GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to Chong Kneas pier (high water) or overland bus from Kampong Cham (low water, 4–5 hrs)

Best For: Ancient temples, Khmer history, floating villages, cultural immersion

Pier to Center: ~30–45 min by tuk-tuk or coach from Chong Kneas; not walkable

Don't Miss: Sunrise at Angkor Wat and the giant stone faces of Bayon Temple

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Angkor Wat Sunrise Tour** — Watch the sun rise over the world's largest religious monument, its five lotus towers reflected in the long pools...
- **Angkor Thom & Bayon Temple** — Enter the ancient walled city of Angkor Thom through a giant causeway flanked by stone giants.
- **Ta Prohm (Jungle Temple)** — Famously left half-consumed by giant silk-cotton and strangler fig trees, Ta Prohm feels like a genuine discovery.
- **Floating Village on Tonle Sap** — Tour the extraordinary floating villages of Kampong Phluk or Chong Kneas by small boat — entire communities of houses...
- **Phare, The Cambodian Circus** — An electrifying evening show by a non-profit that trains underprivileged youth in circus arts, theater, and music.

BEST WALKS

- **Old Market & Pub Street Stroll** 1–2 hrs · Flat · Free — From the riverside area, walk through the Old Market (Psar Chaa) — stalls packed with silk scarves, spices, and street food — then...
- **Wat Preah Prom Rath & Riverside** 45 min · Easy · Free — A short walk from the town center leads to Wat Preah Prom Rath, a beautiful active Buddhist temple with vivid murals and golden spires.

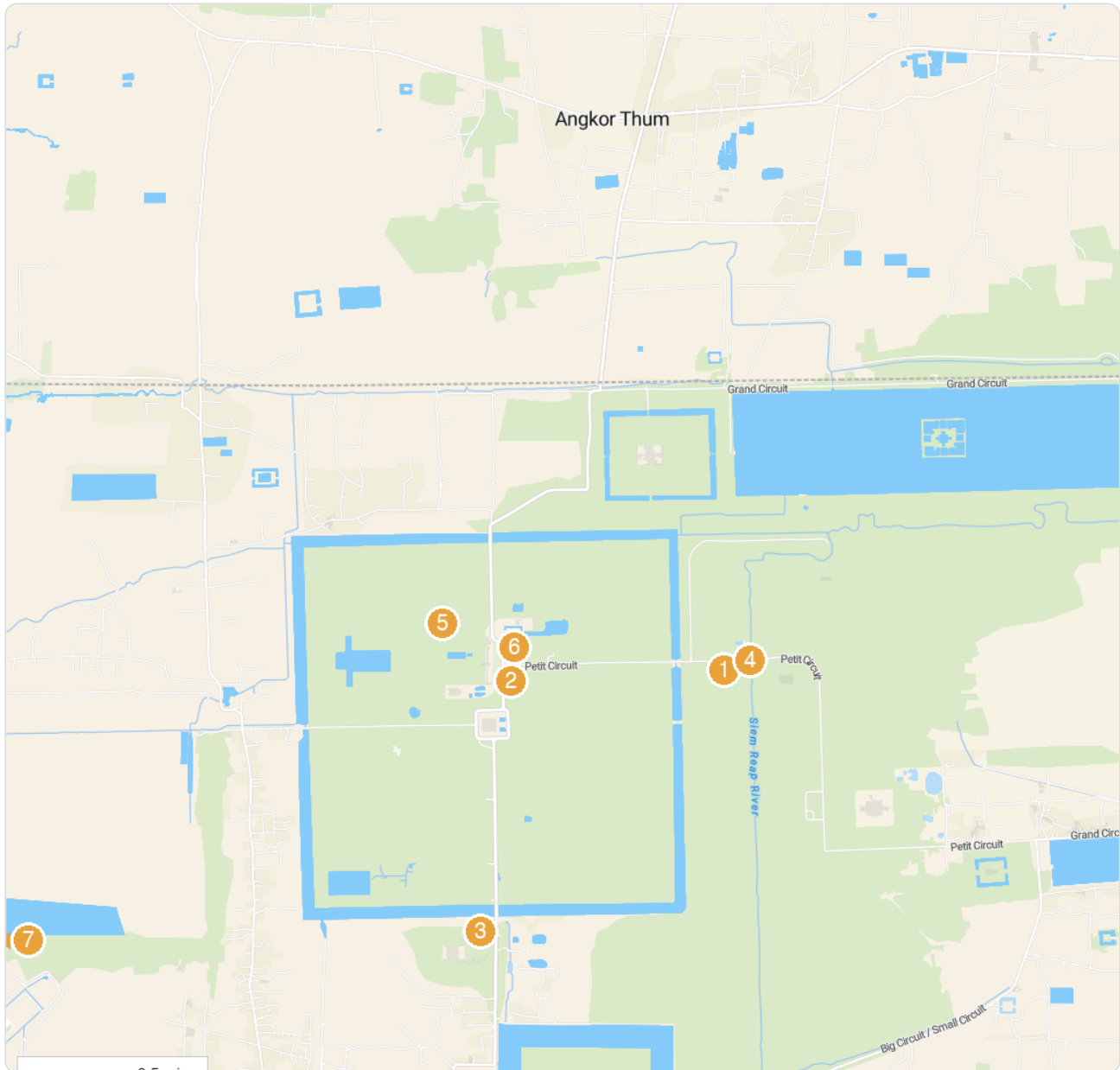
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
