TOP THINGS TO DO

- **California Delta River Tour** — Explore the largest estuary on the US West Coast — a maze of waterways dotted with houseboats, historic drawbridges...
 - **Haggin Museum** — One of California's finest regional museums, with 19th-century European paintings (including a Renoir), Albert...
- **Bob Hope Fox Theatre** — A lavishly restored 1930s movie palace in the heart of downtown, hosting concerts, classic films, and live performances.
 - **Downtown Multicultural Food Tour** — Stockton's historic diversity — Filipino, Cambodian, Mexican, Sikh, Portuguese — translates into over 50 ethnic...
 - **Lodi Wine Country Day Trip** — Just 15 miles north, Lodi is a world-class wine region famous for old-vine Zinfandels.

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront Promenade Walk** 1.5 miles · flat · 30 min — Follow the Joan Darrah Promenade along the Stockton Channel from the marina past Weber Point Park to Banner Island Ballpark.
- **Downtown Historic Core** 1 mile loop · flat · 20–30 min — Stroll from the marina into the downtown grid to see the Bob Hope Fox Theatre, the Adventist Health Arena, and the historic commercial...

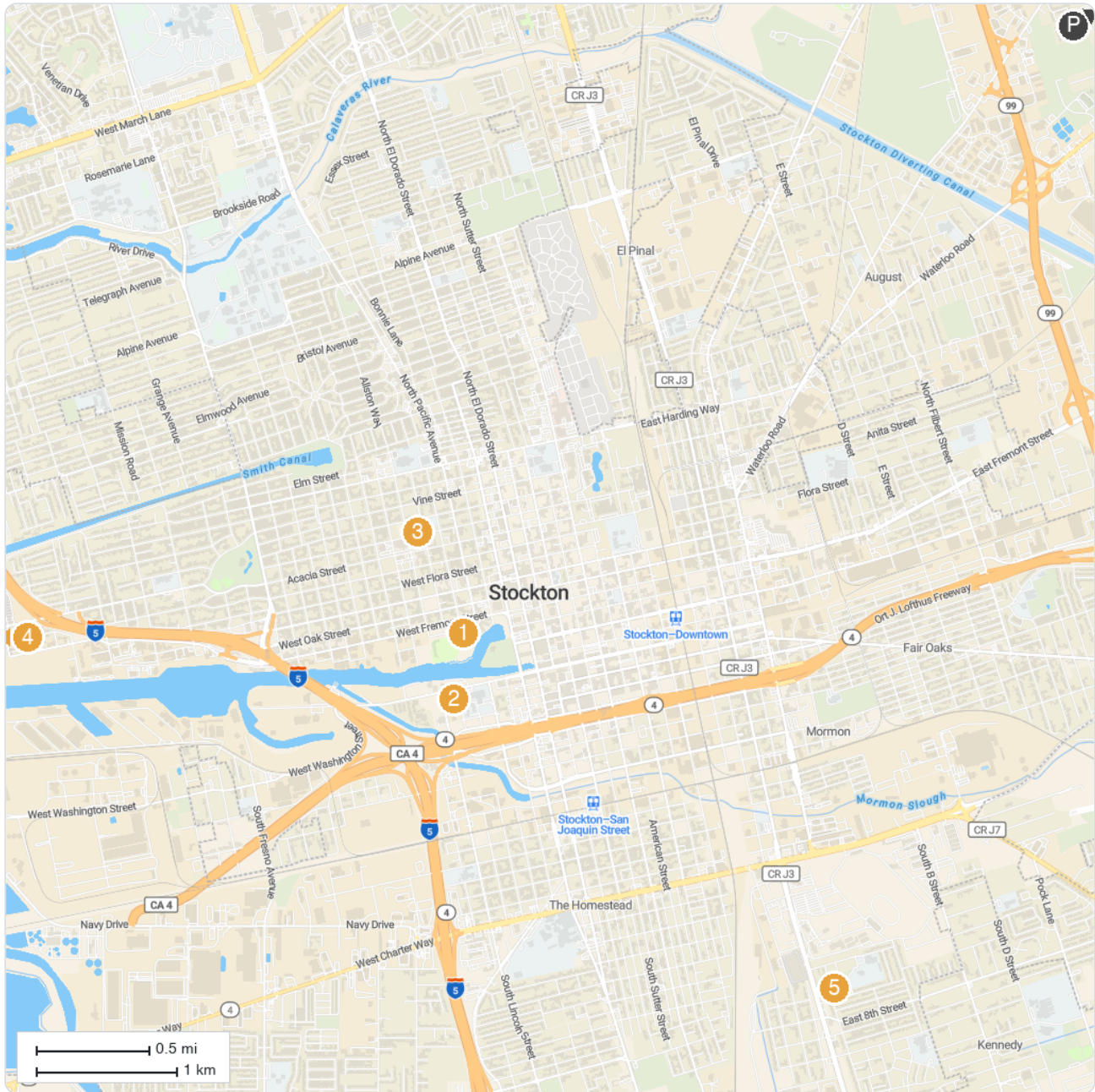
