GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River pontoon on the Kupa — step ashore directly into the city center

Walk to center: 0 min — the promenade IS the city center

Best For: Roman history, Renaissance fortresses, authentic Croatian river-town life

Don't Miss: Sisak Fortress (site of the 1593 Battle of Sisak) and Škrlet wine from the Moslavina region

Getting around: **Taxi** ~€5–€10 within city · **Rideshare** Uber, Bolt

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Sisak Fortress & Battle of 1593** — The triangular Renaissance fortress built in 1544 is one of Croatia's best-preserved.
- Siscia Roman Archaeological Park** — Walk over 2,000 years of history — preserved Roman defensive walls and a military granary sit in situ on Ban Jelačić...
- Dutch House Industrial Heritage Centre** — A beautifully restored 19th-century grain warehouse with a stepped facade, now Croatia's first industrial heritage...
- Lonjsko Polje Nature Park & Stork Village** — One of Europe's largest protected wetlands, just 30 min from the pier.
- Zagreb Day Excursion** — Croatia's vibrant capital is just 50 km away — easily the biggest excursion option from Sisak.

BEST WALKS

- River Promenade to Sisak Fortress** 3 km round trip · ~1 hr · Flat · Historic — Follow the Kupa riverside path south from the pier past the Old Bridge (Stari Most) and the Mali Kaptol Baroque palace, continuing to...
- Roman City Walk** 1 km loop · 30-45 min · Flat · Free — From the pier, walk a few minutes into the city center to Ban Jelačić Square where the Siscia Archaeological Park preserves Roman...

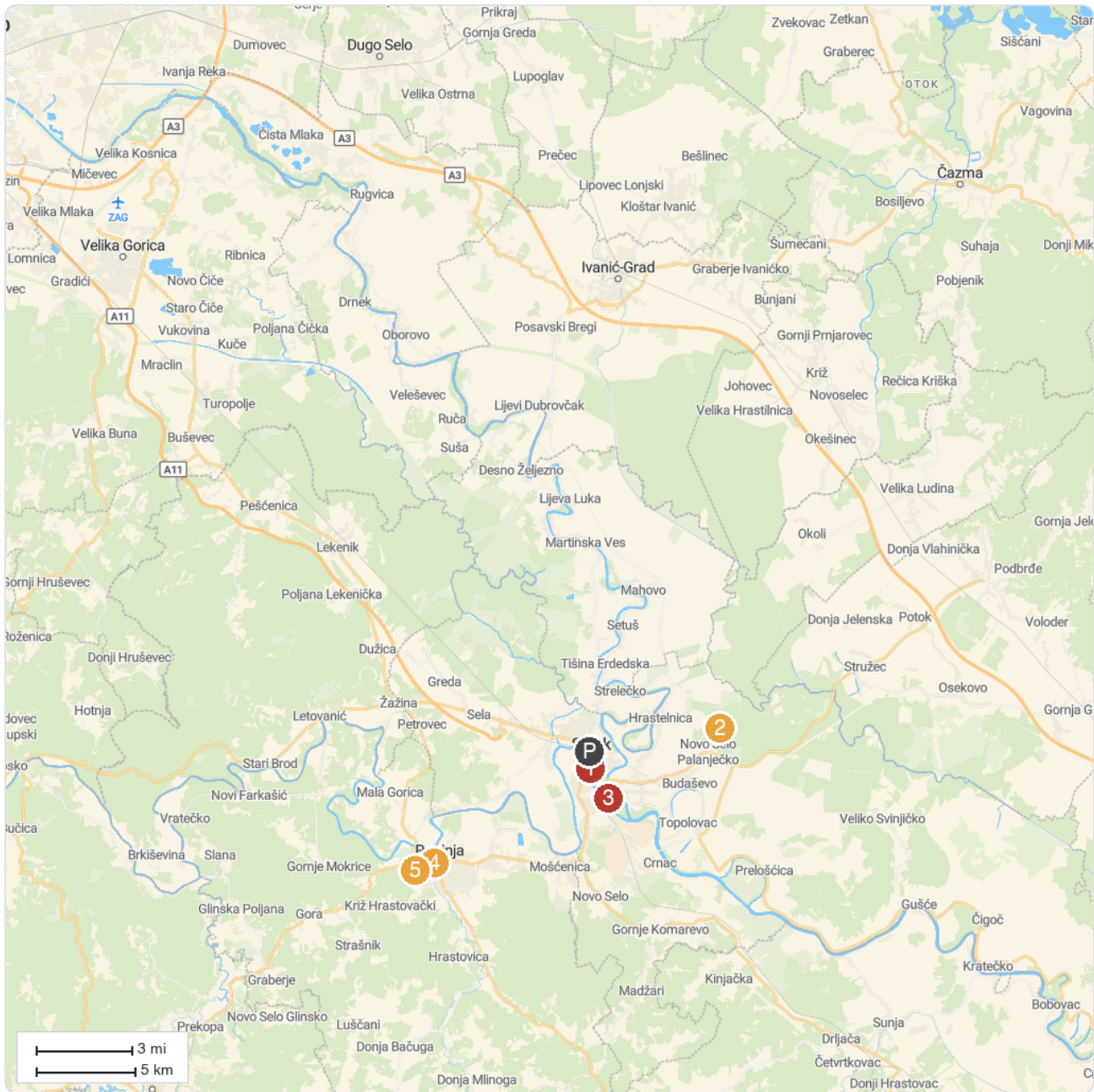
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
