GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Gat Vrulje pier for most ships; tender for very large vessels

Best For: Medieval history, fortress views, Krka day-trip, Dalmatian food

Walk to center: ~10–15 min flat waterfront walk (800 m) to the cathedral

Don't Miss: Cathedral of St. James — 71 carved stone faces on the outer frieze

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Krka National Park Waterfalls** — The cascading travertine falls at Skradinski Buk are arguably Croatia's most spectacular.
- **Cathedral of St. James & Old Town** — The 15th-century Renaissance cathedral built entirely of stone — no mortar — features 71 carved portrait heads ringing...
- **St. Nicholas Fortress Boat Tour** — The second UNESCO site — a striking triangular Venetian sea fortress at the mouth of St.
- **Šibenik's Three Hilltop Fortresses** — St.
- **Banj Beach Swim** — A pebble beach 20–25 minutes' walk north along the promenade, with crystal-clear water and a postcard view back to the...

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront to Cathedral Walk** ~1 km · 15 min · Flat · Free — Leave the pier heading north along the promenade, pass the ferry terminal, and arrive at the Cathedral of St.
- **Fortress Loop** ~2 km · 45–60 min · Hilly · Paid — From the Cathedral, climb the steep lanes to St.
- **Promenade to Banj Beach** ~1.5 km · 20–25 min · Flat · Free — Head north from the pier along the flat waterfront all the way to Banj Beach.

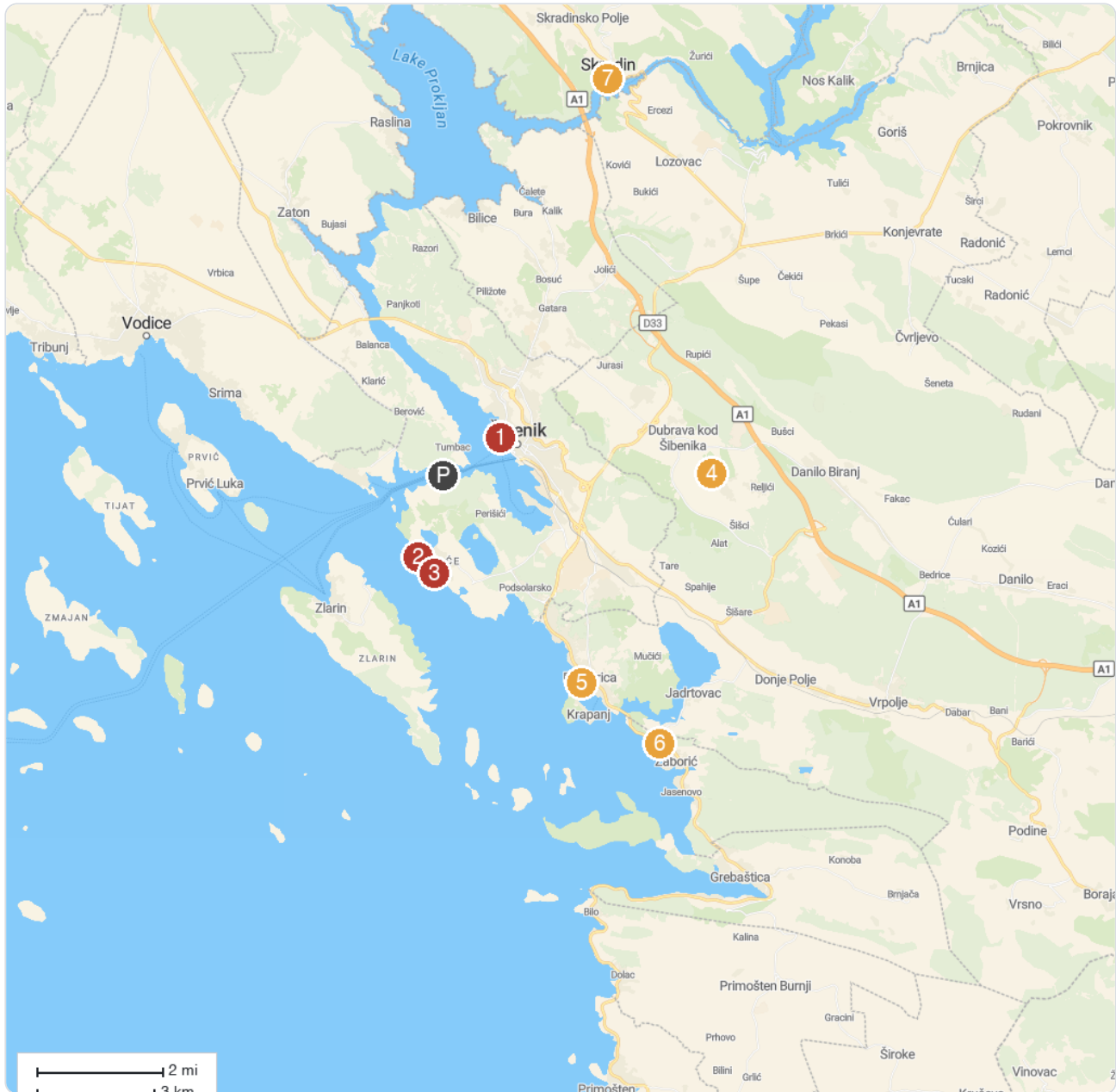
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
