

Tangermünde, Saxony-Anhalt, Germany

Called the "Rothenburg of the North," Tangermünde is a perfectly preserved medieval gem where Emperor Charles IV once kept a royal residence — the half-timbered lanes and intact 14th-century walls feel genuinely untouched.

GETTING ASHORE

- **Medieval Old Town Walking Tour** — Follow a local guide through the intact city walls, past the Neustädter Tor gate, up to Burg Tangermünde, and along...
- **Rathaus & Town History Museum** — The ornate late-Gothic town hall contains a small museum on Tangermünde's Hanseatic and imperial past, including the...
- **Burg Tangermünde Castle Grounds** — The partly preserved imperial castle atop the Elbe bluff was Emperor Charles IV's northern residence.
- **Elbe Cycle Route (Tagesausflug)** — Tangermünde sits on the famous Elbe Radweg (Elbe Cycle Route).
- **Kuhschwanzbier & Regional Tasting** — Sample Tangermünde's legendary dark "Cow's Tail Beer" at Exempel-Gaststuben — a quirky restaurant decorated like a...

BEST WALKS

- **Riverside to Marktplatz via Castle Hill** 1.5 km · 45-60 min · easy-moderate — The classic Tangermünde loop: up from the pier to Burg Tangermünde for Elbe views, then down Lange Straße past half-timbered facades...
- **City Wall Circuit** 2 km · 45 min · easy — Follow the near-intact 14th-century city wall from the Neustädter Tor (one of Germany's finest medieval gates) around to the Elbtor...

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

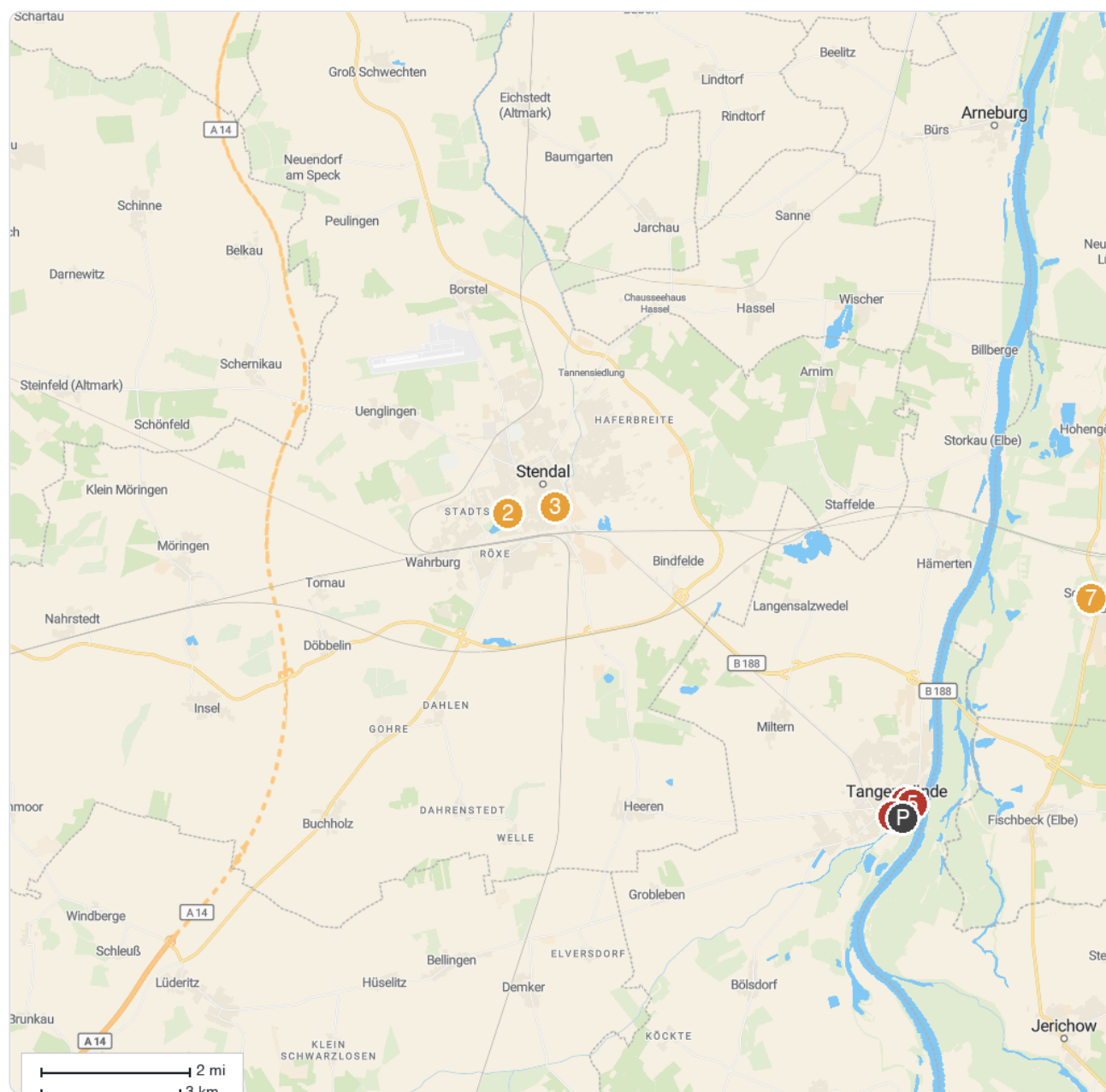
