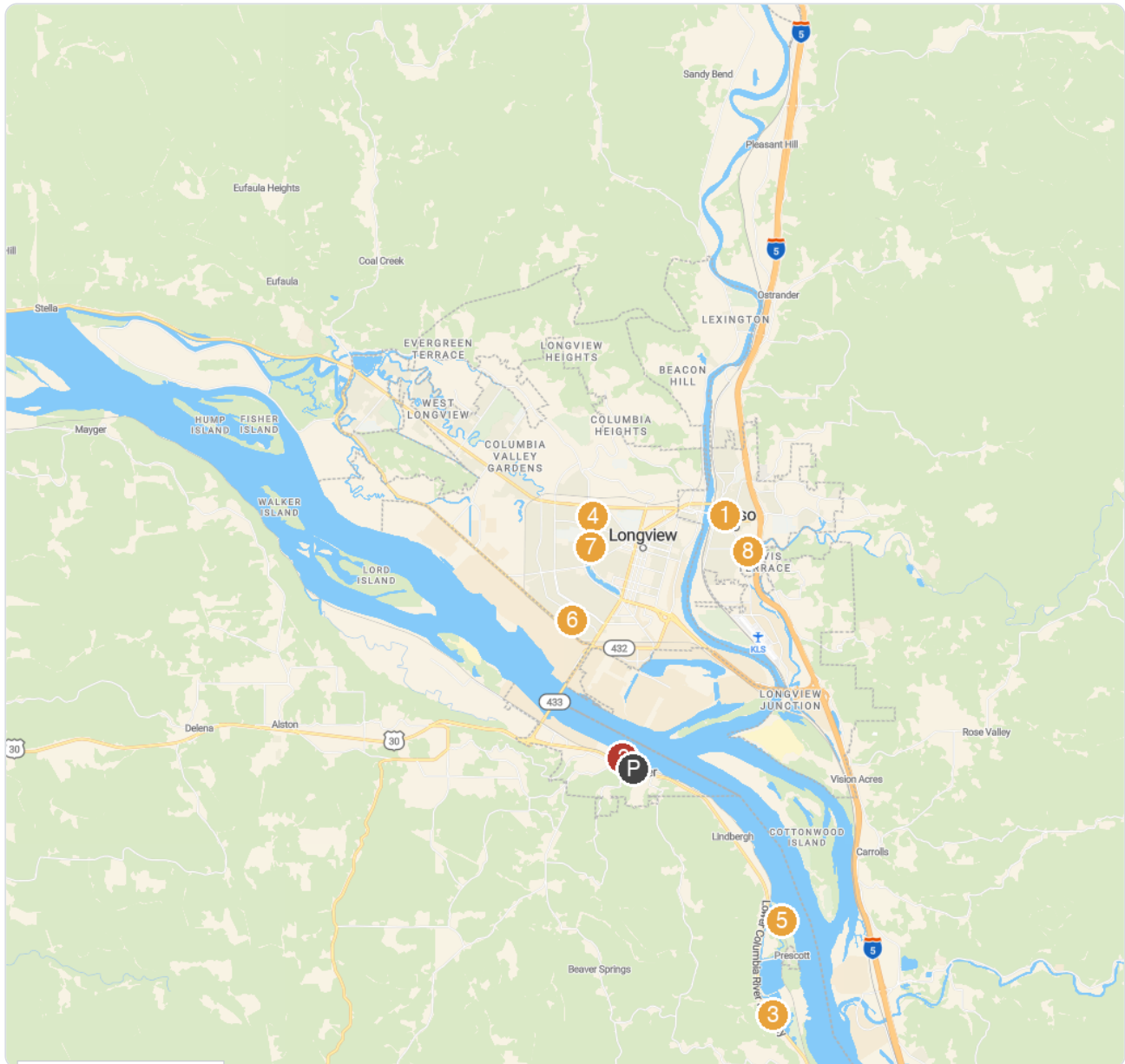
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Pre-arrange transport for excursions. Uber and Lyft barely operate in Rainier — book the cruise line's tour or call a local taxi in advance if you plan to reach Mt. St. Helens or...
- Layer up. Columbia River mornings are cool and breezy even in summer. A light windproof jacket makes the riverfront walk much more comfortable.
- Small-town hours. Some A Street shops and restaurants close early or are shut Sundays and Mondays. Cornerstone Café and El
