TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Isla Negra — Pablo Neruda's Clifftop House** — Chile's most visited literary site sits 30 minutes north on a windswept cliff.
- **Valparaíso & Viña del Mar** — UNESCO-listed Valparaíso is Chile's most photogenic city — steep hills, historic funicular elevators (ascensores), and...
- **Casablanca Valley Wine Tasting** — One of the world's premier cool-climate wine regions lies 45 minutes northeast.
- **Santiago City Tour** — Chile's capital is 90–120 minutes east.
- **Humedal Río Maipo Birdwatching** — The wetlands at the mouth of the Maipo River, just south of the port, shelter thousands of migratory birds including...

BEST WALKS

- **Paseo Bellamar & the Sea Lions** 1.5 km · Flat · 30–45 min — From the passenger terminal, head north along the Paseo Bellamar boardwalk past craft stalls and seafood vendors.
- **Mirador 21 de Mayo Viewpoint** 2 km round-trip · Uphill · 45 min — From the terminal, walk uphill through the town center to this hilltop viewpoint.

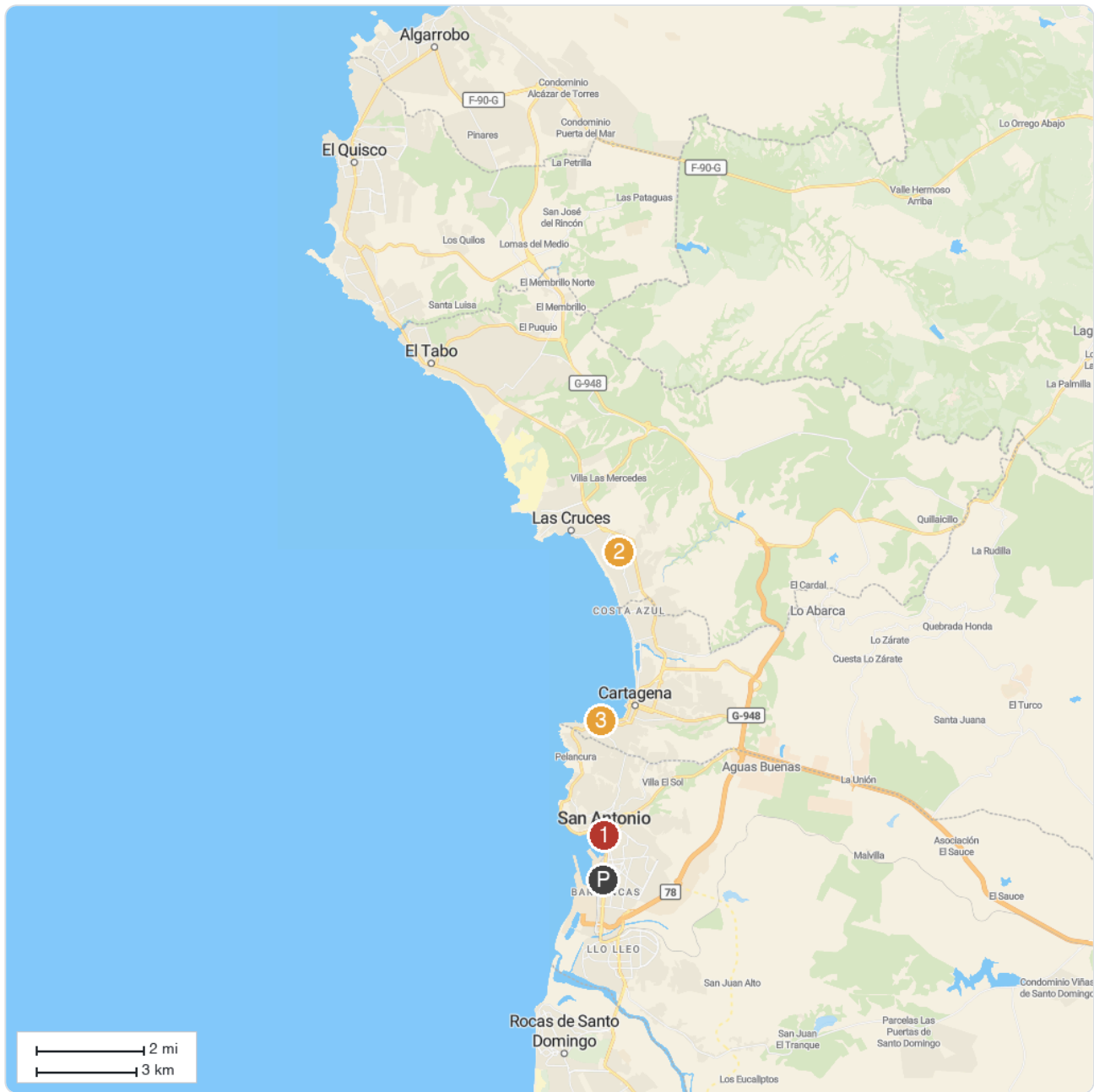
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Book excursions early. San Antonio is primarily a turnaround port — independent tours fill up fast. Isla Negra tickets also require online booking well in advance.
- Carry Chilean pesos (CLP) for market stalls, local taxis, and tips. Major restaurants and wineries accept credit cards but local vendors on Paseo Bellamar are cash only.
