GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in the Gulf of Saint-Tropez; tenders land at the Vieux Port

Best For: Strolling the old quarter, art museums, market days (Tue/Sat), beach clubs

Walk to Center: 0 min — you step off the tender directly onto the Old Port quay

Don't Miss: La Tarte Tropézienne from the original Place des Lices shop

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  €5–7 base + €2.20/km; local rides typically €30–40 ·  **Rideshare**  Uber, Bolt

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Pampelonne Beach & the Famous Beach Clubs** — The legendary 3-mile sandy stretch — home to Club 55, Nikki Beach, and dozens of other iconic clubs — is 6 km south of...
- **Citadelle de Saint-Tropez & Maritime Museum** — A 17th-century fortress crowning the hill above town.
- **Musée de l'Annonciade** — A stunning collection of Modernist paintings — Signac, Matisse, Derain, Dufy — housed in a 16th-century chapel just off...
- **Sentier du Littoral Coastal Walk** — A hiking path that begins beyond the Citadel and follows the rocky coastline south, offering wild Mediterranean scenery...
- **Place des Lices Market (Tue & Sat)** — Saint-Tropez's legendary twice-weekly open-air market fills the town square with lavender, local cheeses, olives...

BEST WALKS

- **Vieux Port to La Ponche Old Quarter** Easy · 30–45 min · 1 km — The classic Saint-Tropez loop.
- **Up to the Citadel** Moderate · 30 min up · 1.2 km — From Place des Lices, follow Rue de la Citadelle uphill to the 17th-century fortress.
- **To Plage des Graniers** Easy · 20 min · 1.5 km — Walk past the Citadel and down the other side to reach Plage des Graniers — a wild, sandy cove with a laid-back beach restaurant.

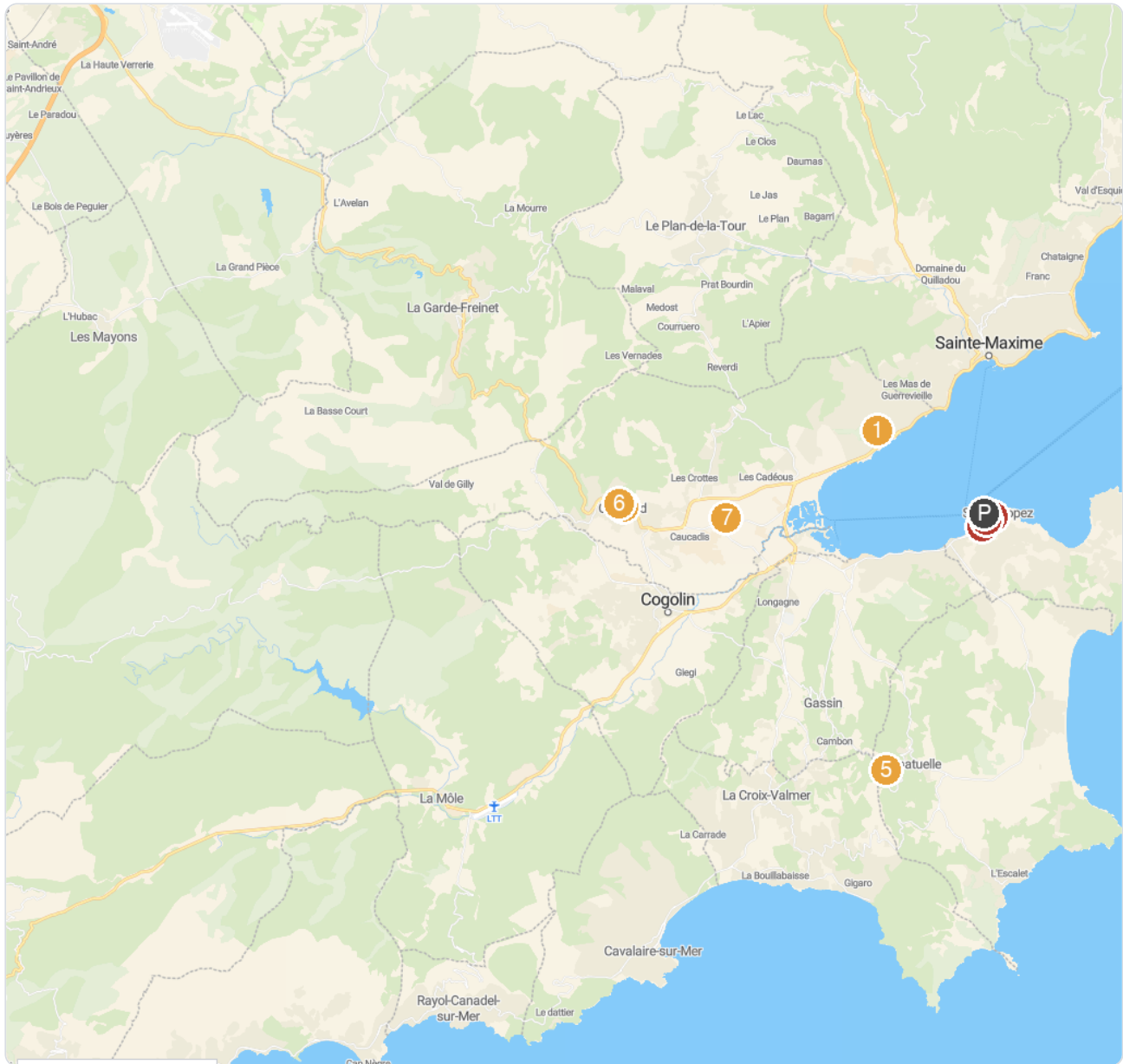
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Build in tender buffer time. Return queues can be 30–60 minutes on busy days. If multiple ships are anchored, aim to be back at the tender dock 90 minutes before all-aboard.
