TOP THINGS TO DO

- Fort William Historical Park** — One of North America's largest living-history sites — a meticulously reconstructed 1816 North West Company fur-trade... massive rock formation that looks uncannily...
- Kakabeka Falls — Niagara of the North** — A 40-metre (130-ft) waterfall plunging through Precambrian rock gorge with accessible wrap-around boardwalks and...
- Sleeping Giant Panoramic Views** — The Sleeping Giant (Sibley Peninsula) dominates the harbour skyline — a
- Terry Fox Monument & Terry Fox Lookout** — A moving tribute to Canadian hero Terry Fox, who was forced to end his Marathon of Hope near Thunder Bay in 1980.
- Lake Superior Zodiac & Catamaran Tour** — Sail Superior Tours departs from Marina Park (steps from the ship) offering high-speed zodiac and catamaran tours out...

BEST WALKS

- Waterfront Trail: Pier to Downtown** 1.5 km · 20 min · Flat, paved — Walk north along the waterfront from Pool 6, through the Prince Arthur's Landing parkland, past the public art installations and Bight...
- Hillcrest Park Harbour Overlook** ~3 km round trip · 45 min · Gentle uphill — Head inland from downtown to Hillcrest Park for a panoramic view of the harbour, the towering grain elevators, and the Sleeping Giant...

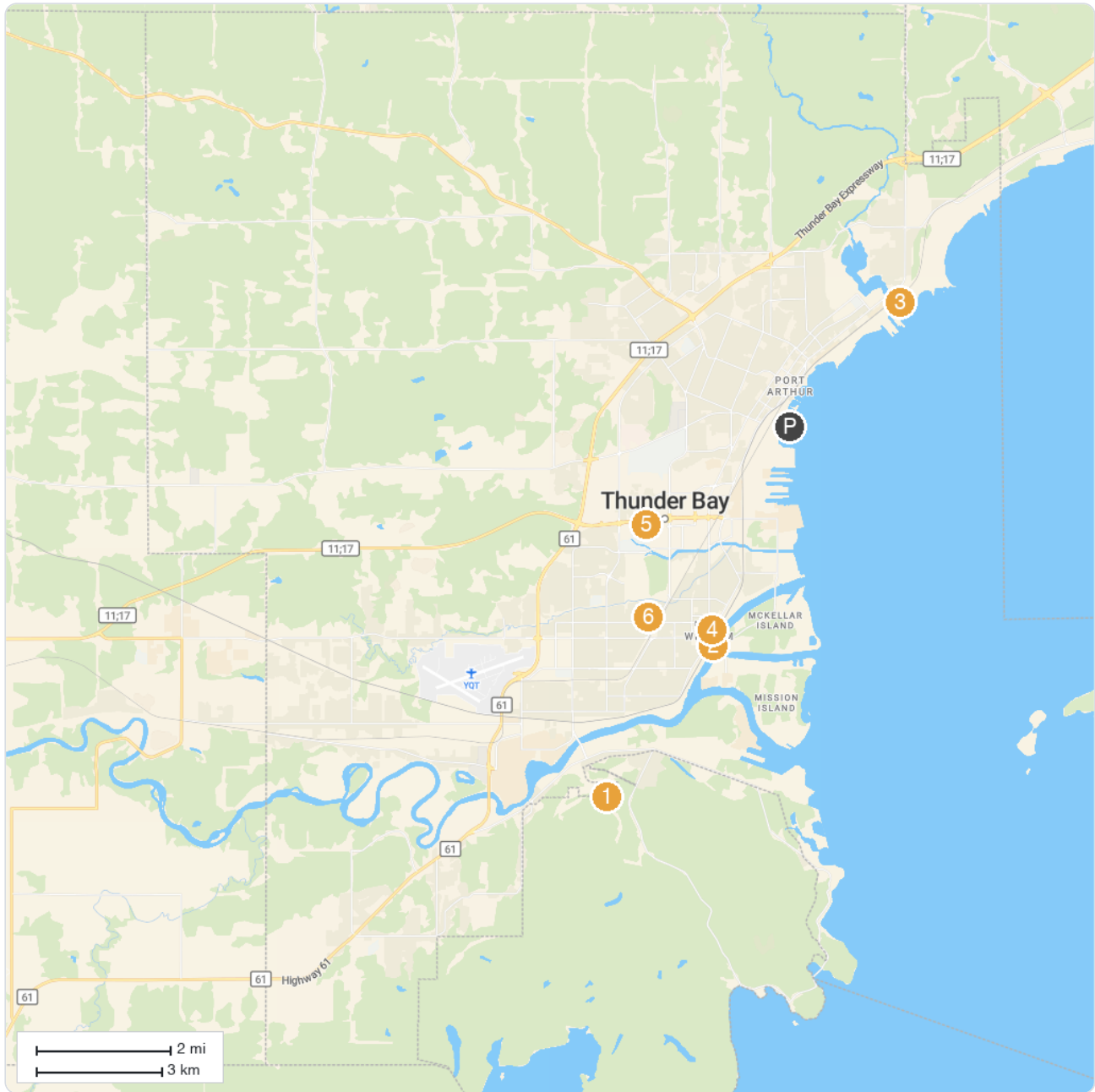
