

Sainte Anne Island, Seychelles

The Seychelles' oldest marine sanctuary wraps six pristine islands in crystalline water. Giant tortoises roam a neighboring isle, manta rays glide through the channel, and white-sand beaches framed by granite boulders look exactly like the postcards.

Don't Miss: Sainte Anne Channel snorkeling (150+ species) and Moyenne Island giant tortoises

- **Marine Park Catamaran & Snorkel** — The classic Sainte Anne day: cruise the marine park on a catamaran with multiple snorkel stops in the Sainte Anne...
- **Moyenne Island Tortoises & Nature Trail** — A 10-minute boat hop from Sainte Anne, Moyenne Island is a national park with free-roaming Aldabra giant tortoises...
- **Club Med Seychelles Day Pass** — The entire island is privately run by Club Med.
- **Scuba Diving the Granite Reefs** — Dive sites in the marine park range from 10–30 m over dramatic granite reef formations.
- **Semi-Submersible Reef Safari** — Prefer to stay dry? Board a semi-submersible or glass-bottom boat for an eye-level view of the reef gardens and...

- **Anse Cabot Beach Stroll** Easy · ~30 min · Free (public beach to high-water mark) — The western shore beaches — Anse Cabot and Anse Cimetière — are gentle walks along white sand backed by granite boulders and casuarina...

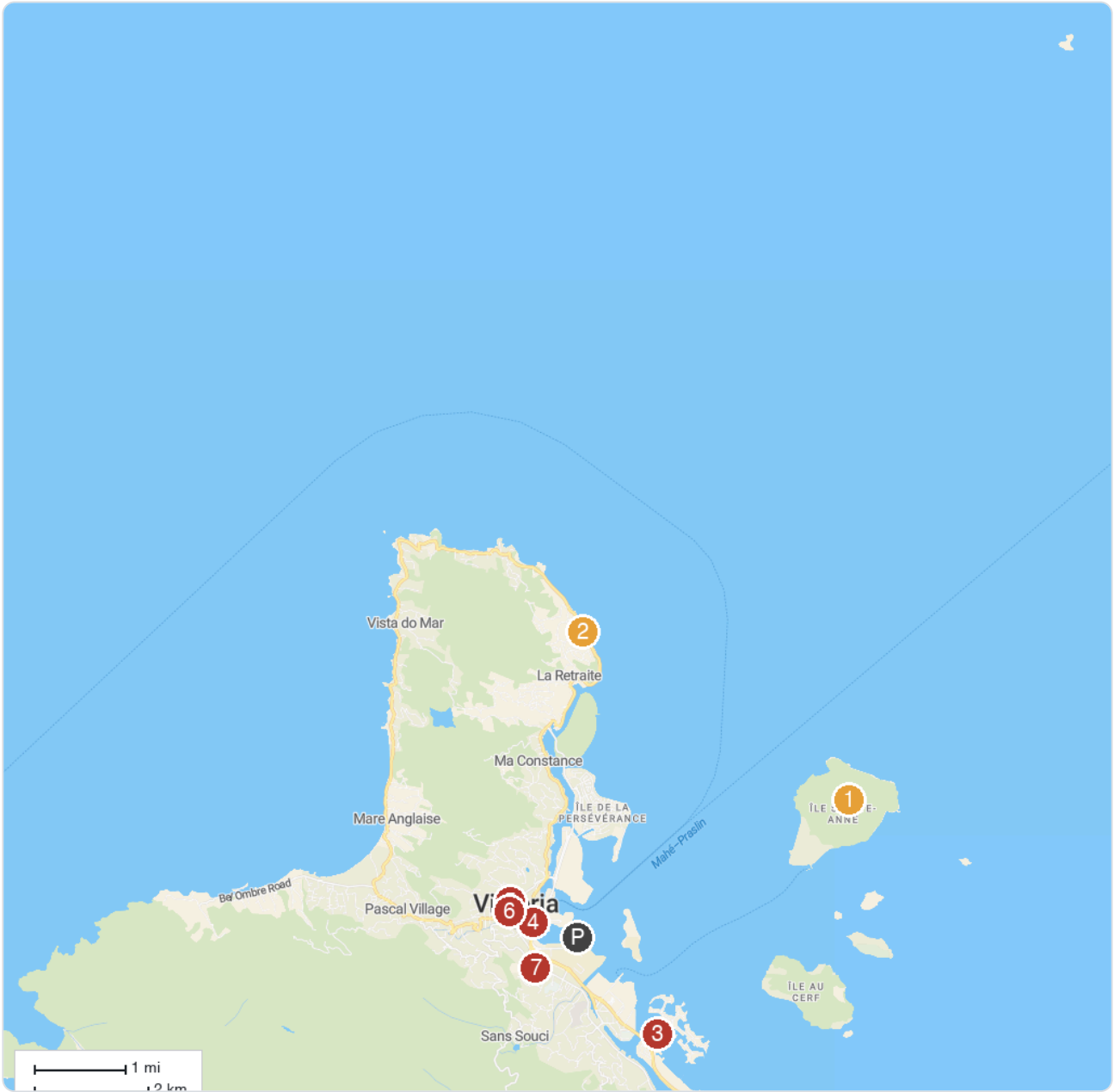
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
