- Plönlein & City Wall Walk** — Start at the famous Plönlein — a crooked yellow half-timbered house at a cobblestone fork framed by two medieval towers.
- St. Jakob's Church & Holy Blood Altarpiece** — This soaring Gothic church houses Tilman Riemenschneider's masterpiece — the 15th-century Altar of the Holy Blood...
- Medieval Crime & Justice Museum** — Europe's leading museum of legal history occupies a sprawling complex near the walls.
- Käthe Wohlfahrt Christmas Village** — Year-round Christmas in a massive, beautifully decorated shop stocked floor-to-ceiling with traditional German...
- Town Hall Tower Climb** — Climb 220 steps up the Rathausturm for the best 360-degree aerial view of Rothenburg's red-tiled rooftops and the...

BEST WALKS

- Old Town Highlights Loop** 2–3 km · 1.5–2 hrs · Easy–Moderate · Free — The essential Rothenburg circuit from the bus parking to all major sights and back.
- Tauber Valley Descent** 1.5 km one way · 45–60 min · Moderate · Free — From the Castle Garden, a wooded path zigzags steeply down to the valley floor.

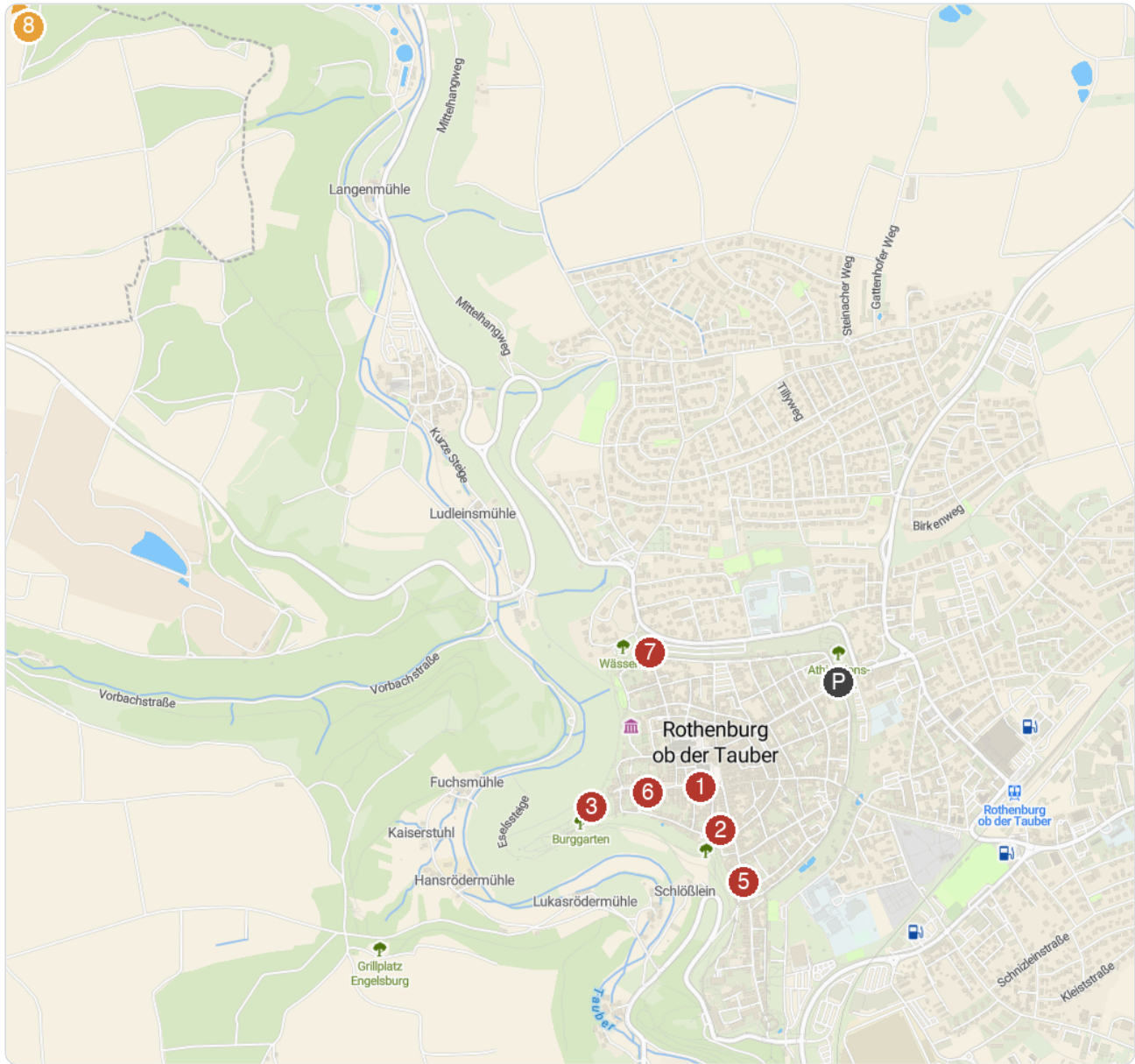
