TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Lower Oder Valley National Park** — Germany's only floodplain national park sprawls across the polders south of town.
- **Oder-Neisse Cycle Path Ride** — One of Germany's most famous long-distance bike trails runs right through the port.
- **Baroque Town Walk & Schlossgarten** — The Margraves of Brandenburg-Schwedt left behind a grand park and the elegant Berliner Tor city gate, even as their...
- **Stadtmuseum Schwedt** — A compact city museum inside a historic Huguenot-era house tracing Schwedt's story: Baroque splendor, WWII destruction...
- **Birdwatching in the Polders** — The Oder floodplains are one of Europe's premier stopover sites for migratory birds — tens of thousands of cranes and...

BEST WALKS

- **Bollwerk to Berliner Tor & Schlossgarten** 1.2 km · 15 min · flat — Walk north from the pier along the Oder promenade, turn into the Lindenallee boulevard lined with centuries-old linden trees, and...
- **Town Center & St. Catherine's Church** 0.8 km · 10 min · flat — Head straight from the pier to the Karthausplatz town square and duck into the restored late-Gothic St.

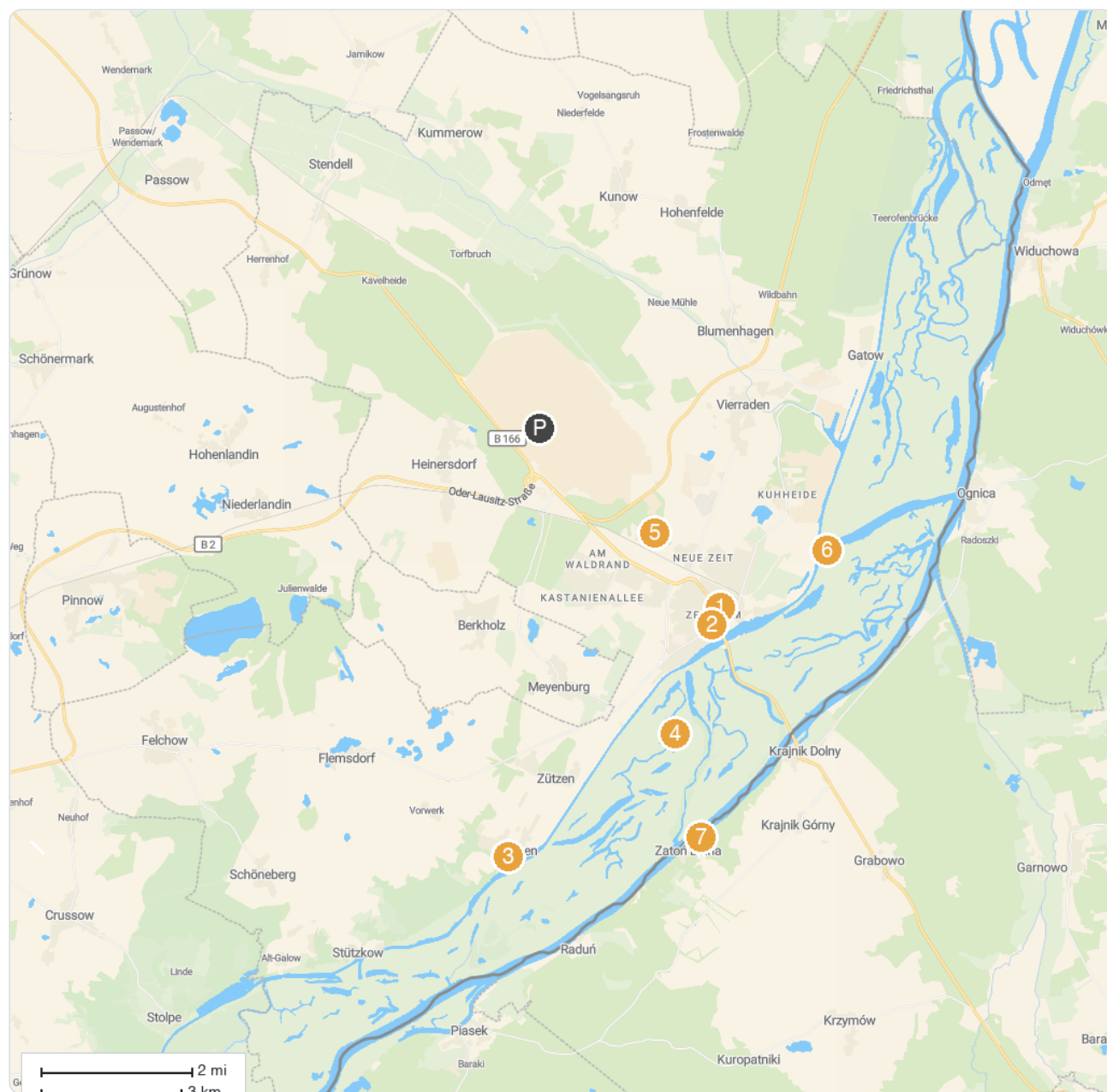
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry cash. Smaller cafés, bakeries, and taxi drivers often prefer euros over cards. ATMs are available in the town center.
- Rent a bike if you can. The Oder-Neisse cycle path runs through the port — cycling into the national park buffer zone is the best way to experience the landscape.
- Pack insect repellent in summer. The surrounding floodplain wetlands breed mosquitoes, especially in the evening and near the reed beds.
