

Sulina, Tulcea County, Romania

The easternmost point of the EU, Sulina is reachable only by water — a faded 19th-century free port frozen in time at the exact spot where the Danube meets the Black Sea.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships dock alongside the Faleza Sulina riverfront quay — no tender required

Best For: Delta boat tours, birdwatching, offbeat history, wild beach

Walk to Center: Step off ship onto Strada I promenade; Old Lighthouse 10 min, Cemetery 25 min on foot

Don't Miss: Cosmopolitan Cemetery — Orthodox, Jewish, Muslim, Protestant graves plus Europe's only pirate tombstone

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  10–20 RON (~\$4) per ride ·  **Rideshare**  not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Danube Delta Canal Boat Tour** — The must-do: hire a local boat to weave through narrow Delta canals surrounded by white pelicans, great white egrets...
- Cosmopolitan Cemetery Walk** — Sulina's most haunting site: a 19th-century multi-faith cemetery with Orthodox, Catholic, Protestant, Jewish, and...
- Old Lighthouse Museum** — Built in 1870, this decommissioned lighthouse charts the golden age of the European Commission of the Danube — the...
- Sulina Wild Beach** — Where the Danube meets the Black Sea, Sulina Beach is wide, uncrowded, and semi-wild — fine Danube silt sand, warm...
- Letea Forest Excursion** — Europe's northernmost subtropical forest, home to ancient oaks draped in vines and famously wild horses roaming freely.

BEST WALKS

- Waterfront Promenade & Town Center** 1.5 km | 25-30 min | Easy | Flat — Stroll Strada I from the dock past the Palace of the European Commission of the Danube (built 1860-1868), St.
- Cemetery Walk** 2.5 km return | 45-60 min | Easy | Flat — Walk or take a short taxi to the Cosmopolitan Cemetery (Cimitirul Cosmopolit), Sulina's most remarkable sight.
