- **Störtebeker Festspiele** — One of Europe's largest open-air theater events, the Störtebeker Festival stages the legend of Germany's most famous...
- **Jasmund National Park & Königsstuhl Chalk Cliffs** — Rügen's showpiece: a UNESCO-listed stretch of brilliant white chalk cliffs rising 118 m above the Baltic, immortalized...
- **Cape Arkona & Slavic Fortress** — The dramatic northern tip of Rügen features chalk cliffs, two lighthouses, and the remnants of a Slavic fortress...
- **Rasender Roland Steam Railway** — The 'Racing Roland' narrow-gauge steam train has served Rügen since 1895, rattling through beach resorts and forest...
- **Binz & Baltic Beach** — Rügen's most elegant resort town, with ornate 19th-century spa villas, a long sandy Baltic beach, and iconic wicker...

- **Village & Castle Park Loop** ~1.5 km · 30 min · Easy — From the marina, stroll through the small village past the Swedish Wooden Chapel (relocated from a Stockholm exhibition and...

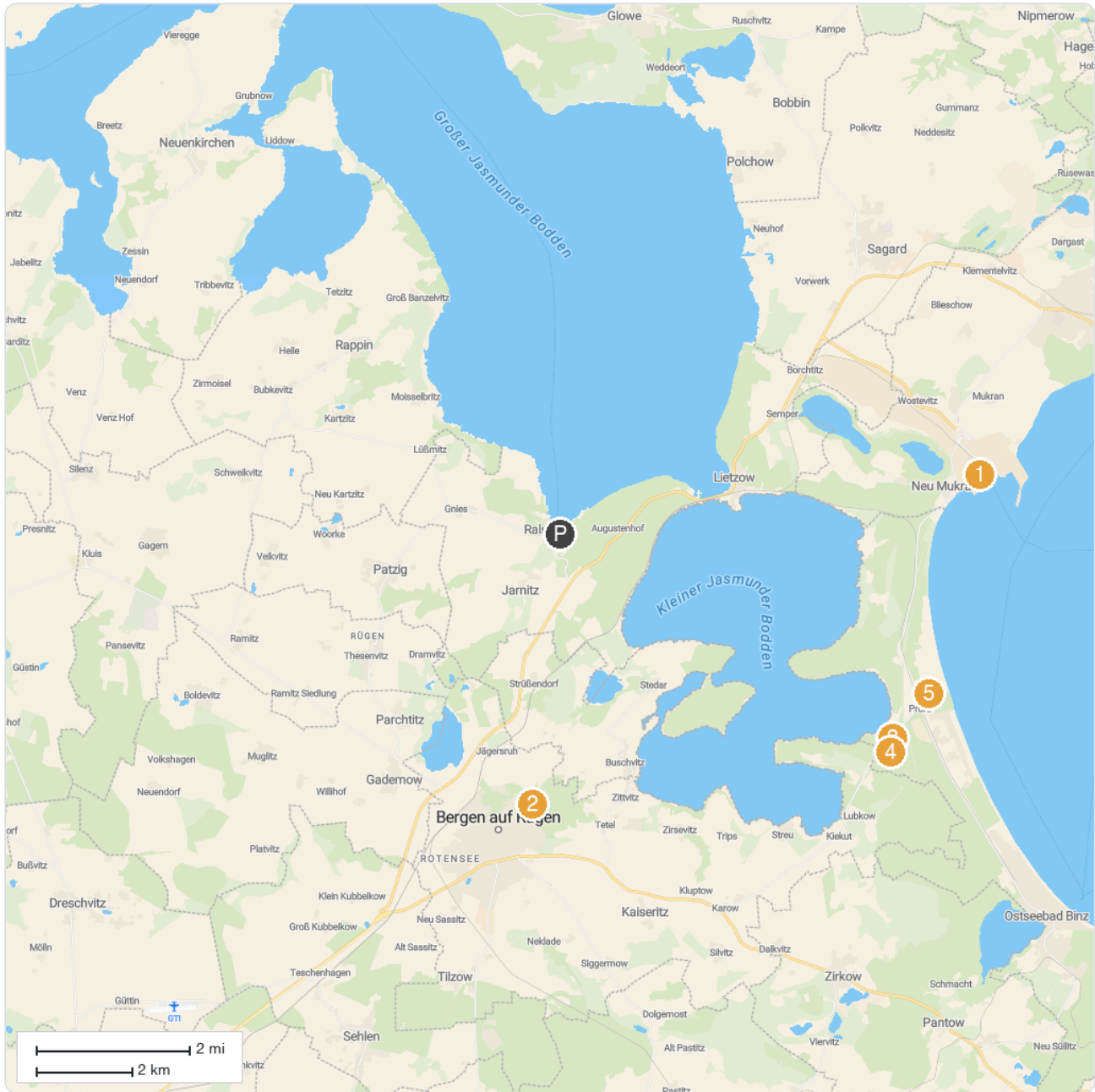
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Bring cash. Small kiosks and harbor vendors at Ralswiek are cash-only. ATMs are in nearby Bergen auf Rügen (~15 min).
- Störtebeker tickets sell out fast. If your port day is June–August and you want the evening show, book well in advance at stoertebeker.de.
- Ralswiek is tiny. You'll exhaust it in 1–2 hours. Do arrange a taxi or check bus connections to Jasmund, Binz, or Putbus for the
