GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River pier at Marc-Aurel-Ufer / Donaulände — steps from the Old Town

Best For: Medieval architecture, Roman history, Bavarian food and beer

Walk to center: 2-7 min to Stone Bridge; 10 min to Cathedral

Don't Miss: Historische Wurstküche — world's oldest sausage kitchen, open since the 12th century

 Getting around:  Taxi  €5–€12

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Old Town Walk: Stone Bridge to Cathedral** — Cross the 12th-century Steinerne Brücke (Stone Bridge), walk to the magnificent Dom St.
- Old Town Hall & Reichstag Museum** — Guided tour of the 14th-century Altes Rathaus, including the Imperial Hall where the Holy Roman Empire's Perpetual Diet...
- Thurn und Taxis Palace (Schloss St. Emmeram)** — Tour the opulent state rooms and medieval cloister of this private palace with over 500 rooms — still home to the...
- Museum of Bavarian History** — Ultramodern interactive museum right on the riverbank, tracing how Bavaria became Bavaria from 1800 to today.
- Walhalla Day Trip** — A scenic Danube boat cruise (about an hour each way) or a 20-minute drive east to Donaustauf brings you to the Walhalla...

BEST WALKS

- Riverside to Cathedral Loop** 3 km · 45-60 min · Easy — Walk east from the dock along the Donaulände, cross the Steinerne Brücke, detour into the Old Town alleys to Haidplatz and Dom St.
- Stadtamhof & Spitalgarten** 1.5 km · 20-30 min · Easy — Cross the Stone Bridge to the historic island district of Stadtamhof, then wind down to the Spitalgarten beer garden on the river for...

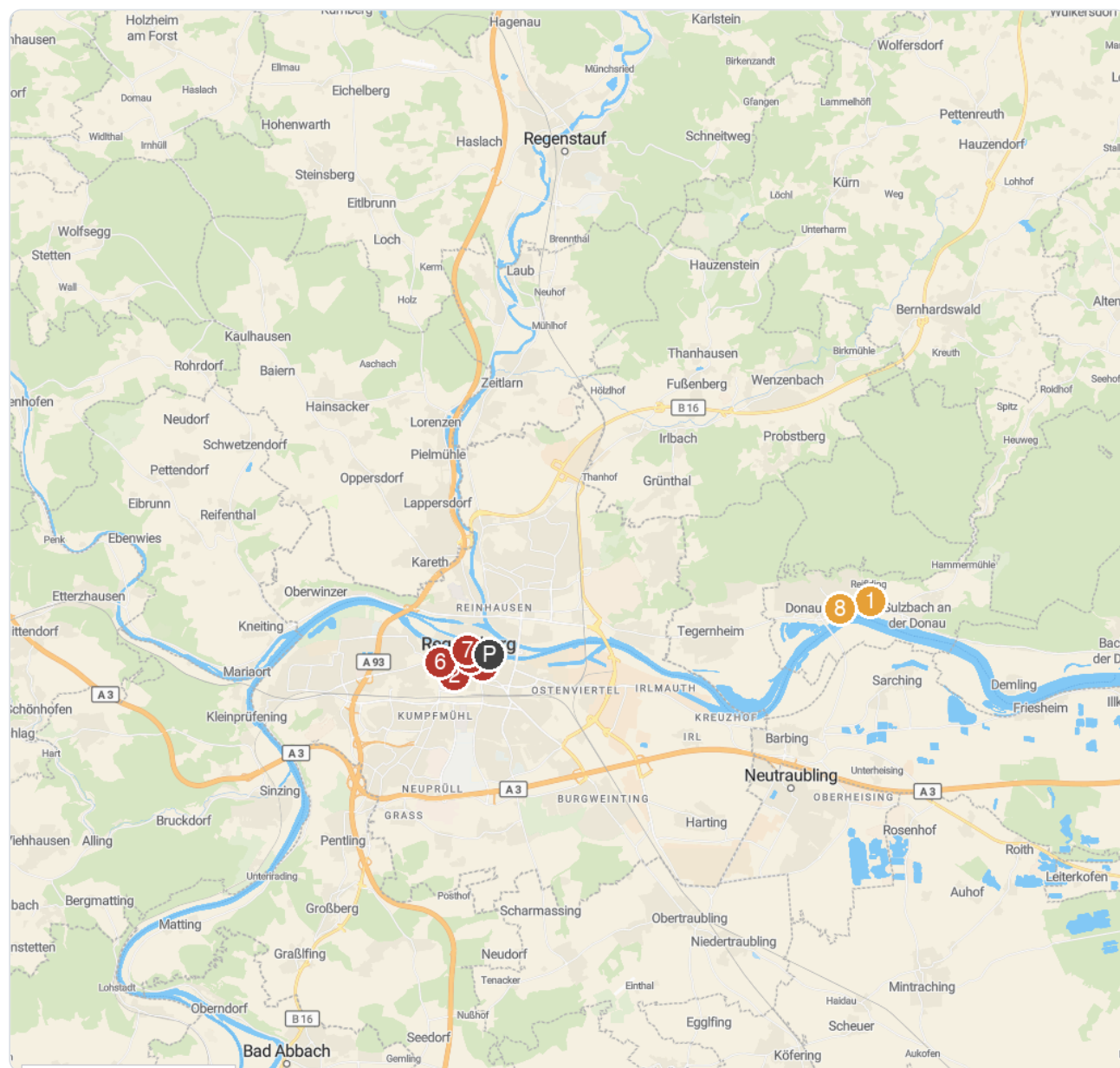
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
