

Sandnessjøen, Helgeland, Norway

Seven jagged peaks loom over a compact island town just south of the Arctic Circle — Sandnessjøen packs Viking legends, a medieval churchyard, and some of Norway's most dramatic coastal scenery into a short shore day.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Horvnes Quay, ~10 min walk to town

Best For: Mountain scenery, Viking history, coastal walks

Walk to centre: 10–15 min from Horvnes; town fully walkable

Don't Miss: Views of De Syv Søstre (Seven Sisters) & Petter Dass Museum

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  100–150 NOK (~\$9–14 USD)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Seven Sisters (De Syv Søstre) Hike** — The seven jagged peaks rising across the sound are the defining image of Sandnessjøen.
- Petter Dass Museum & Alstahaug Medieval Church** — About 12 km south of town, the Alstahaug rectory was home to 17th-century poet-priest Petter Dass.
- RIB Safari through the Helgeland Archipelago** — Speed across the island-dotted Helgeland coast in a rigid inflatable boat, spotting white-tailed eagles, cormorants...
- Island Cycling — Herøy or Dønna** — Take a ferry to flat, scenic Herøy (Herøy church, Herøy Museum) or Dønna (medieval church, Dønnes mountain viewpoint).
- White Nights or Northern Lights Experience** — Summer calls (late May–July) enjoy near-perpetual bright 'white nights' — Sandnessjøen sits just south of the Arctic...

BEST WALKS

- Harbour & Town Centre Stroll** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy — Walk from the Horvnes pier along the harbour front into town, passing the marina, local cafes, and the small commercial centre.
- Helgeland Bridge Viewpoint** ~3 km one-way · 1 hr · Easy–moderate — Walk or cycle out to view the Helgelandsbrua cable-stayed bridge connecting Alsta island to the mainland — a striking piece of...

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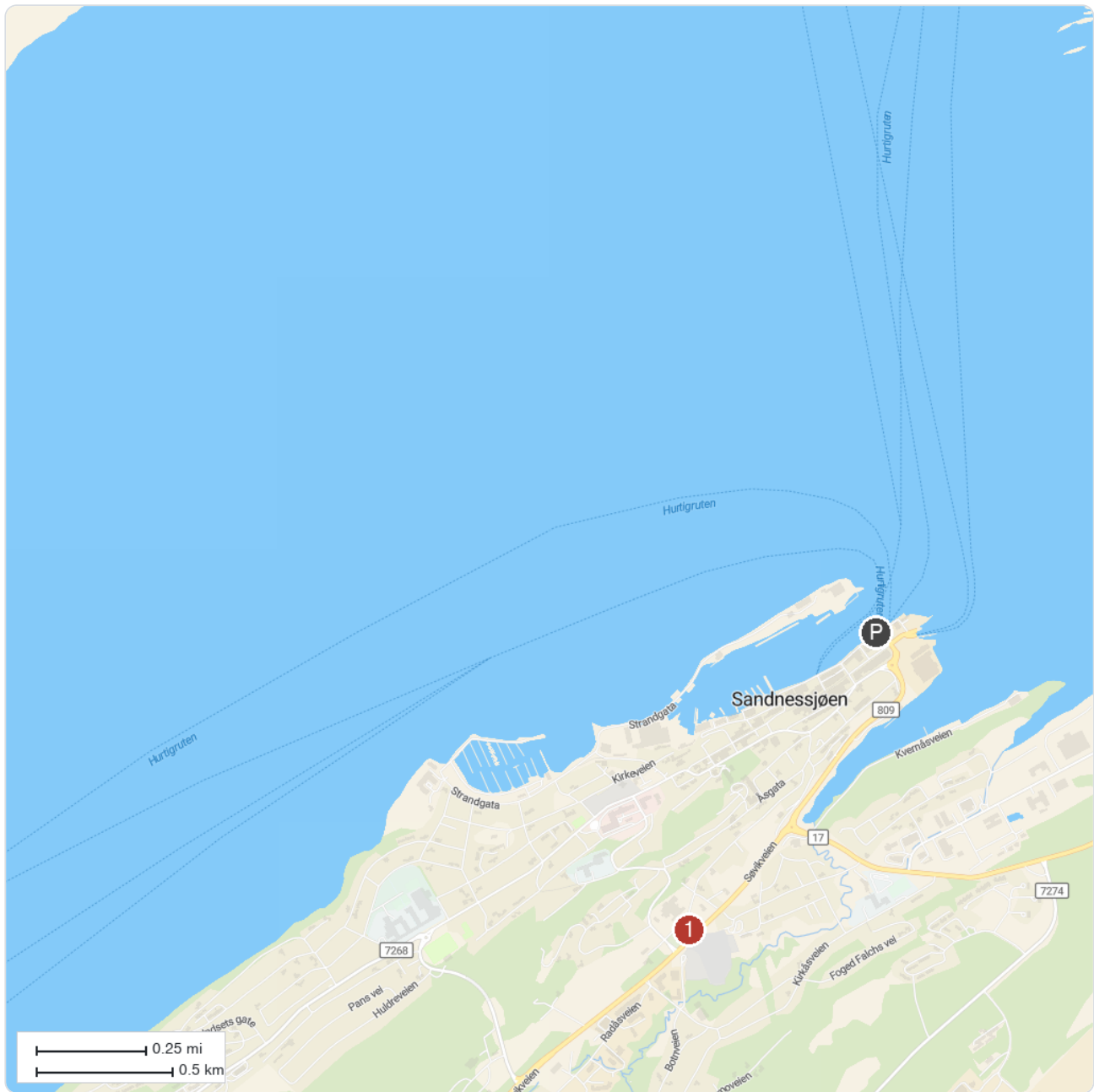
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
