GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier at Mukran Port, ~6 km south of Sassnitz town; shuttle or taxi required

Best For: Chalk cliff hikes, UNESCO beech forests, Baltic seafood, amber hunting

Walk to center: Not walkable from Mukran — take cruise shuttle, bus Line 22, or taxi

Don't Miss: Königsstuhl cliff skywalk in Jasmund National Park

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Jasmund National Park & Königsstuhl Skywalk** — Hike cliffside trails through ancient beech forest to the 118-meter Königsstuhl chalk cliff.
 - Prora — The Colossus of Rügen** — A 4.5 km concrete monolith built by the Nazis for 20,000 holidaymakers that was never completed.
 - HMS Otus Submarine Museum** — Climb inside a decommissioned British Oberon-class submarine moored in
- Sassnitz's Old Harbor.

 - Binz Beach & Resort Promenade** — Rügen's premier Baltic resort — wide sandy beach, classic wicker Strandkörbe chairs, an elegant pier, and grand white...
 - Hochuferweg Cliff Path Hike** — Walk the free cliffside trail through Jasmund's old-growth beech forest, with glimpses of the Baltic far below.

BEST WALKS

- Sassnitz Harbor Stroll** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy · Free — From the Old Harbor, walk out along the Sassnitz Mole — a 1.45 km stone breakwater ending at the iconic green-and-white octagonal...
- Old Town & Bäderarchitektur** 1 km · 20 min · Easy · Free — Wander the steep streets of Sassnitz's historic center.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry cash. Germany remains cash-heavy — fish roll stands, public toilets (€0.50), buses, and small shops all prefer euros. ATMs are in Sassnitz center but not at Mukran Port.
- Don't miss the shuttle timing. Mukran Port is not walkable to town. Confirm shuttle times with your ship and don't cut it close — the
