GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor offshore; boats run to The Cove Embarcadero (new pier, 2023)

Best For: Snorkeling, natural pools, duty-free shopping, fresh seafood

To El Centro: ~15 km / 30-45 min by taxi or golf cart from The Cove Embarcadero (opposite end of island)

Don't Miss: Johnny Cay islet, Acuario sandbar, West View natural swimming hole

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Johnny Cay & Acuario Snorkel Combo** — Boat out to Johnny Cay — a palm-fringed coral islet with white sand and iguanas — then drift over the Acuario sandbar...
 - **Golf Cart Island Loop** — Rent a 2- or 4-seater golf cart and drive the full perimeter road in 45-60 minutes, stopping at El Hoyo Soplador...
 - **West View Natural Swimming Holes** — Rocky-coast eco-park on the island's west side featuring massive natural
- swimming pools carved into coral rock, an...

 - **Morgan's Cave & Pirate Museum** — Explore the cave where pirate Henry Morgan allegedly stashed treasure, paired with a small museum covering pirate...
 - **Rondon & Coco Loco Food Tour** — Taste Raizal cuisine — the traditional rondon stew (fish, conch, coconut milk, yam, and dumplings), crab patties...

BEST WALKS

- **El Centro & Spratt Bight Boardwalk** 1.4 km · 20 min · Easy · Flat paved promenade — After taxiing into town from the pier, stroll the duty-free streets of El Centro, then walk the Malecón promenade along Spratt Bight...
- **Cocoplum Bay to Rocky Cay Wade** Short drive then 200 m wade · 1.5 hrs · Easy · Sandy bottom — Take a taxi or golf cart to Cocoplum Bay on the east coast, then wade chest-deep across the channel to Rocky Cay, a small rocky islet...

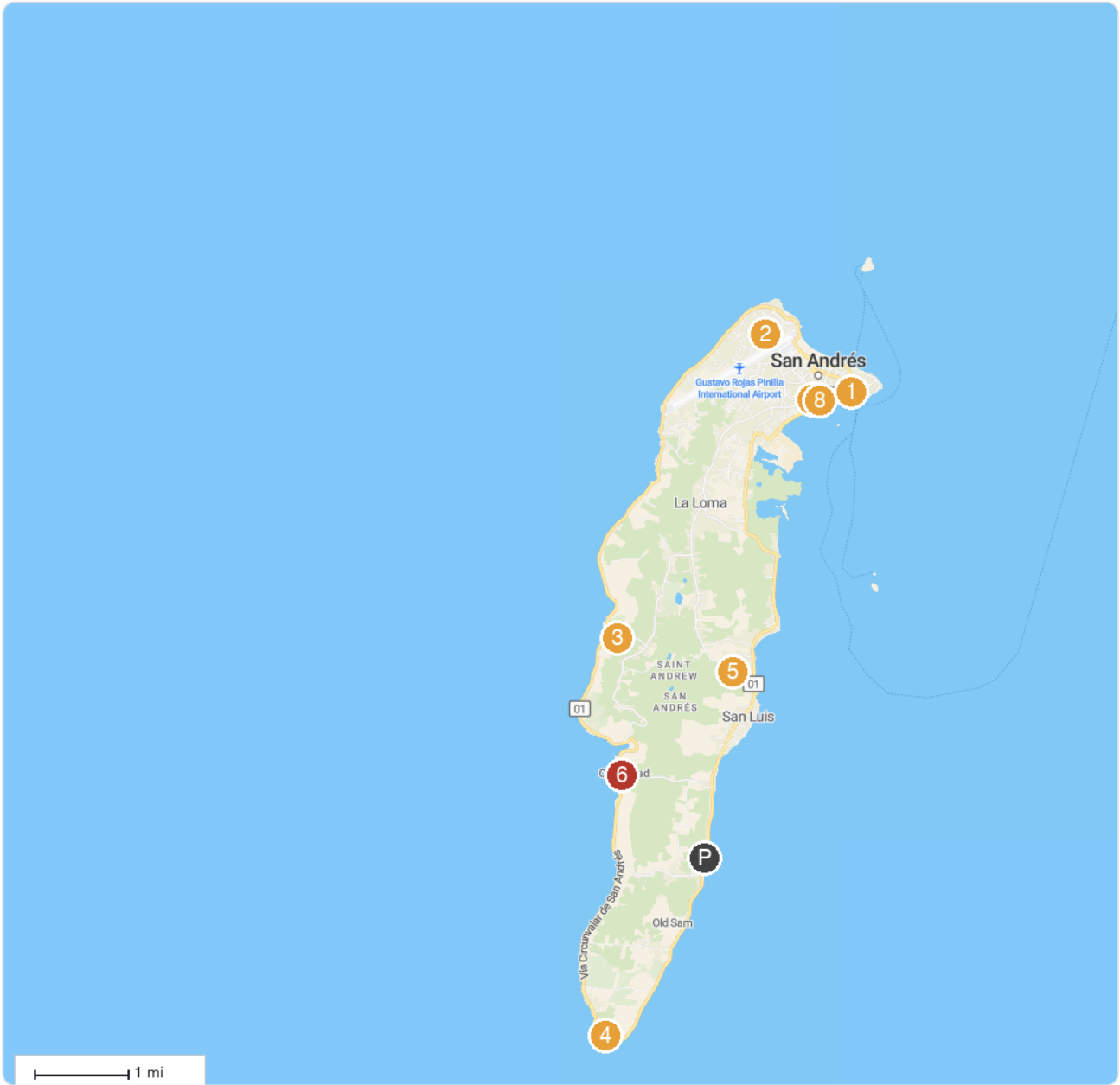
