

St. Augustine, Florida, USA

Founded in 1565, St. Augustine is the oldest continuously occupied European settlement in the continental US — a living museum of Spanish forts, coquina architecture, and sun-washed cobblestone lanes just steps from the ship.

- Docking:** Small ships pier at St. Augustine Municipal Marina; large ships visit via excursion from Jacksonville (~45 mi)
- Best For:** History buffs, architecture lovers, beach day, Southern food & craft spirits
- Walk to Center:** Under 5 min from marina to St. George Street and Castillo de San Marcos
- Don't Miss:** Castillo de San Marcos, St. George Street, St. Augustine Lighthouse, St. Augustine Distillery free tour

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Castillo de San Marcos** — America's oldest masonry fort (1695), built of coquina shell-stone that famously absorbed cannonballs.
- St. George Street & Plaza de la Constitución** — The pedestrian heart of the Old City — centuries-old storefronts, street musicians, the 18th-century Cathedral...
- St. Augustine Lighthouse** — Climb 219 steps inside the 1874 lighthouse for panoramic views of the Atlantic and historic downtown.
- St. Augustine Alligator Farm** — One of Florida's oldest continuously running attractions (since 1893) — the only place on earth where all 24...
- Anastasia State Park Beach** — Four miles of undeveloped white-sand Atlantic beach with dunes, kayak rentals, and paddleboard hire.

BEST WALKS

- Bayfront to Old City Loop** 1.5 miles · Easy · 45–60 min — Follow the bayfront north from the marina past the Castillo de San Marcos, turn south onto St.
- Flagler College & Lightner Museum Quarter** 0.75 miles · Easy · 30 min — Head west from the Plaza to Flagler College (the 1888 Ponce de León Hotel, now containing the world's largest installed Tiffany glass...

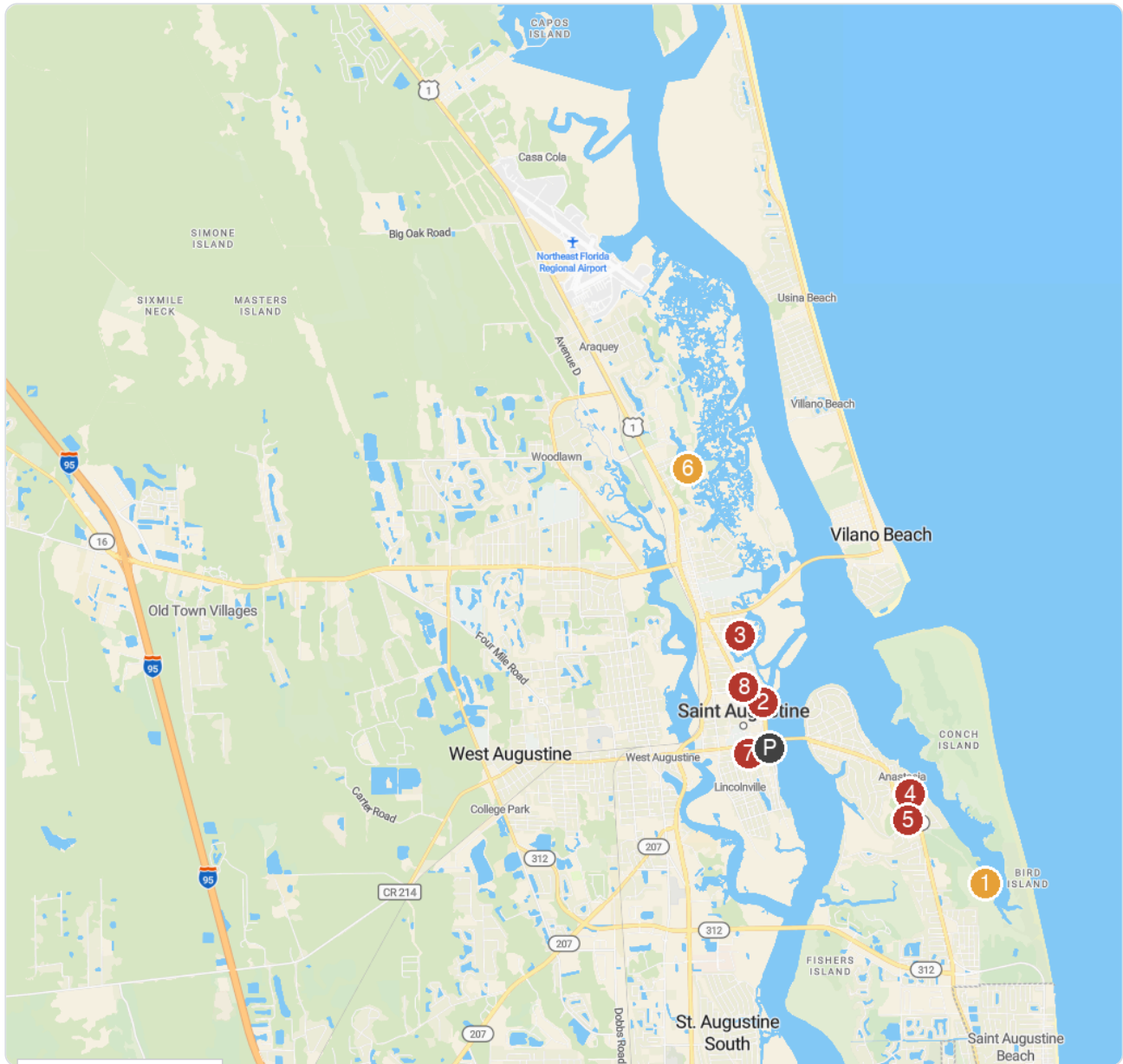
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
