- Bouboulina Museum** — Tour the 300-year-old mansion of Laskarina Bouboulina — the world's first female naval admiral and heroine of the 1821...
 - Spetses Museum (Mexis Mansion)** — This late 18th-century nobleman's mansion houses 4,000 years of island finds, folk art, and — remarkably — Bouboulina's...
- Kaiki Beach (College Beach)** — A 15-minute walk west of Dapia past the grand Anargyrios School.
 - E-Bike Island Circuit** — Rent an e-bike at Dapia and follow the coastal ring road around the island — pine forests, cliff-top views, and secluded...
 - Old Harbor (Baltiza) Walk** — A scenic 20-minute stroll east leads to the atmospheric Old Harbor, where luxury yachts share the waterfront with...

BEST WALKS

- Dapia to Old Harbor Coastal Walk** 2 km · 20–25 min · Flat — Head east from the tender pier along the waterfront past the Cathedral of Agios Nikolaos (where the independence flag was raised in...
- Dapia to Kaiki Beach** 1 km · 15 min · Flat — Walk west from the harbor past the iconic Belle Époque façade of the Poseidonion Grand Hotel and the historic Anargyrios School to...

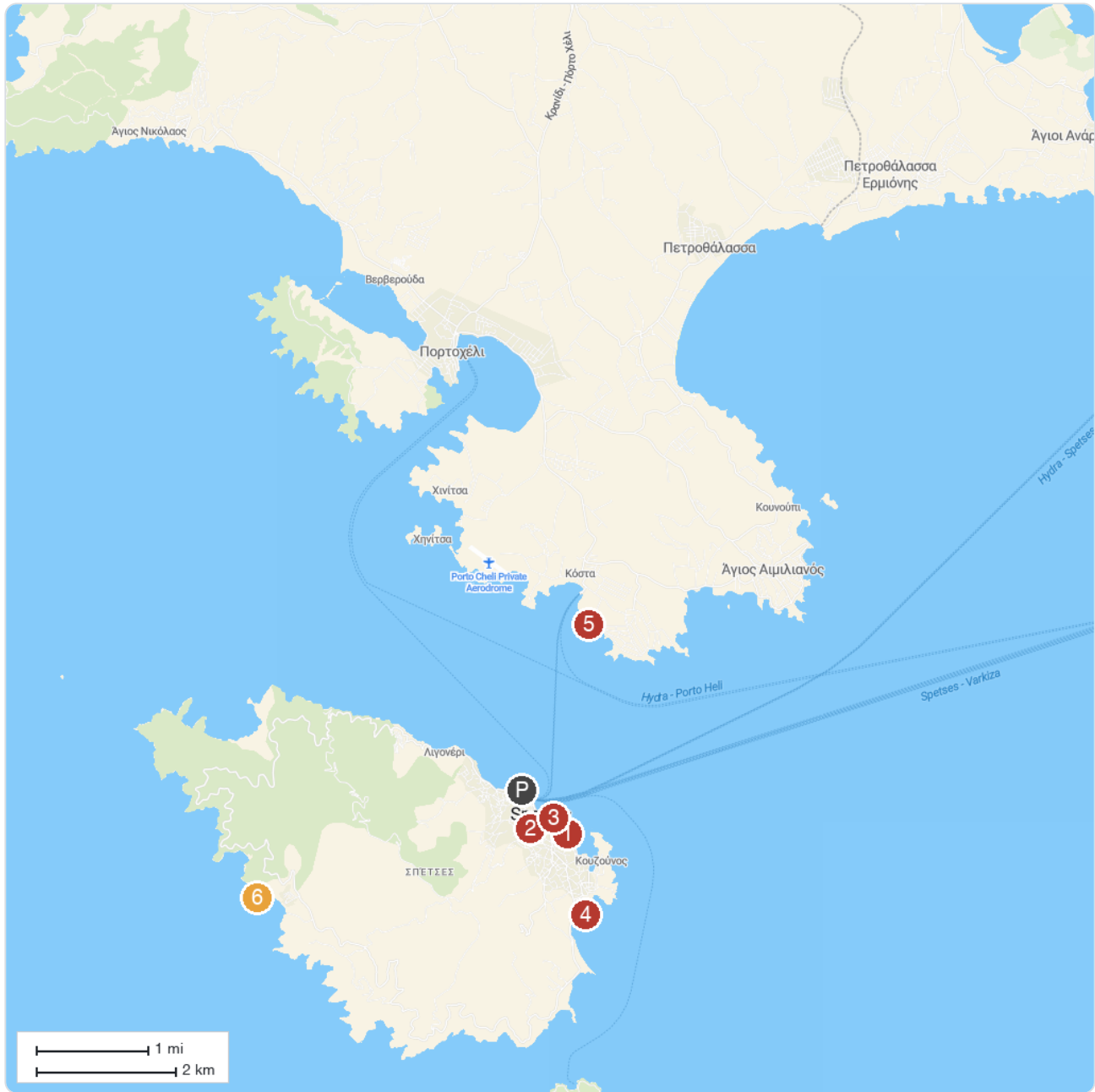
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Wear sturdy shoes. The beautiful pebble-mosaic streets (votsalota) are uneven and slippery even when dry — flip-flops invite twisted ankles.
- Bring cash. Horse-drawn carriages, water taxis, and local buses are cash-only. ATMs are available near Dapia.
