TOP THINGS TO DO

- Riace Bronzes & National Archaeological Museum** — The MARC houses the Riace Bronzes — two life-sized 5th-century BC Greek bronze warriors discovered by a diver in 1972.
- Lungomare Falcomatà Stroll** — Gabriele D'Annunzio called it 'the most beautiful kilometer in Italy.' Walk the botanical-lined seafront past giant...
- Day Trip to Scilla** — Take the train about 20-30 min north to one of Italy's most beautiful fishing villages.
- Bergamot & Calabrian Food Tasting** — Reggio Calabria is the only place on earth where bergamot citrus grows commercially.
- Castello Aragonese & Old Town** — The Aragonese Castle survived earthquakes and centuries of history.

BEST WALKS

- Pier to Riace Bronzes Walk** 1.2 km · 15-20 min · Flat — Walk from the port gates south along the seafront to the National Archaeological Museum.
- Lungomare Full Stroll** 2 km · 30-40 min · Flat — Walk the full length of the Lungomare from the museum end to Piazza Indipendenza, passing ancient Greek walls, Roman baths, Rabarama...

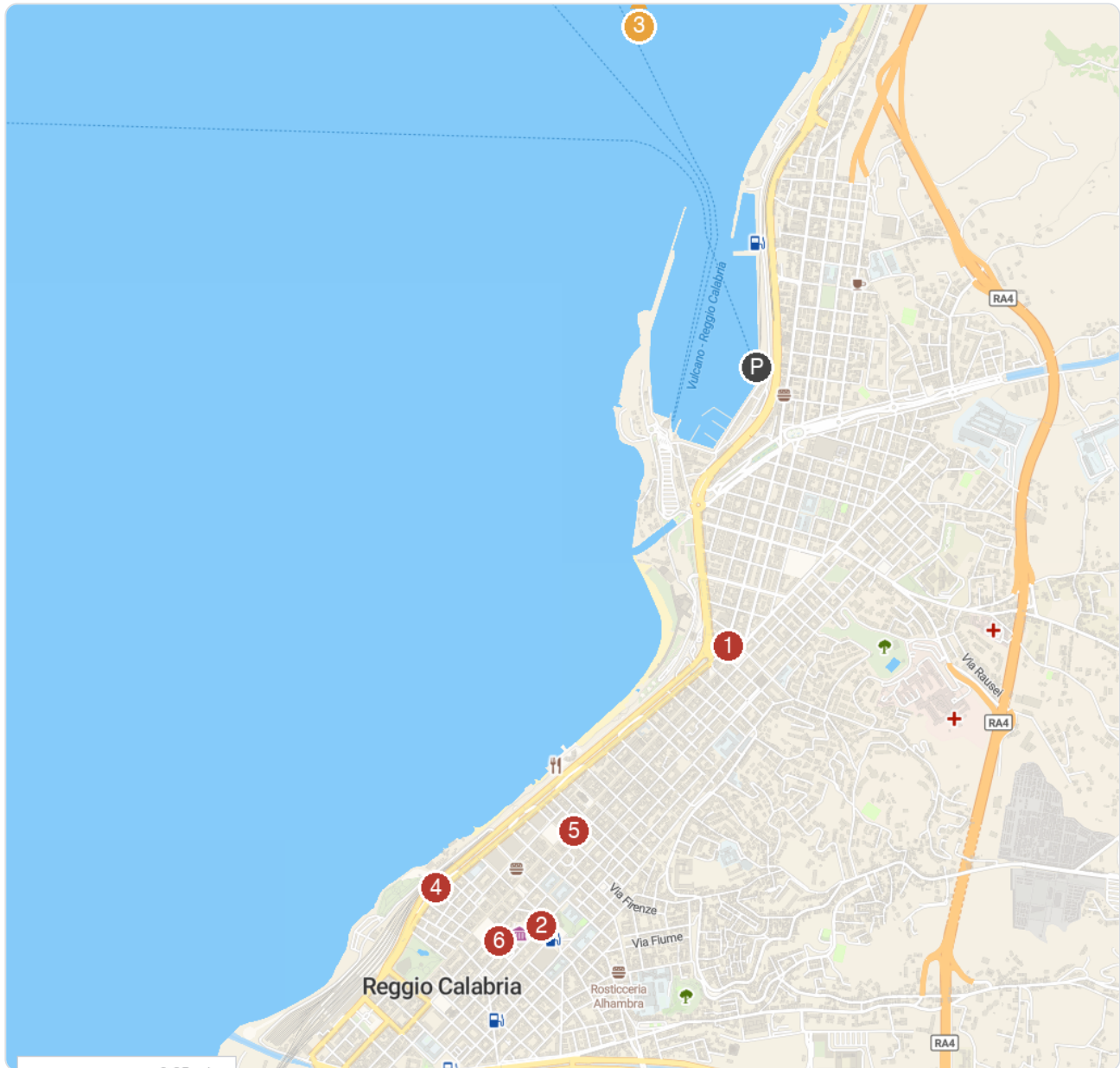
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Don't skip Gelateria Cesare. The tiny green kiosk at the start of the Lungomare near the museum is legendary. Order the bergamot flavor — it grows only here.
- Scilla is worth it if you have 7+ hours. Direct trains from Reggio Calabria Lido (the seafront station nearest the port and museum) run roughly hourly, take about 20-30 min, and...

1 Museo Archeologico Nazionale di Reggio Calabria

Houses the famous Riace Bronzes and Magna Graecia artifacts.

3 Sanctuary of Saint Francis of Paola

Important sanctuary dedicated to Saint Francis of Paola.

5 Pinacoteca Civica

City art gallery displaying local and regional artworks.

P Cruise port / terminal

2 Church of Saint Mary of the Annunciation 'degli Ottimati'

Ancient Byzantine-Norman church with beautiful mosaics and architecture.

4 Roman Baths Ancient Roman public bath ruins near the seafront.

6 Basilica Cattedrale di Maria Santissima Assunta in Cielo

Reggio Calabria's grand main cathedral, rebuilt after the 1908 earthquake.
