GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River pier (Schiffsanleger) on the Weser — no tender

Walk to center: 5–10 min to Marktplatz (~400 m flat)

Best For: Cycling, church architecture, white asparagus season

Don't Miss: The crooked spire of St.-Jacobi-Kirche

 Getting around:  Taxi  €5–€15

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **St.-Jacobi-Kirche & the Crooked Spire** — Stolzenau's signature sight: a deliberately twisted spire helmet, coiled by carpenters when the tower was built in 1679...
- **Weser-Radweg Cycling** — Cycle a stretch of Germany's famous Weser Cycle Path — flat, paved, and scenic.
- **Altstadt Half-Timbered Walk** — Wander Hohe Straße and the backstreets of the old town, where Fachwerk (half-timbered) houses dating to the 16th–17th...
- **Burg Stolzenau Site & Weser Promenade Stroll** — The medieval Weser border castle (built 1346, destroyed in the Thirty Years' War in 1627) survives only as an...
- **Asparagus Season (mid-Apr to Jun 24)** — The Middle Weser region is celebrated for its white Spargel.

BEST WALKS

- **Pier to Marktplatz & Crooked Spire Loop** 1.5 km · 30–45 min · Flat · Free — From the river pier, walk along the promenade to the town center.
- **Burg Site & Riverside Promenade** 2 km · 40–55 min · Flat · Free — From the pier, follow the promenade past the town center toward the old Burg Stolzenau site near the Mühlenteich (mill pond), where...

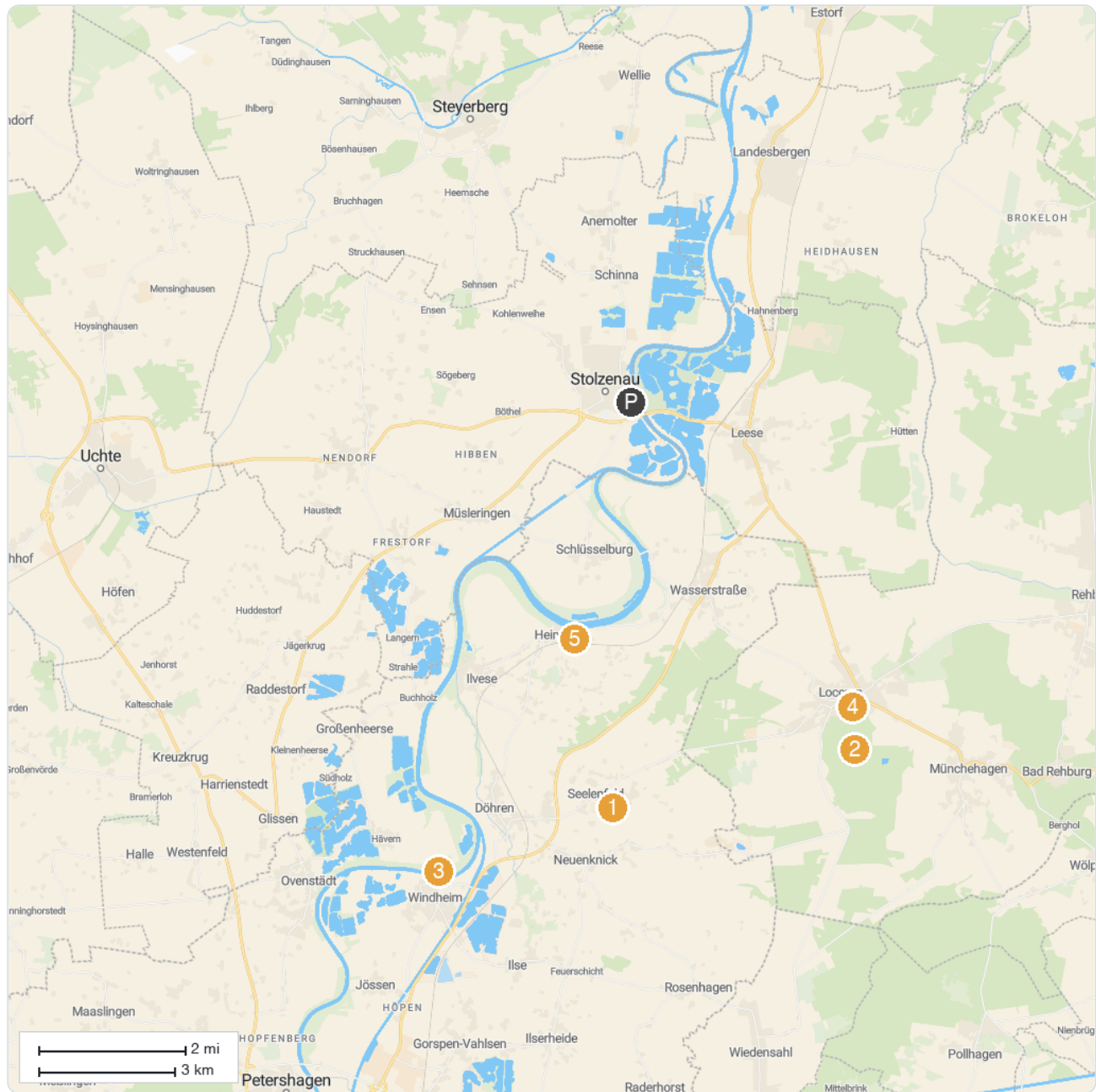
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry cash (Euros). Small bakeries, cafés, and kiosks in Stolzenau often prefer cash or don't accept cards at all. A handful of small bills and coins will serve you well.
- Bikes beat taxis here. There are no tourist taxis at the pier. If your ship carries bicycles, grab one — the Weser-Radweg is flat, well-signed, and perfect for a 2-hour loop.
- Sunday closures. All supermarkets and shops are closed by German law on Sundays. Cafés and restaurants stay open — plan
