

Slano, Dubrovnik-Neretva, Croatia

A horseshoe bay so sheltered it looks like a saltwater lake — Slano trades Dubrovnik's crowds for pine-fringed pebble beaches, a 15th-century Franciscan church, and some of Croatia's best oysters just up the road.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender (large ships); small ships dock at town quay or ACI Marina

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Ston Walls & Oyster Tasting** — Ston, 20 minutes away, has the longest medieval fortification walls in Europe outside China.
- **Trsteno Arboretum** — One of Europe's oldest arboretums (15th century), filled with exotic plants, a Baroque aqueduct-fed fountain, and sea...
- **Bay Beach Day** — Slano Bay's sheltered waters are nearly always flat calm.
- **Dubrovnik Old Town** — The UNESCO-listed walled city is 30–40 minutes by taxi.
- **Franciscan Church & Rector's Palace** — The 15th-century Franciscan Church of St.

BEST WALKS

- **Bay Promenade Loop** 2.5 km · 35–40 min · Flat paved path — A paved seaside path wraps around the entire horseshoe bay under pine shade.
- **Village History Stroll** 1 km · 20 min · Flat — From the pier, walk up into the village to the Rector's Palace ruins, the Church of St.

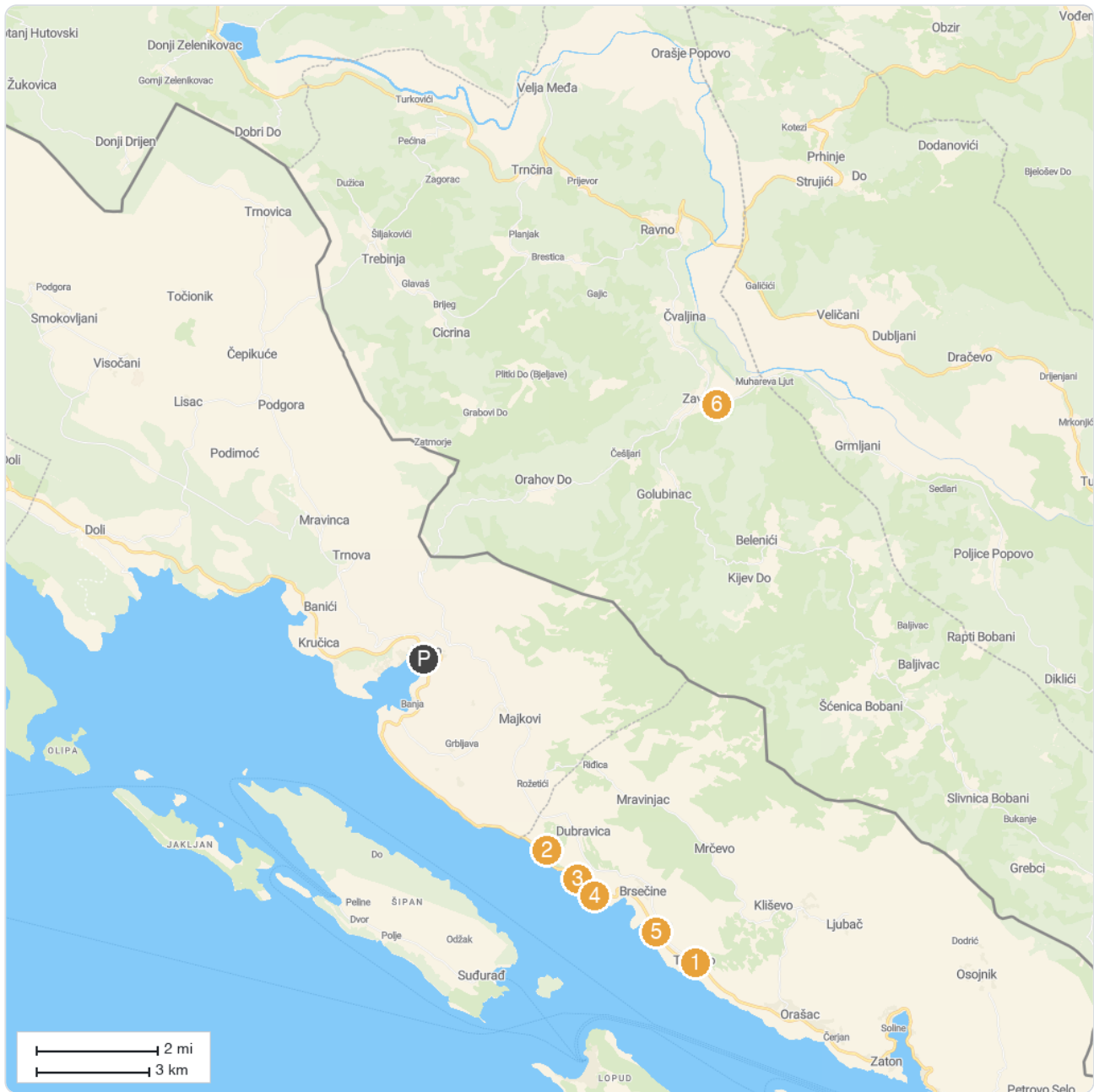
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Euros everywhere. Croatia adopted the euro in 2023. Cards accepted at restaurants and the arboretum; bring a little cash for beach chairs, taxis, and local market stalls.
- Pack water shoes. Every beach in Slano is pebble. Aqua shoes make entry into the water dramatically more comfortable.
- Negotiate taxis upfront. Taxis don't use meters here. Agree on a price before you get in. Ston round-trip with wait: ~€50–70. Dubrovnik one-way: ~€30–40.
