- Archipelago Zodiac Adventure** — Zodiac or small-boat tour through the seven islands.
- Shaputuan Museum & Innu Culture** — The Shaputuan Museum is dedicated to the Innu (Montagnais) nation — their nomadic traditions, seasonal cycle, and...
- Grande Basque Island Nature Walk** — A short boat ride brings you to Grande Basque Island for guided nature walks, a marine basin exhibit with local sea...
- Vieux-Poste (Old Trading Post)** — An open-air living-history site depicting a mid-19th-century fur-trading post where French traders and Innu people met.
- Seafood & Scallop Tasting at Purmer Farm** — Take a boat to Grosse Boule Island to tour the Purmer mariculture farm, learning how scallops, mussels, and seaweed are...

BEST WALKS

- Waterfront Boardwalk — Pier to Vieux-Quai** 2 km | ~25 min one-way | Flat, paved — Walk the paved path from the cruise pier along the bay to the Vieux-Quai (Old Wharf) district.
- Downtown & Dining Loop** 1.5 km | ~20 min | Flat — From the Vieux-Quai, head up rue des Jésuites or avenue Brochu into the downtown core.
