Docking: Riverboat berth on Canalbianco canal, ~2-3 km from center

Best For: Medieval towers, Renaissance art, Po Delta nature

Walk to center: 20-30 min on foot; most lines run a free shuttle

Don't Miss: Torre Donà (51 m brick tower) & La Rotonda octagonal church

Getting around: Taxi €8–€15

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Torre Donà & Medieval Towers** — The 51-metre Torre Donà in Piazza Matteotti is one of Italy's tallest surviving medieval brick towers and Rovigo's...
 - Palazzo Roverella Art Gallery** — This stunning Renaissance palace hosts world-class temporary exhibitions — often French Impressionism or Italian...
 - La Rotonda — Beata Vergine del Soccorso** — Rovigo's unique octagonal 16th-century sanctuary is entirely lined with
- giant 17th-century canvas paintings.

 - Po Delta Natural Park** — A UNESCO Biosphere Reserve 45 minutes from Rovigo, the Po Delta is one of Europe's great wetlands — home to pink...
 - Museo dei Grandi Fiumi** — Housed in a beautifully restored Olivetan monastery, this interactive museum traces Po and Adige river civilizations...

BEST WALKS

- Historic Center Loop** 2-3 km · 45-60 min · Easy — From the main piazza, explore Rovigo's elegant core: two medieval towers, the Duomo, and the ornate Palazzo Roverella.
- La Rotonda & Outer Monuments** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy — A short walk southwest from the center leads to Rovigo's extraordinary octagonal sanctuary, La Rotonda, set amid a small garden.

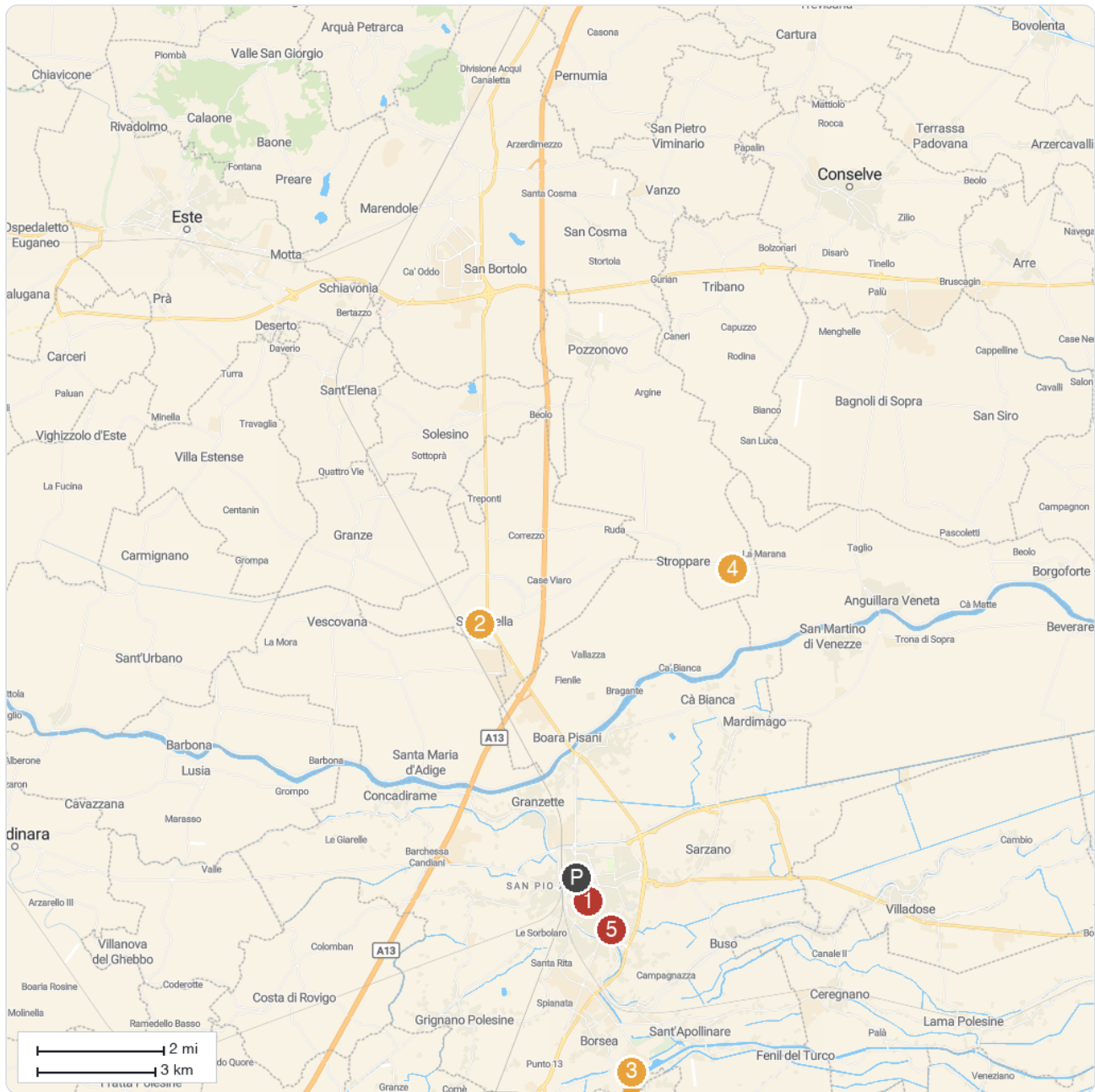
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
