TOP THINGS TO DO

- Ivanovo Rock-Hewn Churches (UNESCO)** — Chapels and monasteries carved into the cliffs of Rusenski Lom Nature Park, featuring vivid 14th-century frescoes.
 - Sexaginta Prista Roman Fortress** — Open-air ruins of a Roman naval fortress ('Sixty Ships') just a 5-minute walk from the ship.
 - Freedom Square & Old Town Walk** — Self-guided stroll through Ruse's finest Neo-Baroque streetscapes — the
- Monument of Liberty, Dohodno Zdanie theatre...

 - Regional Historical Museum** — Housed in the former Battenberg Palace, this museum holds the Borovo Treasure — a stunning Thracian silver feast set...
 - Basarbovo Cave Monastery** — The only active cave monastery in Bulgaria, built directly into the limestone cliffs of the Rusenski Lom river valley...

BEST WALKS

- Quay to Freedom Square Stroll** 1.5 km · 20 min · Easy · Mostly flat — The essential Ruse introduction: follow the riverside promenade north through Pridunavski Park, turn onto Aleksandrovska Street and...
- Old Town Architecture Loop** 2.5 km · 35 min · Easy — From Freedom Square, loop through the backstreets past the Regional Historical Museum on Alexander Battenberg Square, the underground...
