TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Peace Museum — Ludendorff Bridge Towers** — Step inside the two surviving stone bridge towers that U.S. excavated artifacts, tombstones, and...
- **Apollinariskirche Hilltop Pilgrimage** — A striking Neo-Gothic church perched on a hill above the Rhine, its twin towers visible from the pier.
- **Rhine Cycle Path Day Ride** — The flat, paved Rheinradweg runs right past the pier.
- **Roman Museum Remagen** — Housed in a 15th-century chapel in the town center, this free museum displays
- **Linz am Rhein Ferry Day Trip** — From the Kripp district south of the town center, board the Rhine car/passenger ferry for a roughly 10-minute crossing...

BEST WALKS

- **Promenade & Peace Museum Walk** 1.5 km · ~25 min one way · Flat — Follow the Rhine promenade south from the pier past weeping willows and riverside sculptures to the surviving Ludendorff Bridge towers.
- **Church on the Hill** 2 km · ~35 min · Moderate uphill finish — Walk from the pier through the town center, then follow the wooded path up to the Apollinariskirche for frescoes and a sweeping...

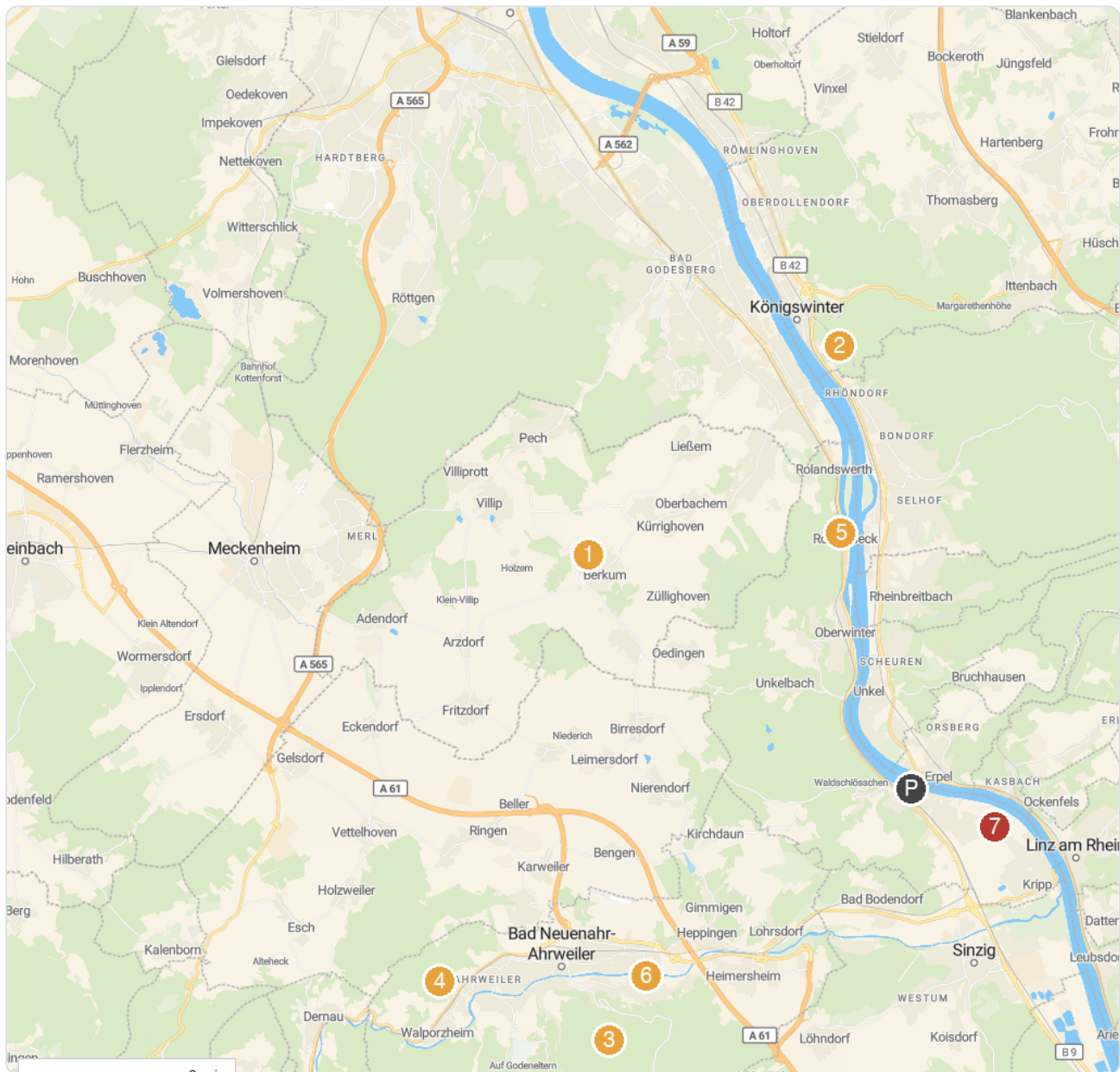
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry some cash. Small cafes, bakeries, and the Roman Museum (donations) prefer cash. Keep bills under €20.
- Order Ahr Spätburgunder. The Ahr Valley next door produces a light, earthy Pinot Noir — a regional specialty you won't find at home. Any riverside cafe will have it.
- Sunday closures. German law closes most shops on Sundays. Restaurants, the Peace Museum, and Apollinariskirche all remain
