GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Stadthafen (City Harbor), right in the Old Town

Walk to center: 5-8 min to Alter Markt; Ozeaneum is 2-3 min from the pier

Best For: Medieval architecture, marine science, fresh Baltic seafood

Don't Miss: Fischbrötchen (fish rolls) from harbour cutter boats

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **UNESCO Old Town Walking Tour** — Explore Stralsund's remarkably preserved 13th-century street grid: the Alter Markt, the Gothic Rathaus arcade, St.
- **Ozeaneum Aquarium** — One of Germany's best aquariums, housed in a stunning modern building right on the harbor.
- **Rügen Island Day Trip** — Take the train from Stralsund Hauptbahnhof to Binz or Sellin on Rügen — Germany's largest island, famous for white-sand...
- **Gorch Fock I Tall Ship** — Board the legendary 1933 steel barque moored right in the Stadthafen beside your ship.
- **Fischbrötchen & Harbor Food Trail** — Stralsund claims the birthplace of the original Bismarck Herring recipe.

BEST WALKS

- **Stadthafen to Alter Markt** 0.5 km · 8 min · Flat — Walk from the pier past the Ozeaneum, through the harbor promenade, and into the heart of the UNESCO Old Town at the Alter Markt.
- **Old Town to St. Mary's Church Tower** 1 km · 15 min · Easy — From the Alter Markt, walk south through the medieval grid to St.

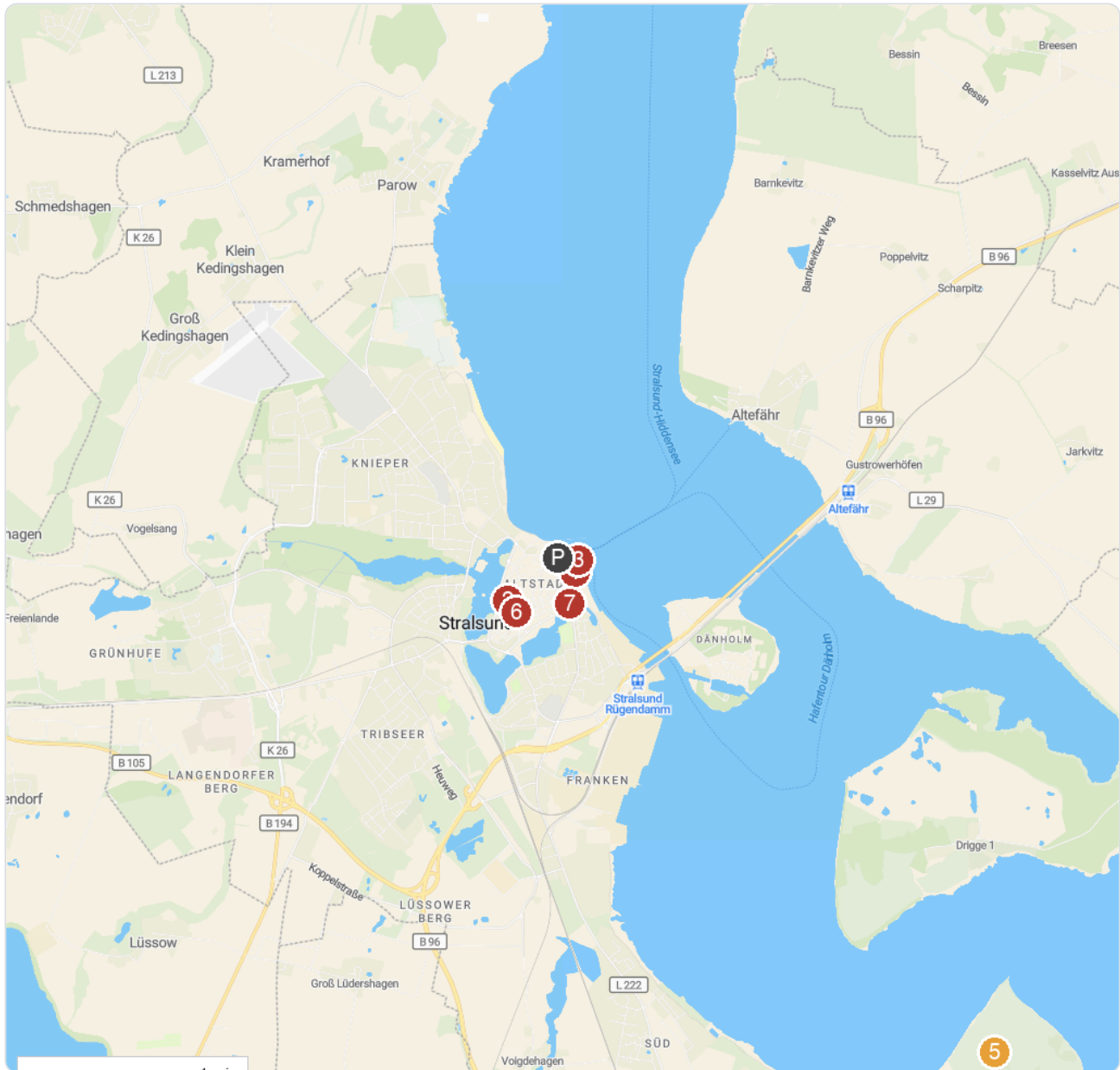

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry cash. Fish roll stands, bakeries, and public restrooms are cash-only. Credit cards work at restaurants and museums.
- Wear flat shoes. The Old Town is historic cobblestone — beautiful but unforgiving on heels or thin soles.
- Rügen trains are easy. The station is a 20-minute walk through the Old Town. Check the schedule early — last trains fill up in summer.

1 OZEANEUM Stralsund GmbH

Modern aquarium showcasing marine life from northern seas.

2 German Oceanographic Museum

Historic museum displaying marine biology and oceanography exhibits.

3 Gorch Fock I Historic sailing training ship, now a museum vessel.

4 Marina NeuhoF GmbH

Modern marina offering berths and services for boats.

5 Halbinsel Devin

Scenic peninsula offering nature trails and views of the Strelasund.

6 Museumshaus

Restored medieval merchant's house showcasing Stralsund's history.

7 Heilgeist Kirche

Historic church, originally part of a medieval hospital complex.
