GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Most cruise ships dock at Port de Blosson (deep-water terminal, ~2 km from center); some smaller ships tender to the Vieux Port

Walk to center: 15–25 min on foot or shuttle (Blosson pier) · 0 min if tendered to Vieux Port

Best For: History, coastal walks, local food, day trip to Île de Batz

Don't Miss: Notre-Dame-de-Croaz-Batz church, Jardin Exotique, Île de Batz ferry

- **Jardin Exotique et Botanique de Roscoff** — Thanks to the Gulf Stream microclimate, this garden grows over 3,000 subtropical species from New Zealand, South...
- **Maison des Johnnies & Onion Museum** — Roscoff's most quirky attraction tells the story of the 'Onion Johnnies' — Breton farmers who crossed the Channel by...
- **Morlaix Half-Day Excursion** — 30 minutes by road, Morlaix is a medieval town spanning a dramatic viaduct, with half-timbered houses (Maison de...

BEST WALKS

- **Vieux Port to Chapelle Sainte-Barbe** 30 min · Easy · Free · Panoramic views — From the Vieux Port, walk east along the coast to the small white Chapelle Sainte-Barbe perched on a rocky headland.
- **Old Town Loop & Exotic Garden** 1.5 hrs · Easy · Mostly flat — From the Vieux Port, explore the old town streets and the church of Notre-Dame-de-Croaz-Batz, then head east along the coast road to...
- **West to Plage de Roch'Roum** 30–40 min one way · Easy · Sandy beach — Walk west from the old port along the coastal path (part of the GR34 Customs Trail) to Plage de Roch'Roum, a clean sandy beach with...

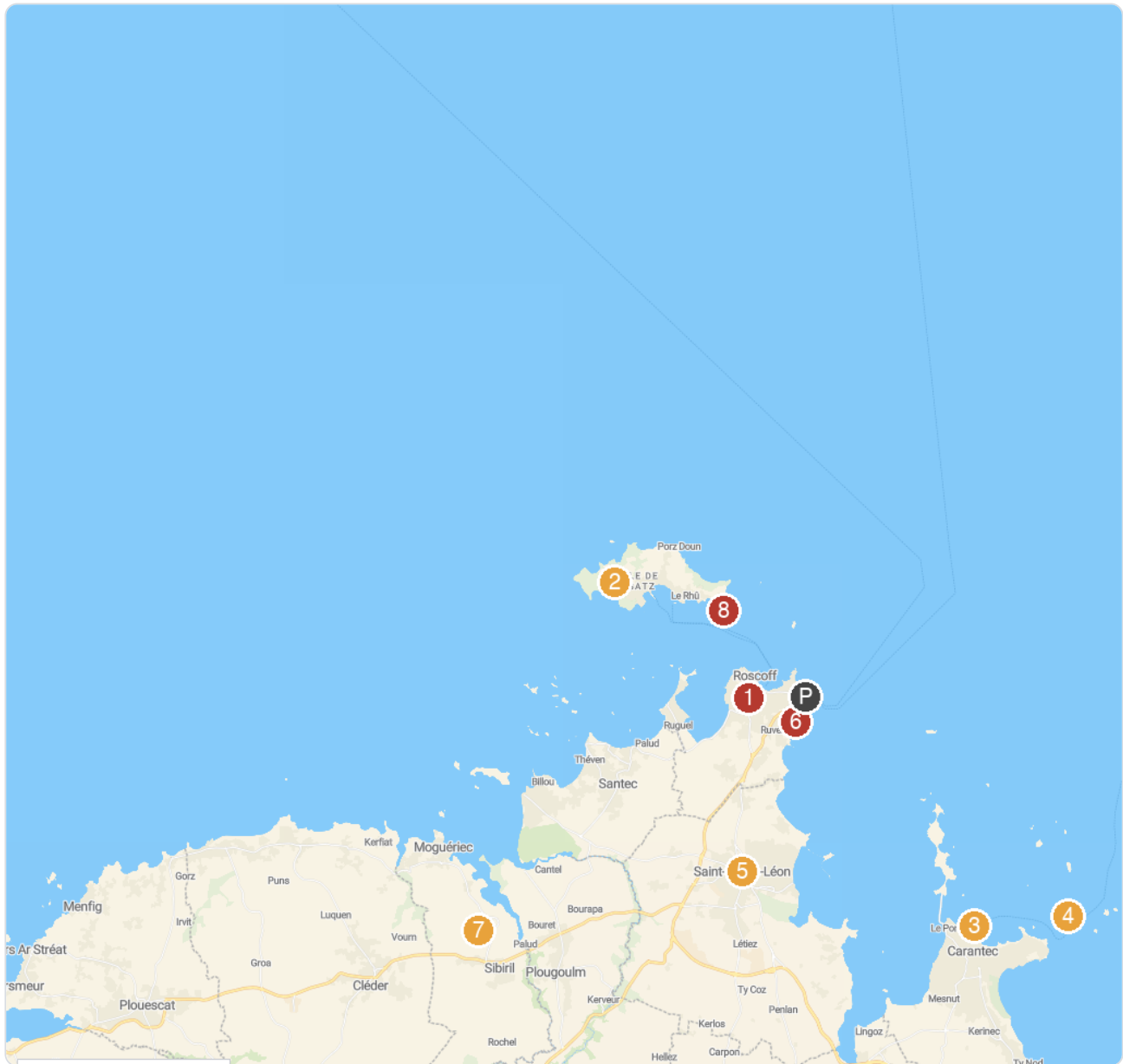
