GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — shuttle bus from ship to passenger terminal (walking through the working port is not permitted)

Best For: History lovers, beach walkers, and those craving authentic small-town Ireland

Walk to centre: Rosslare Harbour village is a 5–10 min walk uphill from the terminal; Wexford Town is 25 min by train

Don't Miss: Hook Lighthouse — over 800 years old and still operational, one of the oldest in the world

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Wexford Town Viking Heritage Walk** — Founded by the Vikings in the 9th century, Wexford is a maze of narrow medieval streets.
- **Hook Lighthouse & Peninsula** — Built by the Normans over 800 years ago, Hook Lighthouse is one of the oldest operational lighthouses in the world.
- **Irish National Heritage Park** — A 40-acre outdoor museum near Ferrycarrig depicting 9,000 years of Irish history — from Stone Age huts and Celtic ring...
- **Dunbrody Famine Ship, New Ross** — A full-scale replica of an 1840s emigrant vessel, this moving interactive experience tells the story of the Irish who...
- **Rosslare Strand Beach Day** — A Blue Flag sandy beach stretching for miles, backed by dunes — officially in Ireland's sunniest county.

BEST WALKS

- **Terminal to Rosslare Harbour Village** 0.5 km · 10 min · Easy (uphill path with ramps) — From the passenger terminal, follow the paved path up the hill to Rosslare Harbour village.
- **Rosslare Strand Seafront Walk** 2-4 km · 45-60 min · Easy · Access by train (6 min) — Take the train one stop to Rosslare Strand, then walk the length of this gorgeous Blue Flag beach.

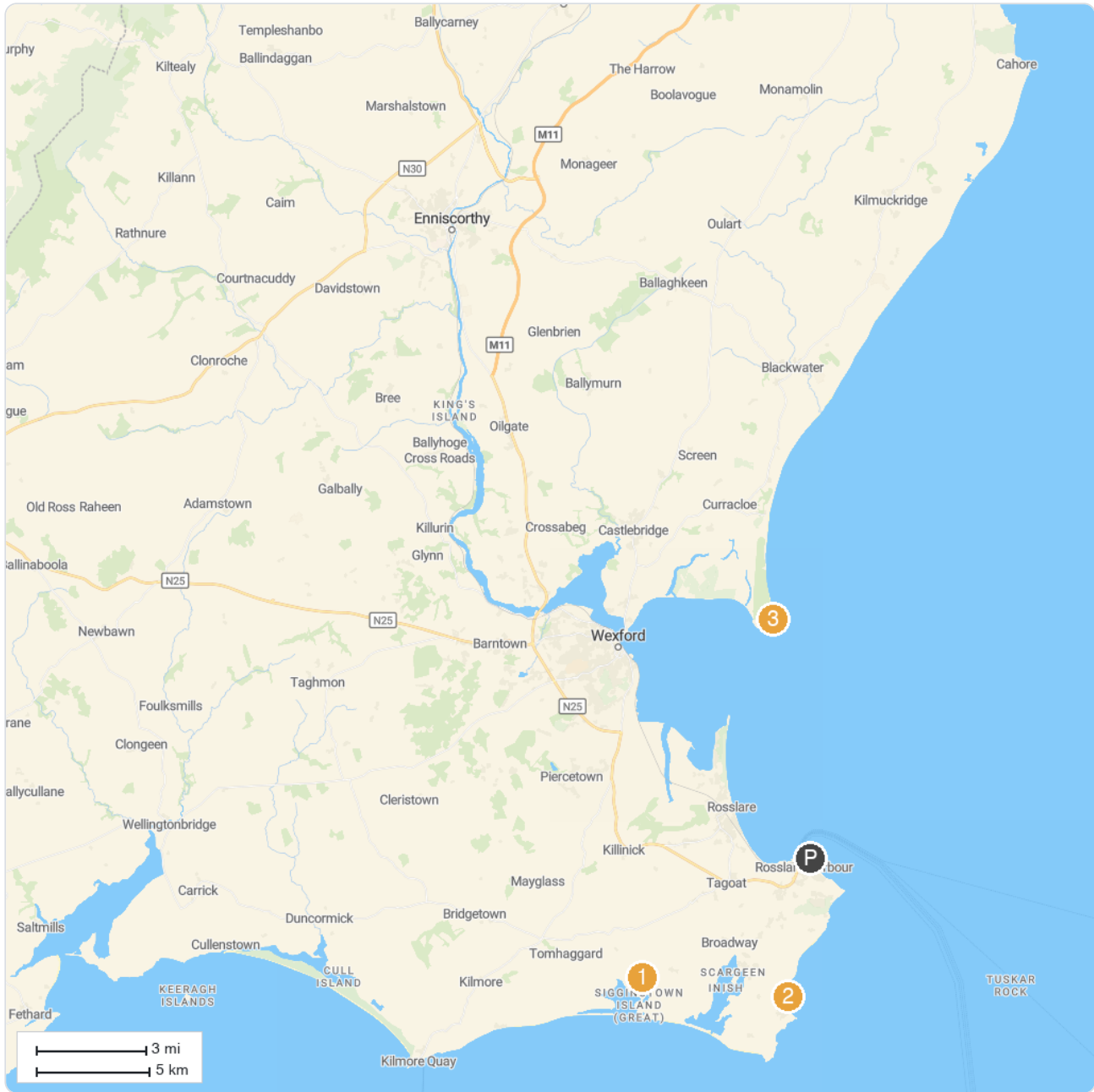
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Use the train. The station is steps from the terminal — it's the easiest and cheapest way to reach Wexford Town (25 min) or Rosslare Strand beach (6 min). Check [Iarnród Éireann](#)...
- Pre-book taxis for longer trips. The taxi rank can be overwhelmed when ships arrive. If you're planning Hook Lighthouse, Dunbrody, or New Ross, arrange a local driver in advance.
- Ireland's sunniest county — still bring a layer. Wexford gets more sunshine than anywhere else in Ireland, but 'sunny' Irish weather still means pack a light waterproof and dress...
