Rebuilt in stone after a catastrophic 1888 fire, Sundsvall is Sweden's only city of stone — an architectural gem on the Gulf of Bothnia and gateway to the High Coast UNESCO World Heritage Site.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier at Tunadal Port, ~5.5 km from city center; cruise line shuttle required (no walkable route)

Best For: Architecture lovers, history buffs, Nordic culture, UNESCO High Coast excursions

Walk to Center: Not walkable from port — shuttle 10–15 min to Kulturmagasinet / Inre Hamnen

Don't Miss: Stenstaden stone city walk, Kulturmagasinet, Norra Berget lookout tower

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Stenstaden Stone City Walking Tour** — Sundsvall burned entirely in 1888 and was rebuilt in stone by Germany's finest architects within five years.
- **High Coast (Höga Kusten) UNESCO Excursion** — About 1.5–2 hours north by road, the High Coast is one of the world's most dramatic examples of post-glacial land...
- **Kulturmagasinet Museum & Library** — Four 19th-century brick harbor warehouses joined by soaring glass roofs now house the city library, a regional history...
- **Norra Berget Open-Air Museum & Panorama** — The North Mountain open-air museum features relocated historic farmsteads, animals, and Swedish heritage crafts...
- **Himlabadet Water Park & Spa** — Award-winning adventure water park within walking distance of the city center, featuring waterslides, a surf machine...

BEST WALKS

- **Stenstaden Architecture Walk** 2–3 km · 1–2 hrs · Easy — Start at Kulturmagasinet on the inner harbour, walk up Storgatan past ornate Neo-Gothic and Renaissance Revival facades to Stora...
- **Inner Harbour to Norra Berget** 3 km · 1.5 hrs · Easy–Moderate (uphill finish) — Walk from the inner harbour along the waterfront, through the city center, and up to Norra Berget for panoramic views over the fjord...
