TOP THINGS TO DO

- **North Cape (Nordkapp)** — Europe's northernmost point rises 307 m above the Barents Sea.
- **Kirkeporten Natural Arch Hike** — A spectacular rock arch frames a view of the fjord and the North Cape plateau.
- **King Crab Safari** — Skarsvåg is ground zero for the giant Red King Crab.
- **Christmas House (Julehuset)** — This family-run cottage is decorated for Christmas 365 days a year.
- **E-Bike to North Cape** — For fit visitors who want to earn that globe photo: rent an e-bike and tackle the 14 km uphill haul to Nordkapp.

BEST WALKS

- **Harbor & Village Loop** 30–45 min | Easy | Free — A gentle stroll from the tender pier around the harbor, past the colorful wooden houses, the fish drying racks (hjell), and the white...
- **Kirkeporten Arch Hike** 1–1.5 hrs | Easy–moderate | Free — Follow signs from the harbor toward Kirkeporten Camping, then take the marked trail up the hillside to the natural rock arch.

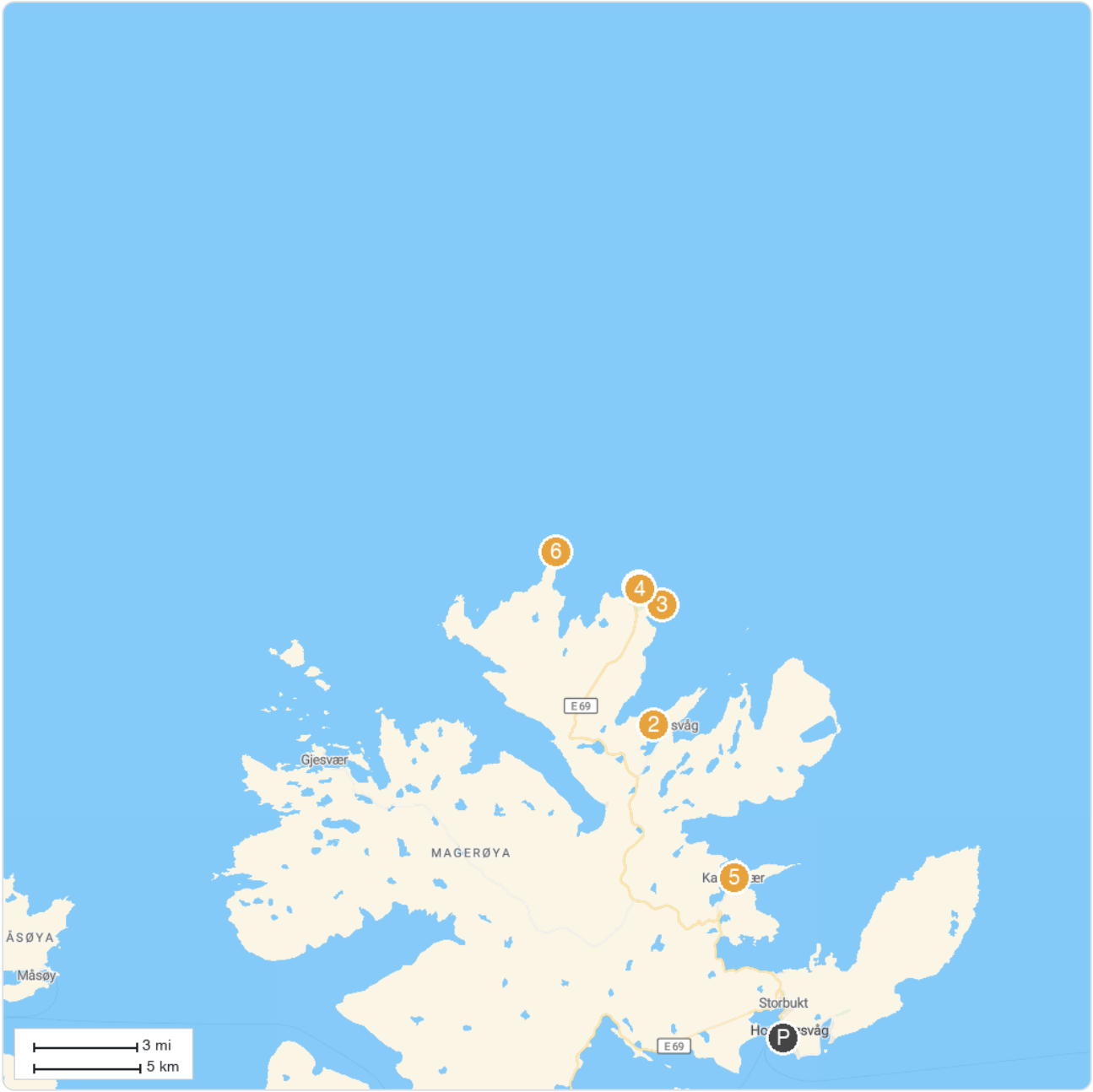
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Layer up even in summer. July temperatures hover around 5–10°C with cutting Barents Sea wind. Bring a windproof and waterproof outer layer, warm hat, and gloves — no exceptions.
- Go cashless. Norway is virtually card-only. Visa and Mastercard are accepted everywhere, including for a single postcard. No need to carry NOK
