TOP THINGS TO DO

- Cumberland Island National Seashore Day Trip** — Take the 45-minute NPS ferry to one of America's most pristine barrier islands.
 - Historic Downtown Walking Tour** — St Marys is one of America's oldest cities (est.
 - St Marys Submarine Museum** — Located right on the waterfront, this museum honors nearby Kings Bay Naval Submarine Base — home to East Coast Trident...
- Wild Horse and Ruins Walk on Cumberland Island** — From the ferry dock at Sea Camp, walk 1.5 miles south through the maritime forest to the iconic Dungeness ruins.
 - Rock Shrimp Lunch on the Waterfront** — St Marys is famous for local rock shrimp — a deep-water variety that tastes like a cross between lobster and shrimp.

BEST WALKS

- Historic Downtown Loop** 1.5 miles • 30-40 min • Easy — From the City Dock, walk up Osborne Street through the heart of historic downtown.
- Cumberland Island: Dungeness Trail** 3 miles round trip • 1.5-2 hrs • Easy (flat sand) — From the Sea Camp ferry dock on Cumberland Island, take the main south trail through maritime forest to the Dungeness ruins.

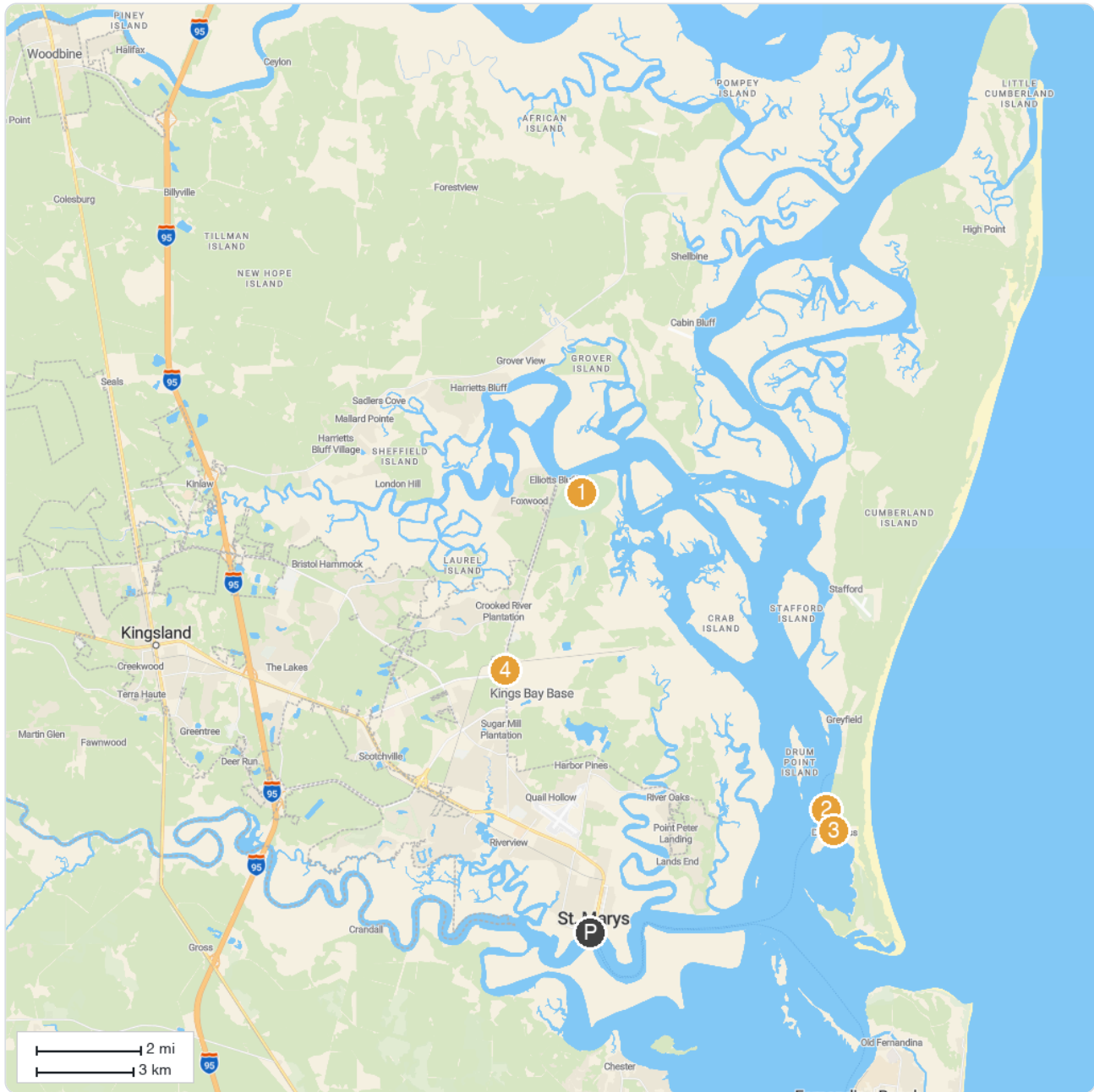
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Pack bug spray — it's essential. Salt marshes mean sandflies (no-see-ums) and mosquitoes on the island and along the waterfront. DEET or Picaridin-based repellent is a must...
