- **Schloss Ratibor & Old Town Walk** — Explore the 16th-century Renaissance castle built for Margrave George the Pious, with its ornate ceremonial hall and...
 - **Nuremberg Day Trip** — Just 25 km away, Nuremberg offers the Imperial Castle, Nazi Documentation Center, medieval old town walls, and the best...
- **Franconian Wire Museum (Fabrikmuseum)** — Roth was Europe's center for "Leonisch" gold and silver wire used in royal embroidery and Christmas tinsel.
 - **Rothsee & Franconian Lake District** — A 10-minute taxi ride brings you to Rothsee, a reservoir with beaches, cycling paths, and water sports in the heart of...
 - **Franconian Food & Beer Garden** — Franconia has more breweries per capita than anywhere on Earth.

BEST WALKS

- **Marktplatz to Schloss Ratibor Loop** 1.5 km | 30–45 min | Easy — Start at the central Marktplatz with its Margrave Fountain and half-timbered facades, walk south to Schloss Ratibor and its...
- **Canal Quay Stroll** 1 km | 15 min | Easy — A short, pleasant walk along the Main-Danube Canal near the dock to watch river traffic and observe the engineering of the lock system...

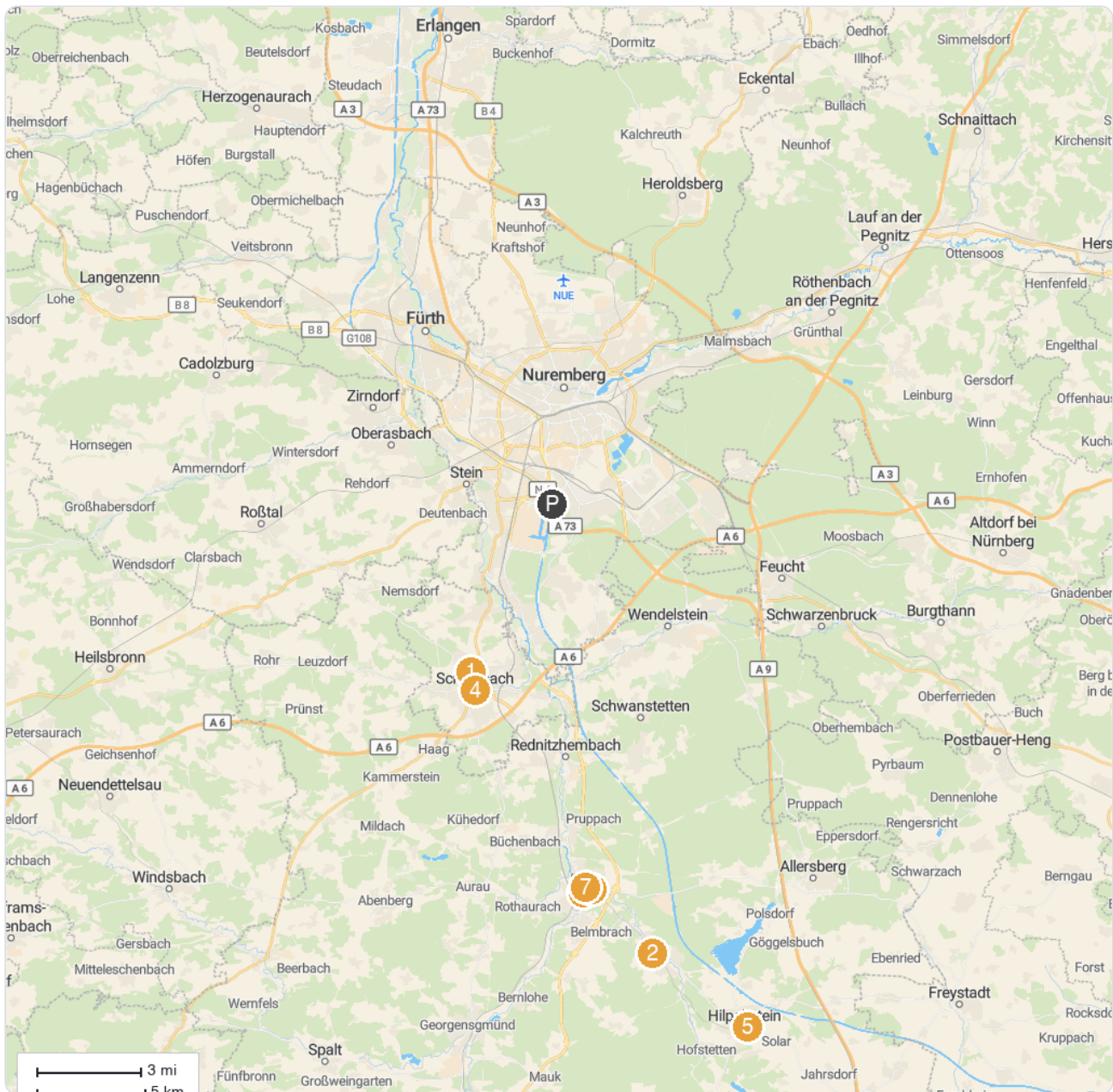
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
