TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Château de Tarascon** — One of France's best-preserved medieval water-castles, built in the 15th century by King René of Anjou.
 - **Provençal Old Town Walk** — Wander the Rue des Halles with its medieval stone arcades, visit the Collegiate Church of Saint-Martha (free entry...
- **Souleiado Museum** — Housed in a 14th-century mansion, this museum traces the story of Provençal printed fabric from antique printing blocks...
 - **Day Trip to Avignon** — The city of popes is 25 km north.
 - **Camargue & Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer** — The wild Camargue delta lies 45 km south — flamingos, white horses, black bulls, and wide sandy beaches at...

BEST WALKS

- **Tarascon Old Town Loop** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy — From the quay, walk to the château entrance, continue into the Vieux Tarascon via Rue des Halles, visit Collégiale Sainte-Marthe, then...
- **Tarascon to Beaucaire Bridge Walk** 3 km round trip · 45 min · Easy — Cross the Pont de Tarascon-Beaucaire to Beaucaire, climb the hill to the ruins of Beaucaire Castle (free entry to grounds) for a view...

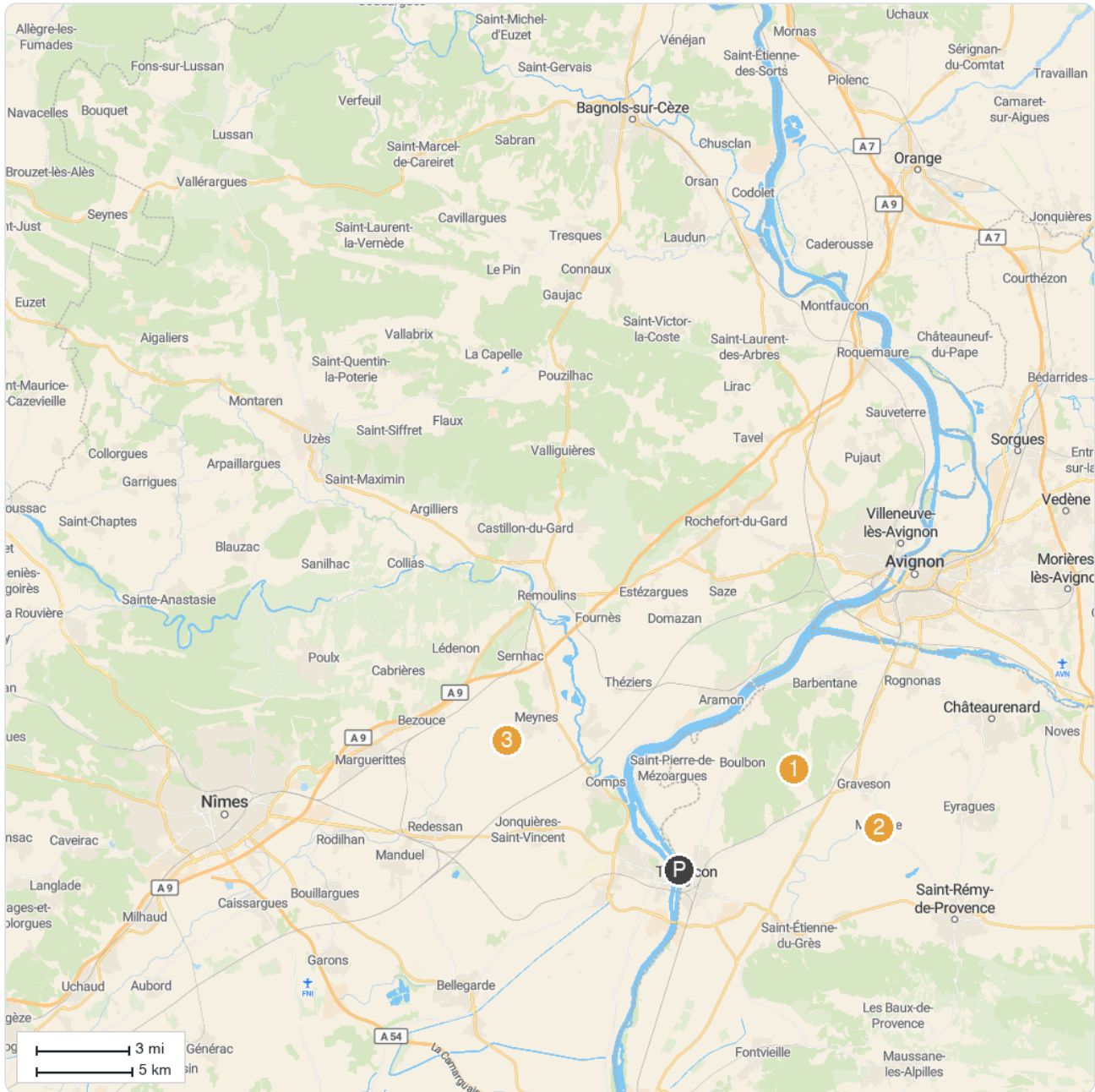
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Buy your château ticket early. Château de Tarascon is the one paid highlight — allow 1.5–2 hours, including the rooftop, before heading into the old town.
- Lunch shutdown is real. Shops and many cafés close 12:00–14:00. Schedule your market visit or shopping for morning; lunch is a good time to tour the château interior.
