GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Saaremaa Harbour handles ships up to ~200 m; no tender required for most vessels

Best For: Medieval history, nature, quiet Baltic charm, day-tripper cycling

Into Kuressaare: Roomassaare pier is ~5 km from Kuressaare's Old Town; free shuttle or short taxi/bus ride on call days

Don't Miss: Kuressaare Episcopal Castle & Kaali Meteorite Crater

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Kuressaare Episcopal Castle** — One of the best-preserved medieval castles in the Baltic, the 14th-century Kuressaare Castle houses the Saaremaa Museum.
- Kaali Meteorite Crater** — The Kaali crater field — nine ancient impact craters, the largest forming a mirror-still lake — is the first...
- Angla Windmill Hill** — A cluster of five traditional wooden windmills on an open hilltop, some dating to the early 20th century.
- Panga Cliff Coastal Walk** — The highest bedrock sea cliff in western Estonia (about 21 m) on the northern coast drops dramatically into the Baltic.
- Kuressaare Spa Day** — Kuressaare has a long spa tradition fed by therapeutic muds and sea water.

BEST WALKS

- Old Town to Castle Loop** ~3 km · 45-60 min · easy — From the shuttle drop-off in Kuressaare's Old Town, stroll along Tallinna tänav, visit the castle and moat park, then loop back...
- Castle to Beach Promenade** ~2 km · 30 min · flat — Head south from the castle park along the shoreline promenade to Kuressaare Beach — a pleasant sandy stretch popular with locals...
