GETTING ASHORE

- Docking:** Pier — ships dock at Uno Port cruise quay; no tender required
- Best For:** Contemporary art, island-hopping, Seto Inland Sea scenery
- Walk to center:** 5 min to Uno Station; ferry terminal is right next door
- Don't Miss:** Day trip to Naoshima — Chichu Art Museum and Yayoi Kusama's pumpkins

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Naoshima Art Island** — A 20-minute ferry ride delivers you to one of the art world's most talked-about islands.
- Kurashiki Bikan Historical Quarter** — A 17th-century merchant district of black-and-white tile warehouses lining a weeping-willow canal.
- Washuzan Lookout** — Mt.
- Shibukawa Beach & Marine Aquarium** — A calm, white-sand kilometre facing the Seto Inland Sea — sheltered waters make it perfect for wading.
- Bizenyaki Pottery Experience** — Bizen-yaki is one of Japan's oldest pottery styles — unglazed, rustic, and fired in traditional kilns.

BEST WALKS

- Uno Port Art Walk** 30–45 min | Flat | Free — A short loop from the pier takes in the outdoor art installations that make Uno one of Japan's most colourful port towns.
- Waterfront to Miyama Park** 20 min by taxi | Easy walking in park | Free — Miyama Park's English-style garden and 7,000-cherry-tree hillside is worth the short taxi ride, especially in spring.

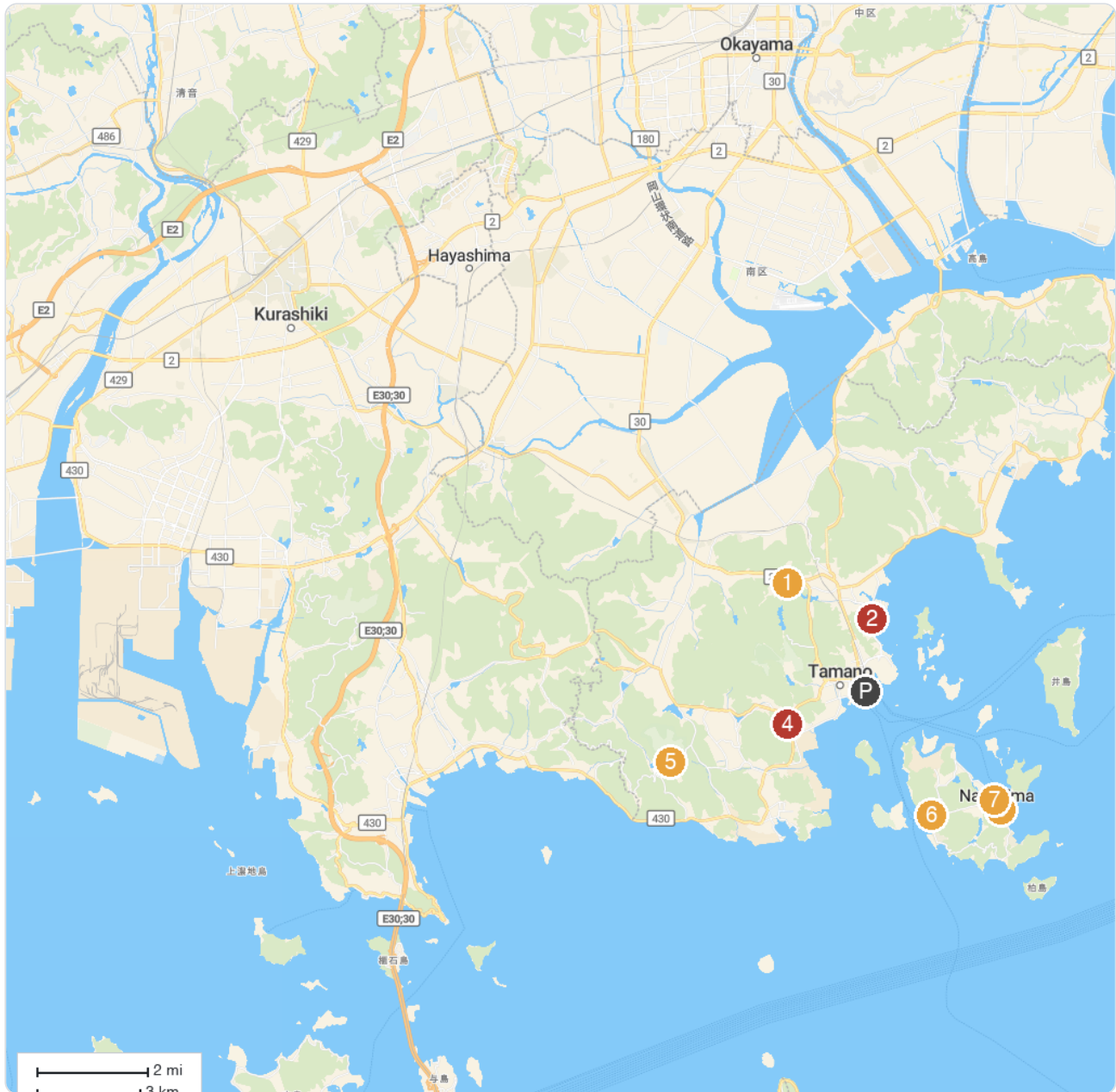
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry yen cash. Ferry ticket machines, island buses, and most small cafes on Naoshima and Teshima are cash-only. The convenience store ATM at Uno Station accepts foreign cards.
- Pre-book Chichu Art Museum tickets. Naoshima's underground museum requires timed-entry tickets purchased online in advance.
