TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Chania Old Town & Venetian Harbor Walk** — Stroll the horseshoe harbor front past Venetian arsenals and the Küçük Hasan Mosque, then walk the breakwater jetty all...
- **Balos Lagoon & Gramvousa Island Boat Trip** — A full-day boat excursion from Kissamos (1 hr west of Chania) to Balos, a dreamy lagoon with shallow turquoise water...
- **Samaria Gorge Hike** — Europe's longest gorge — 16 km through the White Mountains from Xyloskalo plateau to the Libyan Sea at Agia Roumeli.
- **Maritime Museum & Firka Fortress** — Inside the Venetian Firka Fortress at the harbor mouth, this museum covers Cretan naval history from ancient times...
- **Nea Chora Beach Day** — A long sandy city beach a 15-minute walk west of the Venetian Harbor.

BEST WALKS

- **Venetian Harbor Loop & Lighthouse** 2 km · 30-45 min · Easy · Free — Start at the bus/taxi drop-off near the Municipal Market.
- **Old Town Alleys: Evraiki & Splantzia** 1.5 km · 30-45 min · Easy · Free — From the harbor front, duck into the Evraiki (Jewish Quarter) for its flower-filled passages and Etz Hayyim Synagogue, then head east...

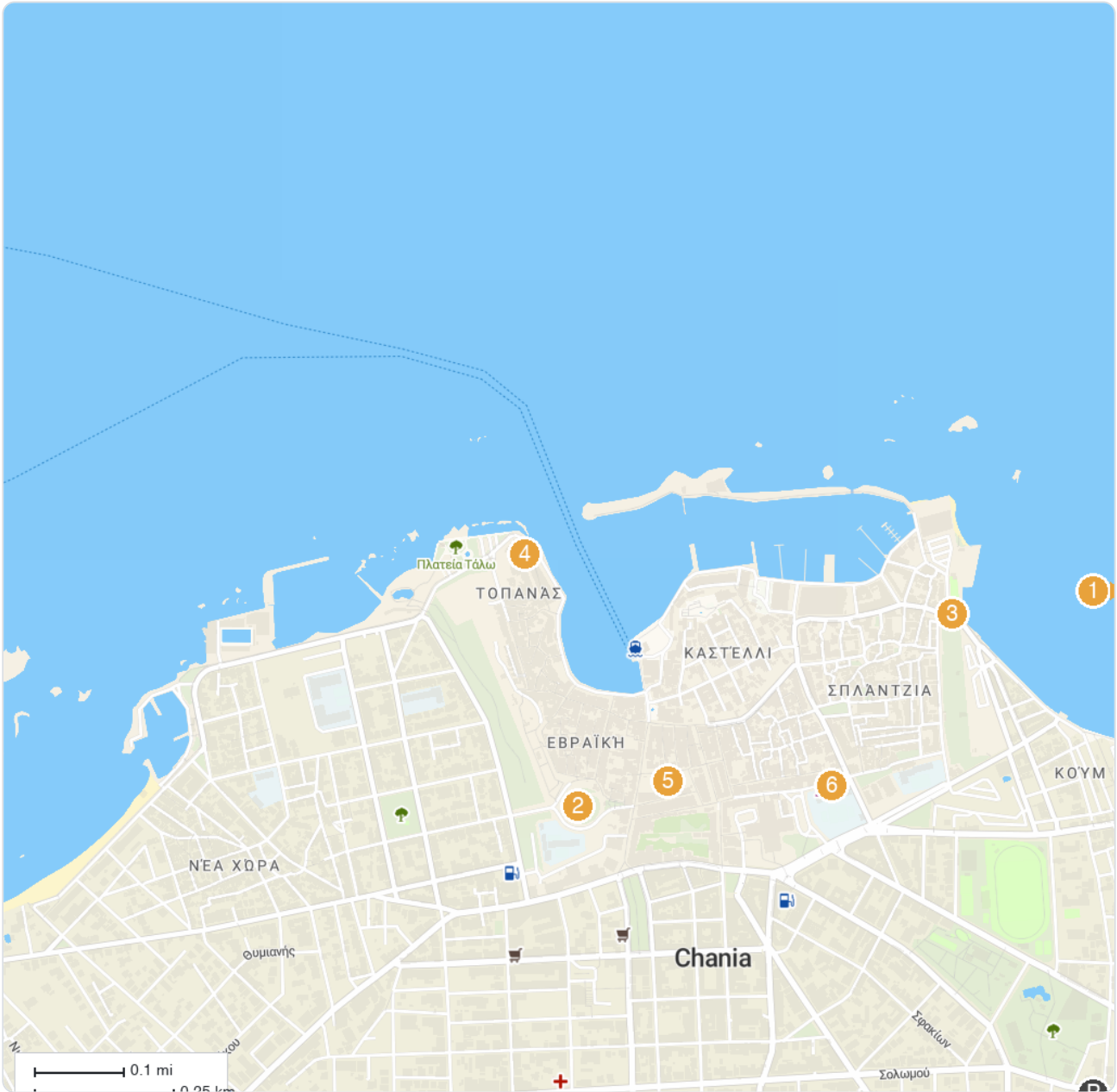
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Take the public bus. Line 13 from the port gate costs ~€1.50 and runs every 20 min — far cheaper than the cruise shuttle and nearly as fast.
- Wear proper shoes. Chania's Old Town is paved with uneven cobblestones and polished Venetian marble — slippery when wet, tough on flip-flops.
