- Kents Cavern Prehistoric Caves** — One of Europe's most important Stone Age cave systems, with stalactites and the oldest human remains found in Britain.
- Agatha Christie Mile & Torquay Museum** — Follow the self-guided walking trail through 12 Christie landmarks, then visit Britain's only dedicated Agatha Christie...
- Torre Abbey Historic House & Gardens** — Torbay's oldest monument — a 12th-century monastery turned art gallery set in 18 acres of award-winning gardens.
- Brixham Harbour & Golden Hind** — Take the ferry across the bay to Brixham — a pastel-coloured fishing village where you can board a full-scale replica...
- Cockington Village & Country Park** — A perfectly preserved medieval village with thatched-roof cottages, a working forge, and craft studios, set within a...

BEST WALKS

- Torquay Harbour Promenade to Torre Abbey Sands** 2 km · 25 min · Flat · Scenic — Stroll from Haldon Pier along the palm-fringed promenade past Princess Gardens to the main Torre Abbey Sands beach.
- Agatha Christie Mile Self-Guided Walk** 1.6 km · 40 min · Flat · Cultural — Follow the heritage trail plaques from the harbour past the Grand Hotel, Princess Pier, Agatha Christie statue, and Torquay Museum.

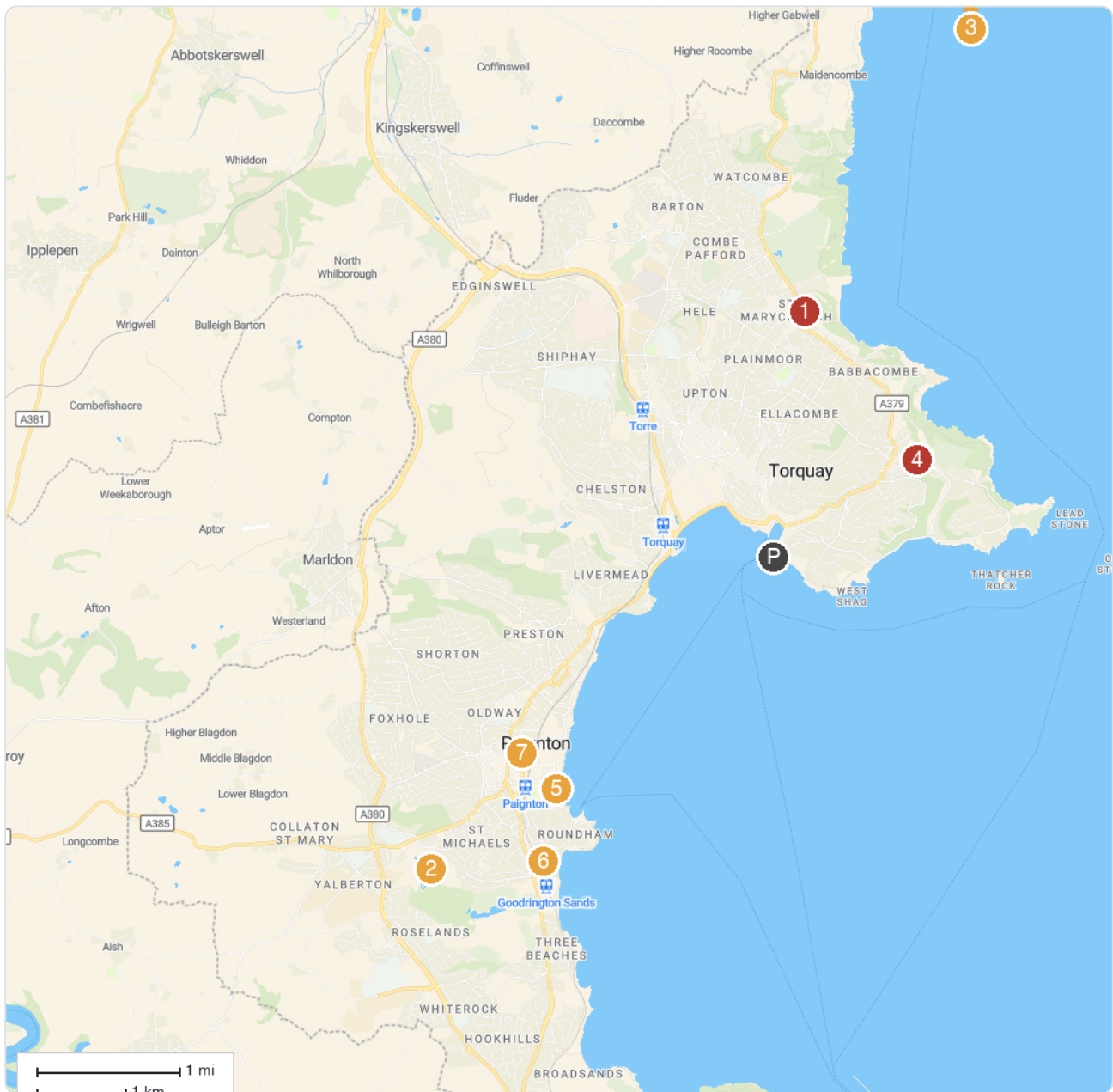
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
