GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Vathy: pier for ships up to 150 m; Pythagorion: anchor + tender

Best For: Ancient history, beaches, wine tasting, scenic hill villages

Walk to center: Vathy old port: immediate; Malagari pier: ~15 min walk. Pythagorion: immediate from tender dock

Don't Miss: Tunnel of Eupalinos (Pythagorion) or Kouros statue at Vathy's Archaeological Museum

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  €5–€15 ·  **Rideshare**  not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Tunnel of Eupalinos** — A 1,036-meter aqueduct carved through a mountain in the 6th century BC — dug simultaneously from both ends and meeting...
- **Heraion & Archaeological Museum** — Visit the Temple of Hera — once one of the largest Greek temples ever built — then head to Vathy's Archaeological...
- **Beach Day — Psili Ammos or Potokaki** — Psili Ammos offers shallow, fine-sand water with Turkey's coast visible across the strait.
- **Samos Muscat Wine Tasting** — The island's sweet White Muscat — Samos Nectar and Samos Vin Doux — has been prized since antiquity.
- **Ano Vathy Village Walk** — A steep 15-minute climb above Vathy port leads to the old town, a preserved maze of narrow lanes, 19th-century stone...

BEST WALKS

- **Pythagorion Harbor & Pythagoras Statue** 1.5 km · 30-45 min · Flat · Easy — From the tender dock, stroll the pedestrianized promenade west past waterfront tavernas, continue to the eastern breakwater to find...
- **Vathy Waterfront to Ano Vathy** 2 km loop · 1 hr · Hilly finish · Moderate — Start at Pythagoras Square on the Vathy waterfront, walk the harbor promenade, then head uphill through the neoclassical streets of...

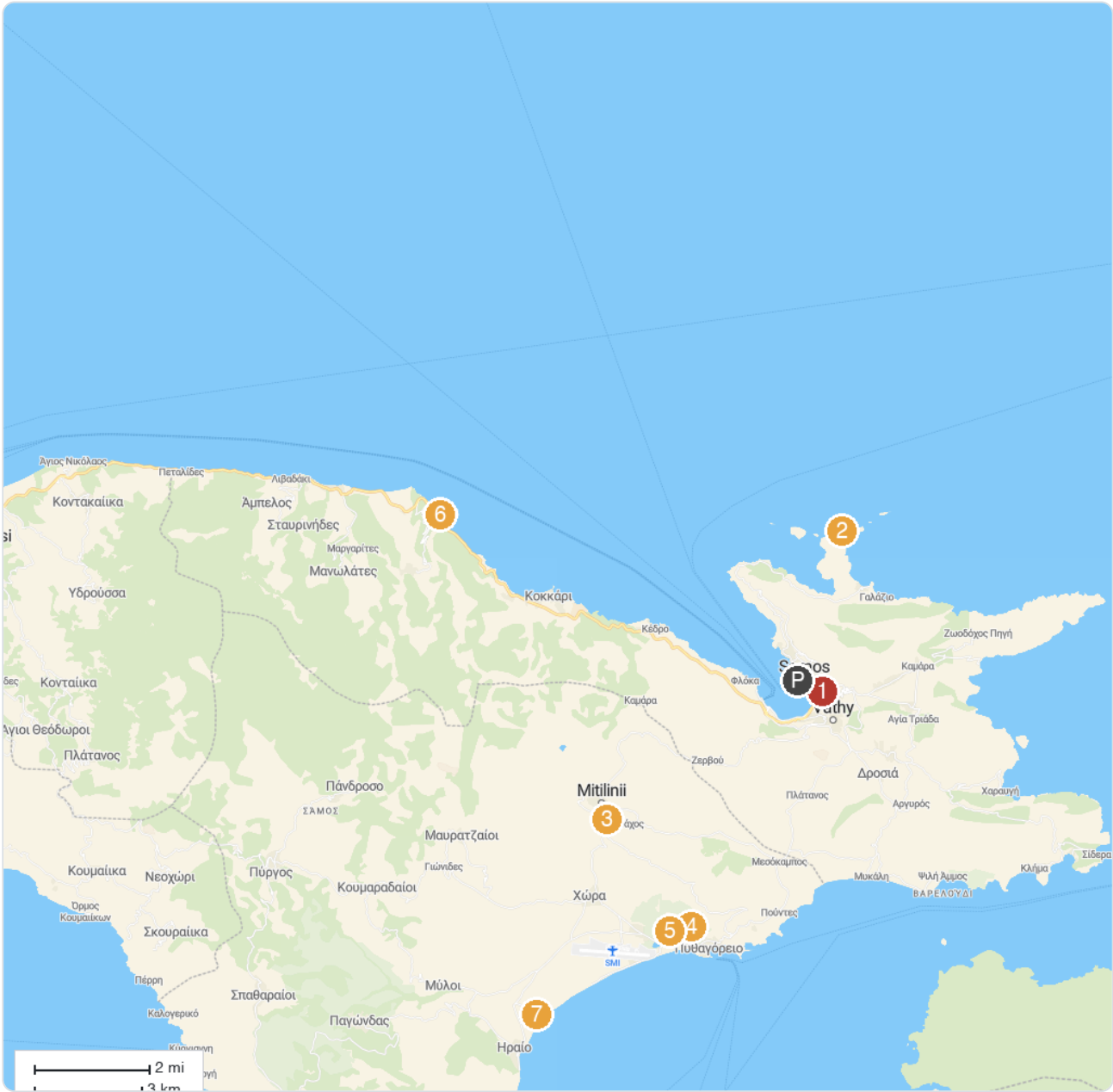
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
