GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor offshore; tenders land at Maseline Harbour or Creux Harbour

Best For: Cycling, cliff walks, La Coupée isthmus, cream teas, total digital detox

Walk to centre: Steep Harbour Hill climb (~10 min) or ride the iconic "Toast-Rack" tractor-bus (£2 cash)

Don't Miss: La Coupée — a 260 ft drop on either side of a narrow stone causeway connecting Great & Little Sark

 Getting around:  **Rideshare** ❌ not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **La Coupée & Little Sark** — Walk the narrow stone causeway with a 260-foot sheer drop on both sides to reach Little Sark.
- **Bicycle Island Circuit** — Hire a bike at the top of Harbour Hill and loop Sark's gravel lanes past cliff-top viewpoints, La Seigneurie, and the...
- **La Seigneurie Gardens** — Visit the walled gardens of the island's feudal lord.
- **Dixcart Bay Beach** — A 20-minute walk downhill through wooded Dixcart Valley brings you to a secluded pebble-and-sand beach framed by high...
- **Sark Village & Cream Tea** — Wander The Avenue, peek into the Sark Museum (donation entry), find the world's smallest active prison (two cells), and...

BEST WALKS

- **Village to La Coupée** 5 km round trip · 1.5-2 hrs · Mostly flat — From The Avenue walk southwest along Rue de la Seigneurie past La Seigneurie Gardens, then continue to La Coupée — Sark's legendary...
- **Harbour Hill to Dixcart Bay** 3 km round trip · 1-1.5 hrs · Downhill out, uphill return — From the village head east through Dixcart Valley woodland to reach Dixcart Bay beach.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Cash for the Toast-Rack: The tractor-bus up Harbour Hill costs ~£2 each way and strongly prefers cash. Cards are widely accepted in the village, but bring GBP notes.
- Extreme tides: The Channel Islands have one of the world's largest tidal ranges (up to 40 ft). A beach accessible at 10 AM may be
