GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships tender into Cabo San Lucas marina; San José del Cabo is ~20 miles NE by taxi or bus

Best For: Art galleries, colonial architecture, estuary birdwatching, farm-to-table dining

Walk to Center: Not walkable from ship — taxi \$40-60 USD or public bus ~\$3 to Plaza Mijares

Don't Miss: Thursday Art Walk (Nov–Jun), Estero San José, Plaza Mijares & Mission church

TOP THINGS TO DO

- San José del Cabo Historic Art District** — Stroll cobblestone Calle Álvaro Obregón and the streets around Plaza Mijares, lined with high-end galleries showing...
- Estero San José Estuary Walk** — A protected freshwater lagoon where the river meets the sea, just east of the hotel zone.
- Farm-to-Table Lunch at Flora Farms or Acre** — San José del Cabo anchors one of Mexico's best farm-to-table scenes.
- Mission San José del Cabo & Plaza Mijares** — Founded in 1730, this Spanish colonial mission faces the main plaza.
- ATV & Desert Off-Road Tour** — Ride ATVs or UTVs through Baja's desert into arroyos and onto beach stretches.

BEST WALKS

- Plaza Mijares & Gallery District Loop** 1.2 km · 30-40 min · Easy cobblestones — Start at Plaza Mijares, visit the Mission church, then head east on Calle Álvaro Obregón through the gallery district.
- Estero San José Boardwalk** 1.5 km · 40 min · Flat boardwalk — From the east end of the hotel zone, follow the estuary boardwalk along the lagoon edge.

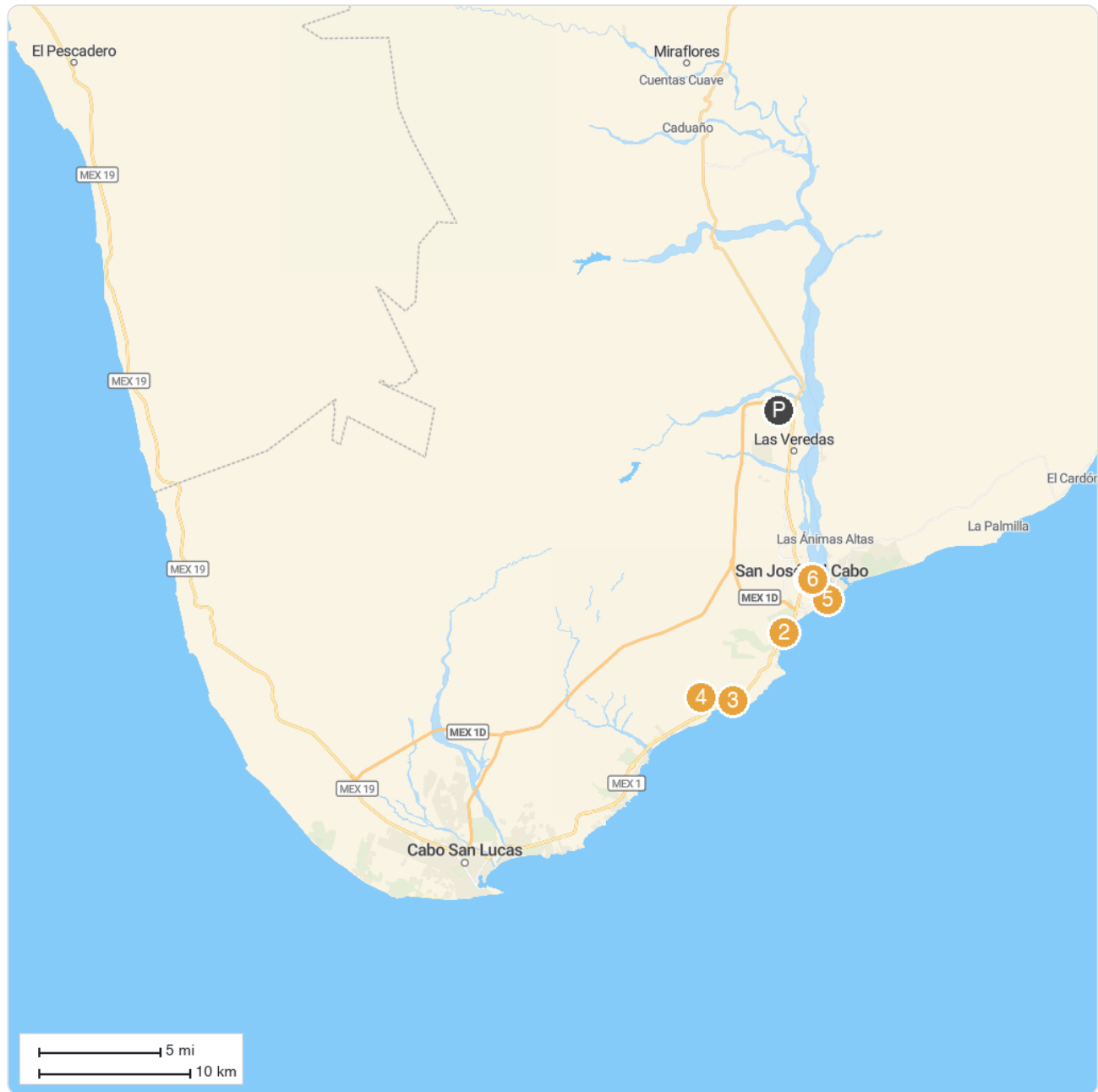
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Time is your biggest constraint. Factor in: tender queue (~45 min), taxi to SJD (~35 min), time in town, taxi back (~35 min), and tender back to ship. Leave SJD by 2.5 hrs before...
- USD works everywhere, but paying in pesos saves you 5-10%. ATMs are available near Plaza Mijares. Avoid the marina money.
