GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Docked alongside Quai National or Quai de la Hutte — no tender

Walk to center: 2–5 min from gangway to cafes and church

Best For: Burgundy wine, canal culture, cycling, day trips to Dijon/Beaune

Don't Miss: Pochouse stew and a stroll around the canal basin

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Dijon Day Trip** — The Burgundy capital is 40 km away — reachable by ship excursion or independent train in 25 minutes.
 - **Beaune Wine Country** — Beaune, about 42 km away, is the wine capital of Burgundy.
 - **Voie Bleue Cycling** — The Voie Bleue is a flat, paved riverside bike path that runs along the Saône and canals.

- **Town Historic Walk** — Explore Saint-Jean-de-Losne on foot: the brick Gothic church of Saint-Jean-Baptiste, the 17th-century Hôtel de Ville...
 - **Musée de la Batellerie** — Housed in one of the oldest timber-framed buildings in town (15th century), this small museum traces the history of...

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town & Canal Basin Loop** 1.5 km · 30–40 min · flat — From the Saône quay, walk into the old town to the Église Saint-Jean-Baptiste, then north past the Hôtel de Ville to the canal marina...
- **Riverside Path to Losne** 2 km round trip · 40 min · flat — Cross the bridge over the Saône to the adjacent commune of Losne, where the train station is located.

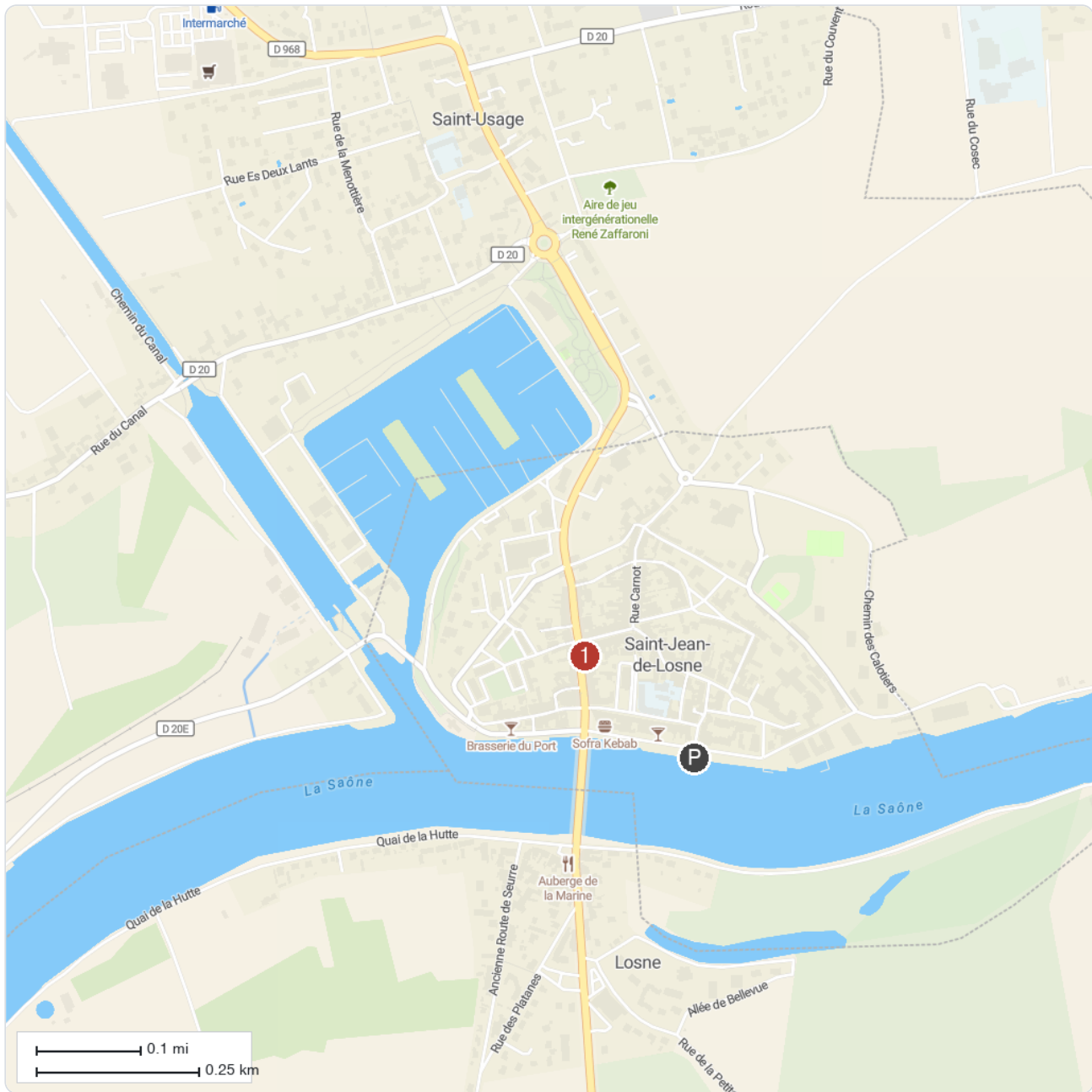
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Bring or borrow a bike. Saint-Jean-de-Losne sits on the Voie Bleue, one of France's best flat cycling routes. Many river cruise ships carry bikes — use them here.
- Order Pochouse. This Burgundian freshwater fish stew is the local specialty — pike, perch, and eel in Aligoté wine. Restaurants
