TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Mont Faron Cable Car** — Ride the téléphérique to the summit of Mont Faron for sweeping panoramas over Toulon's harbor, bay, and the surrounding...
- **Cours Lafayette Market & Old Town** — The daily morning market on Cours Lafayette is one of Provence's best — fish, produce, olives, and spices.
- **National Naval Museum (Musée National de la Marine)** — Located on the waterfront, this museum traces French naval history from the age of sail to modern submarines with ship...
- **Calanques & Cassis Day Trip** — Head 45 minutes west to the picture-perfect fishing port of Cassis, gateway to the dramatic limestone calanques.
- **Aix-en-Provence Full Day** — Elegant Aix — fountains, Cours Mirabeau, Cézanne's studio, and excellent Provençal restaurants — is an hour from Toulon...

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront to Old Town Loop** 1.5 km · 30–45 min · Easy — From the pier, walk along Quai Cronstadt past the naval museum, then turn inland through the Cours Lafayette market and the winding...
- **Mourillon Beach Walk** 2 km beach promenade · Easy · Swimwear useful — From Mourillon, a pleasant promenade links four sheltered coves with cafés and clear water — perfect for a midday break.

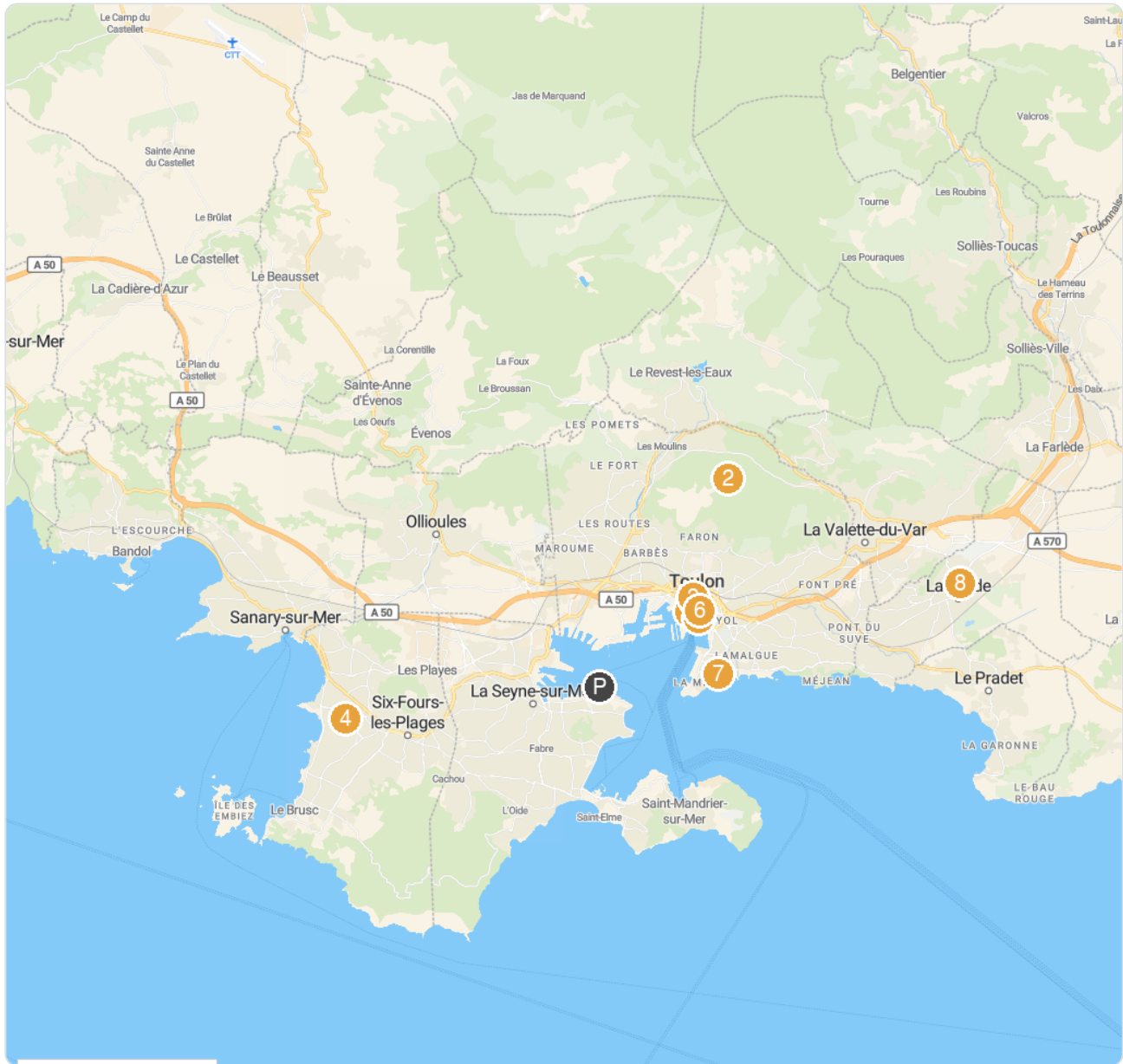
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
