GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Small/luxury ships dock at marina pier; large vessels tender from the Gulf of Roses

Best For: History, beaches, Dalí excursions, seafood, coastal hiking

Walk to centre: 5–10 min along the flat seafront promenade from pier or tender dock

Don't Miss: Ciutadella de Roses, the Camí de Ronda coastal path, and a bowl of Suquet de Peix

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Ciutadella de Roses** — A 17th-century star fortress enclosing 2,500 years of history: the Greek colony of Rhode (4th c.
- **Figueres — Dalí Theatre-Museum** — Salvador Dalí's hometown, about 20 km inland.
- **Cadaqués & Dalí House-Museum** — A whitewashed fishing village over the mountains from Roses, and the most photographed town on the Costa Brava.
- **Cap de Creus Natural Park** — The easternmost point of the Spanish mainland, where the Pyrenees plunge into the sea.
- **Empuriabrava Canals** — One of the world's largest residential marinas, 15 min south of Roses — over 24 km of navigable canals lined with villas.

BEST WALKS

- **Promenade to Ciutadella Loop** 2.5 km · 45 min · Easy · Flat — Head south from the pier along the palm-lined Passeig Marítim, browsing sculptures and seafood terraces.
- **Camí de Ronda — Roses to Canyelles Petites** 3 km one way · 40 min · Easy–Moderate · Coastal cliffs — Pick up the Camí de Ronda coastal path near the Far de Roses (lighthouse) and follow it east along dramatic cliffs and through pine...

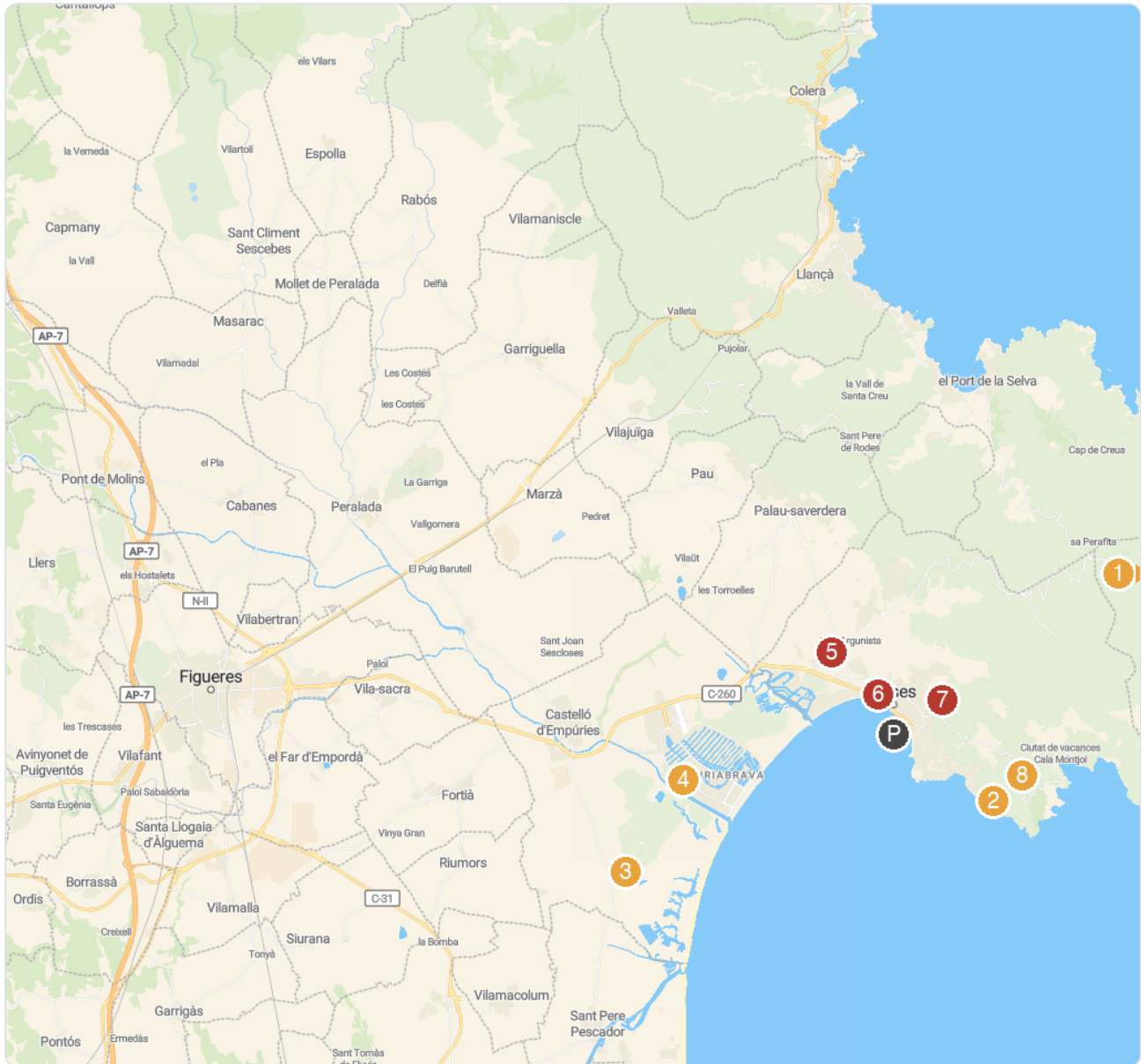
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Tendering can be skipped: if the Tramuntana wind is blowing hard, tender operations may be delayed or suspended. Check ship announcements before planning your day.
- Roses Express tourist train departs from the promenade near the pier. It's a cheap, easy way to reach Castell de la Trinitat and the
